We need a sustainable framework that synthesizes human and environmental elements of security: Vice President

New Delhi, Feb 27
The Vice President of India, Shri M. Hamid Ansari has said that we need to move towards implementing a framework of sustainability that synthesizes both the human and the environmental elements of security for sustainable human development. He was delivering the 6th Prof. Moonis Raza Memorial Lecture, here today, organised by the Prof. Moonis Raza Memorial Trust. Speaking about Prof. Moonis Raza, the Vice President said that his work blurred the boundary between traditional human

geography and environmental science, synthesizing both natural and socio-economic elements of geography, and its impact on the human landscape. A Muslim by birth, a Marxist by orientation and an agnostic in matters metaphysical, Moonis sahib was acutely aware of the sociological imperatives of the Indian scene, he added. The Vice President said that sustainable development cannot be achieved by technological solutions, political regulation or financial instruments alone. We need to change the

way we think and act, he added. The Vice President said that the human security approach is tied intrinsically to the idea of sustainable human development, which envisions not only generating economic growth but distributing its benefits equitably, regenerating the environment rather than destroying it, and empowering people rather than marginalizing them. It is increasingly apparent that approaches to development, based merely on economic values are insufficient, he added.

NPPA asks hospitals, doctors to report stents shortage

New Delhi, Feb 27
National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority, NPPA has asked the hospitals and doctors to report shortage of stents to ensure availability of the medical device in the wake of price cap. The drug price regulator has been taking several steps to ensure stents are available under its prescribed price list as reports emerged that there were shortages in the

market. Last week, the NPPA had warned hospitals, stent manufacturers and importers of legal action in case they are found spreading misinformation about shortage of stents. It also asked stents manufacturers and their distributors to align their system according to the new price list. In a tweet, the NPPA also said that drug companies need to restructure their

stents trading and supply channel to work within 8 per cent maximum trade margin without circumventing it. It had also said, the 8 per cent margin also adequately covers hospital handling charges. In a major relief to patients, the NPPA had slashed prices of coronary stents by up to 85 per cent, capping them at 7,260 rupees for bare metal ones and 29,600 rupees for the drug eluting variety.

NASA to send robotic spacecraft to Sun next year

Washington, Feb 27

NASA plans to send its first robotic spacecraft to the Sun next year, to probe its atmosphere. Eric Christian, a NASA research scientist at Goddard Space Flight Centre said in Washington that NASA's Solar Probe Plus mission to the Sun, which is about 149 million kilometres from the Earth, will unveil why the surface of the Sun is not as hot as its atmosphere, how solar wind gets its speed and why the Sun occasionally emits high energy particles that are a danger to unprotected astronauts and spacecrafts.

He said, NASA has designed a 11.4 centimetres carbon-composite shield, which is designed to withstand temperatures outside the spacecraft of 1,370 degrees Celsius. Christian said, the unmanned probe will have special heat tubes called thermal radiators that will radiate heat that permeates the heat shield to open space.

Trade initiatives to develop strong India-CLMV bond vertical: Commerce Minister

Jaipur, Feb 27

Commerce and Industry Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman has said that trade with the CLMV countries grew from USD 1.5 bn to more than USD 10 bn in the last 10 years and expressed hope that India will be able to partner in more trade initiatives with these countries to develop a strong India-CLMV vertical within the ASEAN market. In her inaugural address at the 4th India-CLMV (Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar and Vietnam) Business Conclave in Jaipur today she invited both the Government and business community of these countries to actively partner in India's initiative to strengthen manufacturing capacities, and stated that in India

there is a good scope for improving trade in sectors like health and wellbeing, manufacturing, agriculture, fisheries, skilling among others. The Minister indicated that there are clear verticals for India to facilitate trade with these countries like, organic agriculture

produce from Myanmar, value added products from coffee & pepper produce of Vietnam, two & three wheeler exports to Lao PDR etc. She highlighted that these countries can take advantage of the tremendous scope in India on skill resources across various sectors.

India seeks 'strongest' US action in Kansas shooting

New Delhi, Feb 27

India demanded the "strongest action" from the US government after Hyderabad's engineer Shri Srinivas Kuchibhotla was killed and his colleague from Warangal wounded in an apparent hate crime in Kansas City.

Union Information and Broadcasting Minister Shri

M. Venkaiah Naidu said the US should respond to this incident. He said, US President and people of America should come out openly to condemn such actions and then take the strongest action. Shri

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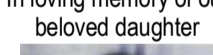

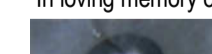

ISSF World Cup: Heena Sidhu, Jitu Rai win gold in 10m Air Pistol event

New Delhi, Feb 27
Ace Indian shooters Heena Sidhu and Jitu Rai on Monday clinched the gold medal in the 10m Air Pistol mixed team event here at the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) World Cup.
The Indian duo won the first-ever medal in the discipline by beating Japan in the finals at the Karni Singh Shooting Range. "In Rio Olympics, a lot of hopes were pinned on these shooting duo but they failed to notch up the results. Meanwhile, this is the first time that shooters are competing in mixed events at a World Cup, with talk of the 2020 Tokyo Olympics most likely including the discipline for the first time at the biggest stage. As the mixed team events are Test-only event, there will be no official World Cup medals and no official scores added to the shooters' accolades. Earlier, Pooja Ghatkar, who had narrowly missed out on winning a quota berth for the 2016 Rio Olympics, had won bronze for India in the 10m Air Rifle event.
The 28-year-old posted 228.8



in the final of the event to finish third on the podium and win her maiden World Cup medal. Former world number one Sidhu, on the other hand, could not make the cut and finished 11th in the qualification stage with a total score of 378 in the women's 10m air pistol final on Monday.
