Together with the rest of the Country, the 72nd Republic Day was celebrated in these Islands too in a manner befitting the occasion with extra precautions and measures in view of the COVID-19 situation on January 26. The main function for the Republic Day was held at the historic Netaji Stadium wherein the Lt Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) unfurled the National Flag and took the salute



of the Republic Day Parade. The parade and guard of honour comprised of the armed contingents of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard/A&N Police and NCC alongwith their bands. Defence helicopter showered flower petals at Netaji Stadium, the venue of the main function of the Republic Day-2021.

The Govt. of India's guidelines for the conduct of the Republic Day celebrations as per the COVID -19 protocols was effectively followed during the main function of the Republic Day celebrations by ensuring social distancing, wearing of masks, proper sanitisation, avoiding large gatherings,

protecting vulnerable persons etc.

Fleet of zero-emission public transport buses Lt Governor flags off air-conditioned e-buses on Republic Day from Netaji Stadium

Port Blair, Jan. 27

The Andaman and Nicobar Administration is committed towards preserving the environment of these pristine Islands by following the Government of India's vision of moving towards electric vehicles from the existing fossil fuel vehicles. To achieve this goal, the Transport Department has placed orders for deployment of 40 air-conditioned zero tail pipe emission e-buses by signing an agreement with NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Ltd.

As part of the agreement, the Department has received 25 AC buses. The Lt Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) flagged off the newly arrived air-conditioned buses from Netaji Stadium here on Jan. 26 in the presence of the Member of Parliament, Shri Kudeep Rai Sharma, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Chetan B. Sanghi and other senior Officers of A&N Administration.

These buses are fitted with GPS based vehicle tracking system with panic buttons, security cameras for the safety of commuters especially women & children and mobile phone charging ports for all the seats. Passenger Information System is provided in the buses which will not only facilitate the waiting commuters to know about the destinations of the bus but at the same time inform the travelling passengers inside the bus about the forthcoming stoppages. Traveling in these noiseless electric buses having air suspension will give the passengers a luxury travel experience. The remaining buses are expected to reach Port Blair shortly.

With the induction of these electric buses, it is anticipated that not only the general public will get an improved noiseless public transport having zero tail pipe emission for their mobility but also motivate the personal vehicle users to opt for public transport, Transport Department sources informed.

IMF revises growth projection for India to 11.5 per cent in 2021

New Delhi, Jan. 27
International Monetary Fund, IMF projected an 11.5 per cent growth rate for India in 2021. It makes India only major economy of the world to register double-digit growth this year amidst the coronavirus pandemic. With the latest projections, India regains the tag of the fastest developing economies of the world. Revising its figures, the IMF said that in 2020, the Indian economy is estimated to have contracted by eight per cent. In its latest World Economic Outlook Update, China is next with 8.1 per cent growth in 2021 followed by Spain (5.9 per cent) and France (5.5 per cent). IMF said India's economy is projected to grow by 6.8 per cent in 2022 and that of China by 5.6 per cent. (Source: india.gov.in)

Islands Forest Officer bags National Forestry Research Award

Port Blair, Jan. 27

Shri Joju P. Alappatt, Director, Forest Training Institute, Wimberlygunj has brought laurels to the Islands and Department of Environment & Forests, Andaman & Nicobar Islands by bagging the prestigious ICFRE Forestry Research Award (Non-ICFRE individuals) under ICFRE Awards for Excellence in Forestry-2019. Indian Council of Forestry Research & Education (ICFRE) Dehradun under Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Govt. of India constituted this award for honouring persons who have made significant contributions



towards cause of forestry. The award includes a cash prize of Rs 25000 along with citation and plaque. Due to COVID-19 pandemic situation, the award was presented through online mode in a function organised by ICFRE on 22.01.2021.

The officer's main area of work in forestry is biodiversity conservation, research and education. As part of forestry research, he has focused mainly on forest plants of A & N islands. During the last 10 years he has conducted many explorations in the forest areas of the island leading to discovery of new plant species and distributional records. So far, he has discovered and reported 2 new species, 9 new records to India and 6 new records to A & N Islands. The intensive explorations on plants of the islands have contributed for publication of hand

books and papers. On publication of research findings, he has authored two books and one chapter in a book. The two books published are 'Hand books on Common forest plants' and 'Trees of A & N islands' which have been of immense help for frontline executive staff of forest dept., forest managers, researchers and students of the islands for better understanding of the plant diversity of the Islands. Further, in the same period, he has published 21 papers in national and international journals. He is also a recipient of Lt. Governor's Commendation Certificate for outstanding contributions in biodiversity research, education and awareness and conservation of plants of A&N Islands. Honouring his contributions to floristic studies of the Island, a new species of plant discovered from North Andaman Island by a team of researchers from University of Calicut was named after him as Ophiorrhiza jojuui, a press release received here said.

