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GST draft bills tabled in Parliament; peg peak rate at 40%

New Delhi, Mar 27 Finance Minister, Shri Arun Jaitley today introduced in Lok Sabha four bills on Goods and Services Tax, providing for a maximum GST rate of 40 per cent, an anti-profiteering authority and arrests for evading taxes. With this, rollout of GST - the biggest tax reform since independence - has entered the last lap and its passage by Parliament will

pave the way for integrating India as one market with one rate of tax replacing multiple state and central levies. Shri Jaitley introduced a Central Goods and Service Tax or CGST bill which will amalgamate all the indirect central government levies like sales tax, service tax, excise duty, additional customs duty (Countervailing Duty),

special additional duty of customs, surcharges and cesses. CGST provides for a maximum tax of 20 per cent. Actual rates would however be a four-tier tax structure of 5, 12, 18 and 28 per cent as approved by the GST Council. The peak rate of 40 per cent is only an enabling provision for financial emergencies.

A Union Territory GST Bill will take care of taxation in UTs of Chandigarh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu. A Bill on Integrated-GST -- to be levied and collected by the Centre on inter-state supply of goods and services, was also introduced in the Lok Sabha. The IGST law provides for a maximum tax of 40 per cent.

No genuine student to be denied mid-day meal: HRD Minister

New Delhi, Mar 27 HRD Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar today said that no genuine student will be denied mid-day meal for the lack of Aadhaar card. Shri Javadekar's comments came in wake of the Supreme Court's decision that Aadhaar cards cannot be made mandatory by the government and its agencies for extending benefits of social welfare schemes. "No genuine student will be denied mid-day meal. We will give meals and also Aadhaar cards to

students," he told reporters. The Human Resource Development Ministry had earlier this month made an announcement that cook-cum-helpers working under the mid-day meal scheme as well as the student beneficiaries will now be required to have an Aadhaar card to avail the benefits. The Department of School Education and Literacy (DSEL), under the HRD Ministry, had also decided to give a window till June 30 to those who do not

have an Aadhaar card. However, the government had also stated that no one will be deprived of the benefits of subsidy schemes for the want of Aadhaar number and other identity proofs will be accepted. The Supreme Court today made it clear that Aadhaar cards cannot be made mandatory by the government and its agencies for extending benefits of social welfare schemes. A bench comprising Chief

Hyderabad, Mar 27 Indian Railways will tap solar energy to the tune of 1000 MW in the next five years. Railway Minister Shri Suresh Prabhu said, his Ministry has taken up a mission-oriented plan to save 41 thousand crore rupees on energy bills over the next decade. He said, Solar panels will be installed on railway buildings to generate 500 MW power and another 500 MW

through land based solar fields. Shri Prabhu was addressing a gathering, after commissioning various infrastructure projects on South Central Railway in Hyderabad recently. The Minister said, in addition, Railways have already started production of 26 MW in wind energy and are now working on converting waste to energy and commissioned two such projects.

Kolkata to host final; Mumbai & Guwahati get semis of U-17 WC

Kolkata, Mar 27
Kolkata will host the summit clash of the U-17 World Cup football on October 28 while Navi Mumbai and Guwahati were chosen to stage the semifinals of the prestigious FIFA tournament the country is hosting for the first time. The 85,000 capacity Vivekananda Yuva Bharati Krirangan, which was refurbished by spending crores of rupees for the October 6-28 tournament, will also host the third place play-off match, one match each of round of 16 and quarterfinals, besides six Group F matches. The announcement of the tournament schedule came after a seven-day visit by an eight-member FIFA team led by its head of events Jaime Yarza. The FIFA officials, along with Local Organising Committee members, inspected all the six

cities -- Kolkata, New Delhi, Guwahati, Margao, Kochi and Navi Mumbai -- which will host the tournament. Kolkata was the last port of call for the FIFA team. The two semifinals will be held in Navi Mumbai's DY Patil Stadium and Indira Gandhi Athletics Stadium in Guwahati. DY Patil Stadium in Navi Mumbai, which has been termed as the benchmark venue by the visiting FIFA team, will also be home to Group A and host a round of 16 match. Guwahati will be home to Group E besides hosting one round of 16 and one quarterfinal match. New Delhi will stage Group B matches, besides two round of 16 games. The Capital City will host its last match on October 16 due to the pollution concerns which has robbed it from hosting marquee matches. Margao will be home to Group C, besides hosting two matches of round of 16 and one quarterfinal game while Kochi's Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, which has been rated worst by the FIFA team in terms of preparations, will be the venue for Group D matches, besides one round of 16 and one quarterfinal match.

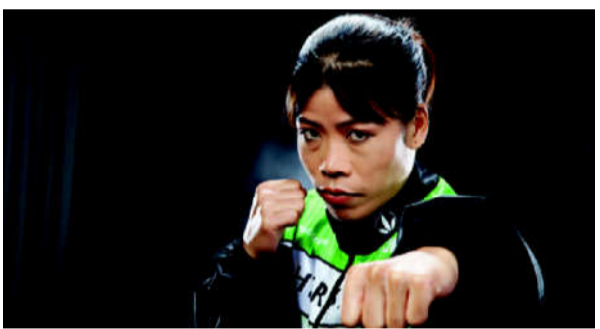
