Highlights importance of story telling with moral lessons

New Delhi, Sept. 27

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said India will become self reliant only when the farmers and villages are empowered. Addressing the nation in his 'Mann Ki Baat' program on All India Radio, Shri Modi said the agricultural sector of the country, farmers and villages are the very basis of **Aatmanirbhar Bharat**. He said even in this hour of crisis, agricultural sector has shown its resilience. He added that in the recent past, farmers have liberated themselves from many restrictions and tried to break free from many myths. Shri Modi said farmers have the power to sell their fruits and vegetables, anywhere and to anyone.

Prime Minister stressed that this power has now also been imparted to other farmers of the country. They



now have the freedom to sell whatever they are cultivating, be it paddy, wheat, mustard,

sugarcane, at any place where they can get a higher price.

The Prime Minister emphasized that innovation is required in agriculture. He talked of Bijay Shanti of Manipur who is in the news for her new innovation. She launched a start-up to develop thread from the Lotus stem. Shri Modi said her efforts and innovations

In order to enhance the teaching and learning process and to attain the requisite learning outcome of school going children, the State Project Office, Samagra Shiksha under Education Department has started introducing smart classrooms in the Govt. Schools covering the length and breadth of these Islands. The Department has initiated the Smart Classrooms Project



with the approval of Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India and it will cover 162 Govt. Schools at an approved outlay of Rs.4.05 crore @ 2.5 lakh per school under the flagship programme titled 'Samagra Shiksha' for digital education in A&N

Islands.

Installation of interactive panel with offline digital content has been completed in 43 schools in South Andaman and 16 schools in Wimberlygunj. The oldest ship repair facility, Dry Dock-I, constructed in 1956 with good old hinges type timber gate was renovated during the year 2005-06. This Dry Dock was continuously used for docking/undocking of vessels. The timber gate after prolonged usage had developed several cracks and was profusely leaking.



The gate was in precarious condition, dangerous and it was beyond economical repairs.

To keep the Dry Dock-I at Marine Dock Yard complex at Port Blair in functional state, it was decided to replace the timber hinge gate into steel hinge gate. The possibility of caisson gate was also examined, as it has advantages over the



steel hinge gates. The formation of Cofferdam work commenced in January, 2019 and was completed in March, 2019. The gate work commenced in August, 2020, despite COVID-19 challenges. Dry Dock No. I of size: 18.00 m x 5.25 m was made operational

have opened new avenues in the fields of lotus farming and textile. The Prime Minister talked at length about the art of storytelling, and how it has always been a part of Indian culture. Classrooms will be taken up in Little Andaman (10 schools), Car Nicobar (12 schools), Nancowry (11 schools) and Campbell Bay (6 Schools).

Under this project, the equipments in the smart classrooms, among other, include wall mounted interactive panel of 65" with latest technology/features, Mini PC, Offline NCERT e-content in bilingual language i.e. Hindi and English for the Smart Classrooms from Pre-Primary to Class XII with all main subjects etc.

To provide a better understanding of the smart classrooms, hands on training for the teachers to get acquainted with the devices has been planned from next month by the experts. Viewing the pandemic COVID-19, cluster wise training for teachers level of South Andaman Block will be imparted by maintaining all COVID protocols and SOPs issued by MHA. Thereafter, training will also be imparted to teachers in the other blocks as well.

The smart classroom program will motivate the students to use multimedia tools in classroom and enhance their knowledge. Use of this technology will help the students to get quality education and to prepare themselves for competitive examinations such as NEET & JEE etc. It will also enable them to access digital education through online/offline mode across the UT. This will lead to child-center learning through technology. This technology will also be helpful for teachers and students while utilising online digital educational platforms viz DIKSHA. ePathshala, NROER, NDL etc.

Further, use of exploratory learning helps students to learn with ease and enjoyment. It also motivates in creativity, aesthetic aspect, analytical ability, problem solving ability and sensitivity of the teacher and students. It helps the teacher and students to be more enthusiastic in teaching learning process. The teacher can improve the attendance and get better results through integration of technology in education. By using audio/video modules in class, the involvement of students can be made easy. Technology can make them have better understanding about the concept. Nutrient-rich Foods



All age groups, including children from 6 months of age need to consume a variety of nutritious food in adequate quantities.

- These include various types of foods like grains and pulses, green leafy vegetables such as spinach, fenugreek, amaranthus and mustard, beets, carrots, yellow/orange fruits such as mango and ripe papaya.
- If non-vegetarian, consume eggs, meat and fish.
- Include milk, milk products and nuts in the diet.
- Consume locally produced nutritious food items in your diet
- Consume Take Home Ration which is distributed at Anganwadicentres.
- When the child completes six months, in addition to breastmilk, give the child mashed and semi-solid complementary food prepared at home such as pumpkins, gourds, carrots, spinach and thick dal, dalia, khichdi etc. If non-vegetarian, add eggs, fish and meat.
- Add one spoon of ghee/oil/butter to the child's food.
- Give the child food with less salt, sugar and spices.
- Introduce one food item at a time and gradually increase the diversity of food. Include different flavours, textures and colours to make the child's food more enjoyable.
- Do not give food such as biscuits, chips, savoury snacks and juices to the child, as these do not give adequate nutrients to them.