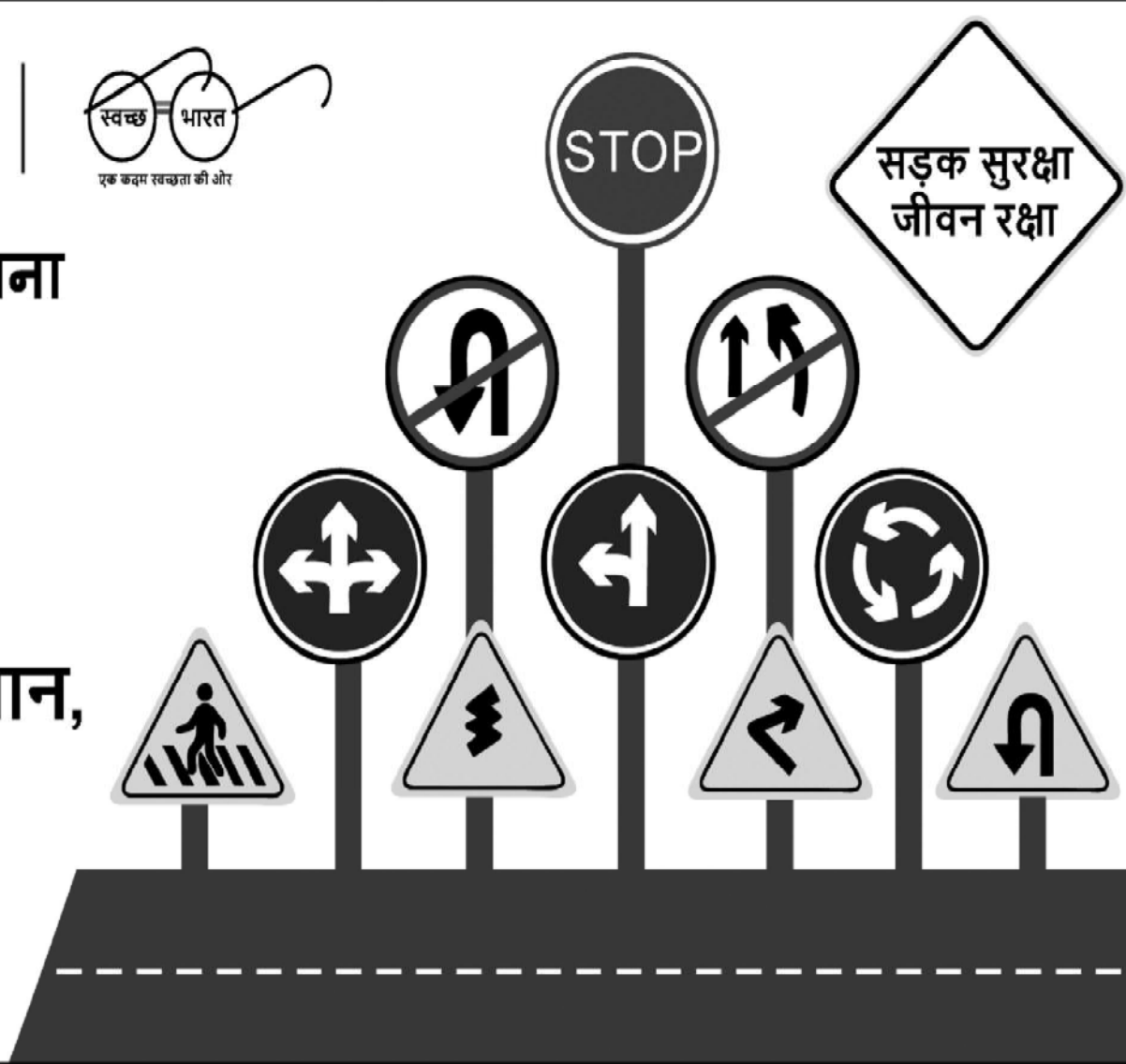




