PM flags off affordable flights scheme Udan from Shimla



Shimla, Apr 27
In a bid to make air travel accessible to a wider range of citizens & enhances connectivity with many more airports across India, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on Thursday launched the ambitious UDAN regional connectivity scheme for

small towns in the country, from Shimla today. Besides flagging off the first flight between Shimla and Delhi, Prime Minister also flagged off the inaugural UDAN flights on Kadapa and Nanded through video conferencing. The UDAN scheme seeks

to make flying more affordable for the common people, holding a plan to connect over 45 unserved and under-served airports in the country. Under UDAN, 50 per cent of the seats on each flight would have a cap of Rs 2,500 per seat/hour. The (Contd. on last page)
