The Secretary, IP&T, Shri Vinayak Chamadia, IAS as the chief guest gave away prizes to the winners of various competitions organised as part of the World Tourism Day celebrations.

Addressing the gathering, the Secretary appreciated the general public, particularly

students and youth, for their enthusiastic participation and excellent performance in the sporting events. Highlighting the importance of digital infrastructure in tourism, the Secretary informed that the Department is developing a Single Window System, which is expected to be ready within the next 3-4 months. The Secretary further informed that several tourism policies have been launched by the Department to boost tourism activities in the Islands. The Tourism Department is also working towards obtaining Dark Sky Certification for Chidiyatapu, Little Andaman, Baludera and Ramnagar, taking advantage of the region's minimal light pollution and

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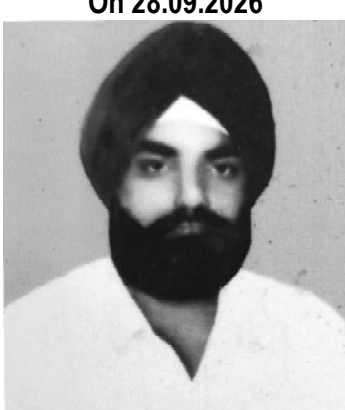
