### EC announces schedule of Karnataka Assembly elections

New Delhi, Mar 27  
The Election Commission on Tuesday announced the schedule for the Assembly election in Karnataka. Addressing a press conference in New Delhi, Chief Election Commissioner Shri Om Prakash Rawat said, a single phase polling will be held in the state and voting will take place on 12th May for the all 224 seats. Notification for the polls will be issued on 17th of next month and candidates can file nomination till 24th April. The results will be out on the 15th May.

## SC bans interference by Khap Panchayats into marriages of inter-faith or inter-caste couples

New Delhi, Mar 27  
In a relief to inter-faith or inter-caste couples who often face threat to their lives due to their relationship, Supreme Court today banned any interference by illegal assemblies like 'khap panchayats' into their marriages terming the intrusions as absolutely illegal. A bench of Chief Justice Dipak Misra and Justices AM Khanwilkar and DY Chandrachud also laid down guidelines to prevent such interferences. The



apex court said, the norms laid down by it will remain in force till a suitable legislation is enacted by the Parliament. The ruling came on a plea by NGO Shakti Vahini, which had moved the apex

court in 2010 seeking protection of couples from honour killings. While reserving its verdict in March this year, the court had observed that when two consenting adults get married irrespective of their background, no relative or a third person can interfere or threaten or unleash violence against them. During the proceedings in the matter, the Centre too had told the top court that state governments must provide protection to couples fearing for their lives due to inter-caste or inter-faith marriages and that such couples should inform the marriage officers about any such threat so that they can be given protection. ## Street food vendors cautioned Directives issued to maintain hygiene; stringent action to be initiated against defaulters

Port Blair, Mar.27  
All the street food vendors including panipuri vendors have been directed to protect food articles exhibited for sale near road side from dust and dirt. They shall ensure that food articles are prepared and served hygienically and sufficient protection is given to food articles from exposure to dirt and dust. Similarly, street food vendors offering food for sale in open handcarts have been advised to keep



their food handcarts neat and tidy and at least 5 mts away from the road and proper dress code has to be maintained such as clean and neat head wears, aprons and hand gloves to be used by the food handlers.

Necessary provision for safe and potable water has to be made by the vendor and adequate arrangement should also be ascertained for safe disposal of waste/refuses. All the street food vendors have been given one week's time to carry out the rectifications and thereafter stringent action shall be initiated against the defaulters, a communication from Commissioner Food Safety said here today.

The projects were sanctioned across 523 cities in the states of Haryana, West Bengal, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Mizoram, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Kerala, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and Goa. **Manu Bhaker-Anmol win mixed air pistol gold at junior WC**



Sydney, Mar 27  
The duo of Manu Bhaker and Anmol secured India's seventh gold medal in the ISSF junior World Cup by winning the mixed 10m air pistol event with a qualification world record here on Tuesday. Genemat Sekhon bagged an individual bronze medal in the junior women's skeet, shooting a 36 in the final. In the mixed 10m air rifle event, 17-year-old Shreya Agrawal and 19-year-old Arjun Babuta finished on the podium with a third place bagging 432.8 points, while their country-mates Elavenil Valarivan Elavenil (18) and Tejas Krishna Prasad (20) finished fourth with 389.1. Bhaker and Anmol dominated the event from the

very start and entered the final with the highest qualification score and a new junior qualification world record. They finished with a 5.6 advantage on their closest rivals, China's Liu Jinyao and Li Xue. The two Indian youngsters dominated the final from the very first series, progressively building a gap between them and their closest rivals. They eventually finished with 478.9 points, just 1.8 points away from the current world record. The silver and bronze medals were both awarded to China, as Liu Jinyao (20) and Li Xue (18) finished in second position with 473.3 points, while Wang Zhehao (19) and Xiao Jiaruixuan (15) took third place

with 410.7. A second Indian team, comprising 18-year-old Gaurav Rana and 19-year-old Mahima Turhi Agrawal had to leave the final at the 38th-shot mark with 370.2 points. The duo ended up in fourth position. Finishing 11.2 points away from the fifth place because of a dry-fire shot, and also suffering a 1.0-point reduction, Australia's Hans Ben Hummer (18) and Sascha Kroopin (16) took the sixth place with a final score of 320.9. Overall, India occupy the second place with 18 medals, including seven gold, while China continued to lead the tally with 22 podium finishes, including eight gold medals.

**Venus Williams, Victoria Azarenka march into quarterfinals at Miami Open**

Miami, Mar 27  
Venus Williams upended defending champion Johanna Konta 5-7, 6-1, 6-2 on Monday to reach the Miami Open quarterfinals while a dominant Victoria Azarenka also advanced with a straightforward win over Agnieszka Radwanska. Three-times champion Williams stormed back from an early deficit to cruise past the British 11th seed, who needed several bouts of treatment on her lower back throughout a match that lasted two hours and 19 minutes. Perhaps more impressive was that Williams, who turns 38 in June, was able to look so in control despite playing a day after spending nearly three hours on the court for her third round clash against Dutchwoman Kiki Bertens. Former world number one Azarenka, in only her second



event after an eight-month absence because of a custody dispute involving her son, also looked sharp throughout her 6-2, 6-2 win over 30th-seeded Pole Radwanska. The Belarussian, competing as a wild card, won 79 percent of her first service points and needed only 82 minutes to prevail in a clash between former Miami champions. Up next for the 28-year-old is Czech fifth seed Karolina Pliskova, who advanced to the last eight after Zarina Diyas of

Kazakhstan was forced to retire injured while trailing 6-2, 2-1. Former world number one Pliskova was efficient from the start and did not drop a point on her first serves in the entire match against Diyas, who took multiple medical time-outs and was visibly struggling with her movement. Sloane Stephens raised her game to levels similar to last year when she won the U.S. Open as she beat Spanish third seed Garbine Muguruza 6-3, 6-4 and secure passage to the quarterfinals.

**Shooting coach Ronak Pandit's name for CWG approved by Sports Ministry**

New Delhi, Mar 27  
The Sports Ministry has approved shooting coach Ronak Pandit's name in the Indian Olympic Association's list of non-athletes as part of the contingent for the upcoming Commonwealth Games. The National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) and ace pistol shooter Heena Sidhu had slammed the sports ministry amid reports it had called for dropping of 21 names, including that of her husband and coach Pandit, from the IOA's list of non-athletes as part of the contingent for the Gold Coast Games. The Commonwealth Games starts on April 5. Pandit, a former India shooter, will be travelling to the Games on 'cost to government's (government taking care of his expenses like other technical specialists) as coach-cum-manager of the shooting team, according to the IOA list. Throwing his weight behind Pandit and Heena, NRAI chief Raninder Singh had earlier, in an apparent dig at the ministry, said "we have to fight more here than there". Among those dropped from the IOA's earlier list include PV Sindhu's mother Vijaya Pusarla, Saina Nehwal's father Harvir Singh



and shooter Heena's husband Pandit, who is the High Performance Director of the Indian pistol and rifle team.
