3626 pregnant women examined & 550 pregnant women with high risk referred to G.B Pant Hospital during 2025-26 under the scheme

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 27
The Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) has been launched by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India aimed at providing assured, comprehensive and quality antenatal care, free of cost, universally to all pregnant women on the 9th of every month.

The PMSMA launched in the year 2016 guarantees a minimum package of antenatal care services to women in their 2nd / 3rd trimesters of pregnancy at designated Government health facilities and it envisages to improve the



quality and coverage of Antenatal Care (ANC) including diagnostics and counseling services as part of the Reproductive Maternal Neonatal Child and Adolescent Health (RMNCH+A) Strategy. According to information received from the Directorate of

Health Services, the PMSMA has been implemented in A&N Islands on 9th September, 2016. On 9th day of every month all essential maternal health services are provided at identified public health facilities including examination by Medical Officers. Under this

scheme, a total number of 3626 pregnant women were examined during 2025-26 and 550 pregnant women with high risk were referred to G.B Pant Hospital during the same period.

PMSMA helps in providing quality ANC including complete set of investigations such as HB, Urine Albumin, VDRL, OGTT including ultrasound for each pregnant woman. These facilitates in timely detection, referral, treatment and follow-up of high-risk pregnancies and ensure that all pregnant women complete their scheduled Antenatal Care Visit.

Do's and Don'ts for Canine Distemper - Urgent Advisory to Pet Owners

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 27
The Dept. of AH&VS has confirmed the outbreak of Canine Distemper Virus (CDV) in Canine in Sri Vijaya Puram. Canine Distemper is a life-threatening viral disease that primarily affects unvaccinated or improperly vaccinated dogs. Early symptoms include high fever, dry nose, congested eyes, occulo-nasal discharge, coughing, loss of appetite, vomiting, and diarrhoea. In advanced stages, it may cause neurological signs such as convulsions, chomping of the jaw, excessive salivation, jerky muscle movements (chorea), and hardening of footpads. It is however not transferable to humans and primarily a disease of canine

Do's for Pet Owners	Don'ts for Pet Owners
- Immediately isolate any dog showing symptoms of fever, coughing, vomiting, diarrhoea, or neurological signs to prevent spread to other dogs. - Consult a veterinarian at the earliest if your dog shows any signs of illness. Early supportive treatment significantly improves chances of recovery. - Ensure your dog is properly vaccinated. Puppies should receive the first dose between 6–8 weeks of age, followed by booster doses every 3–4 weeks until 16–20 weeks, and annual boosters thereafter. - Maintain strict hygiene in your premises. Clean food and water bowls daily and disinfect the living area regularly using mild disinfectants or a 1:20 dilution of household bleach. - Provide a soft, semi-solid or liquid diet to sick dogs. Use curd and probiotics to maintain gut health and hydration. - Keep your dog away from stray dogs and crowded public places until fully vaccinated and healthy.	- Do not ignore early symptoms such as fever, nasal discharge, or loss of appetite. Delaying veterinary care can be fatal. - Do not allow unvaccinated dogs to mix with other dogs or visit public parks and beaches. - Do not use over-the-counter medicines without veterinary advice, as they may worsen the condition. - Do not neglect cleaning and disinfection of the environment where an infected dog lives. - Do not allow your dog to roam freely during this period.

Collective cooperation from pet owners is essential to control the spread of Canine Distemper.
For any assistance or guidance, pet owners may contact the nearest Veterinary Institution or the Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

Test (LFT) and serum electrolytes to assess the overall health status of the animals.
For proper identification and record keeping, one damaged ear tag was replaced with a new ear tag and two newly inducted animals were tagged. A total of 24 animals were dewormed as a preventive health measure. Feed supplements - Profeed and liquid Phytocal Ruchi - were also provided to support the nutritional requirements and improve the general condition of the animals.
The caretaker of the Gaushala was advised in detail regarding scientific feeding practices. Emphasis was laid on the balanced provision of green fodder, dry matter, concentrate feed and adequate clean drinking water for better animal health, productivity and overall welfare, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

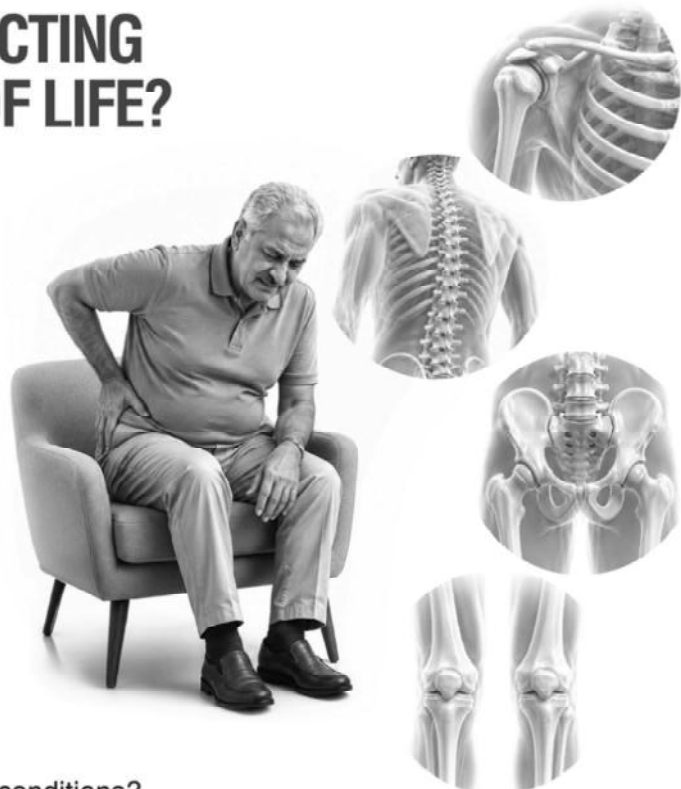
