Shuttler P V Sindhu bags bronze medal in Tokyo Olympics, becomes first Indian to win two Olympic medals



Tokyo, Aug. 1
Indian shuttler P V Sindhu won the bronze medal in women's single match in Tokyo Olympics today. PV Sindhu defeated He Bing Jiao of China by 21-13 and 21-15 in the bronze medal match and became the first Indian woman to win two Olympic medals. Sindhu won silver at Rio 2016. Wrestler Sushil Kumar is the first and only other Indian to win two Olympic medals. President, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Sports Minister, Shri Anurag Thakur and Indians from all corner of the country congratulated PV Sindhu for her achievement.
Sindhu showed immense character and guts to come back from a crushing defeat on Saturday to win a historic bronze medal.

Tokyo Olympics: Indian men's hockey team storms into semifinal To take on world champions Belgium on Aug. 3

Tokyo, Aug. 1
The Indian men's hockey team defeated Great Britain 3-1 in a quarterfinal match to qualify for the semifinals of Olympics Games after 49 years on Sunday. India scored three field goals through Dilpreet Singh (7th minute), Gurjant Singh (16th) and Hardik Singh (57th) to seal the win for the eight-time Olympic champions. The lone goal for Great Britain was scored by Sam Ward in the 45th minute. The last time India



featured in the semifinals of the Tokyo Olympics was in 1972 Munich Games. In the semifinal, India will take on world champions Belgium on Tuesday. Belgium defeated Spain 3-1 in another quarterfinal to seal their place in the last four round.

COVID-19 management through Test, Track, Treat, COVID Appropriate Behaviour & Vaccination

Rate of Test Per Million in A&N Islands reaches 11,05,158; so far 4,42,063 samples tested
71.91% of target beneficiaries administered first dose of vaccine



Port Blair, Aug. 1
The A&N Administration is strictly implementing the five-fold strategy of Testing, Tracing, and Treatment, COVID-appropriate behaviour and Vaccination. To stop the chain of transmission of virus and reduce the number of positive cases various steps have been initiated. Since the outbreak of COVID-19 in A&N Islands, the testing has been augmented manifold and as on date, 442063 samples have been tested in A&N Islands. Further, the Islands Test Per Million (TPM) stands at 1105158.
Apart from this, the District Administration is also conducting mobile RAT testing in rural areas of the District. The incoming flight passengers are also being retested with RTPCR. The District Control Room regularly monitors patients who are placed under home isolation by keeping track on the person's health status besides providing the required medicine.
As per health data, the new active case in the last 24 hours has come down to 2 while the total number of active cases during the 2nd wave (since 01.03.2021) has also come down to 07 in the entire Islands. Out of the total, 7539 confirmed cases of COVID since March 2020, 7403 patients have been cured / discharged so far. The vaccination drive is going on smoothly in

The Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), a maternity benefit program is being implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme for pregnant and lactating women of 19 years of age or above for the first live birth. The objective of the Yojana is to provide partial compensation for the wage loss in terms of cash incentives so that the woman can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first living child and the incentive provided would lead to improved

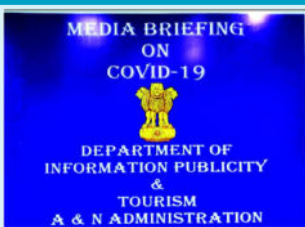

Support to individual micro enterprises through PM FME Scheme Interested individual entrepreneurs willing to set up food processing units may apply online

Port Blair, Aug. 1
The Department of Industries, A & N Administration is implementing a newly introduced Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Prime Minister Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME)' under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan with the objective to strengthen backward/forward linkages, common infrastructure, packaging, branding & marketing of products of micro food processing enterprises. Under the scheme, financial assistance in the form of grant/ seed capital would be provided to individuals/SHGs/Co-operatives/ Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs). The scheme adopts 'One District One Product (ODOP)' approach to reap the benefit of scale in terms of requirements of input, availing common services and marketing of products. The ODOP identified for the South Andaman District is Marine based Fish products and for Nicobar and North & Middle Andaman District is Coconut based products.
Scheme Components:
1. **Support to Individual Micro Enterprises:** Credit-linked Capital subsidy @ 35% of the eligible project cost with a maximum ceiling of Rs.10.00 Lakh per unit. Beneficiary contribution should be minimum 10% of the project cost.
2. **Group Category:** Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs)/ Producers Cooperatives: FPOs and Producers Cooperatives would be provided the following support:
• Credit linked grant @ 35% of the project cost. Maximum limit would be as prescribed.

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 348 flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. RAT test was conducted on 339 passengers bound for North & Middle



Andaman at Ferrargunj and two positive cases were found. Today, 2 flights with 359 passengers arrived here and the results of RT-PCR reports are awaited. He said, citizens should continue to follow COVID appropriate behavior to protect themselves from the virus.
The Director, ANIIMS, Dr. A.K Mandal said that 1 corona patient is undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital while no patient is on oxygen or ventilator.
The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De said that two patients are being taken care of at ITI COVID Care Centre.

Simplified Patent and Copyright Registration helping India become an innovation hub: Minister Fees for Start-ups, MSMEs, Women Entrepreneurs reduced by 80%

New Delhi, Aug. 1 (PIB) Union Minister for Commerce & Industry, Consumer Affairs and Textile, Shri Piyush Goyal has expressed satisfaction over the reforms introduced in examining and granting of patents, designs, copyrights and trademarks, saying the 'ease of doing business' will go a long way in catapulting India as an innovation hub.

The Minister reviewed the functioning of the Office of Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks in Mumbai yesterday and deliberated on ways to help a robust Intellectual Property Rights infrastructure.

Shri Goyal reiterated Government's commitment to bolster the ecosystem of patents, design, trademarks, GI (Geographical Indication) systems; to encourage innovation, research & development in the country and bring newer inventions and knowledge from India's heritage systems to

global platform. He emphasized that Prime Minister has been closely monitoring developments in this field since 2014 itself. Shri Goyal while speaking about the CGPDT's speedy disposal of applications informed that, "The pendency in the IPR Department has come down drastically. It has also been decided that any pending application should be completed within days and not months."

Shri Goyal also mentioned about the reduction in fee allowed by the department in order to help and support Startups and Women entrepreneurs in the country. Filing fees for Startups, MSMEs, Women entrepreneurs has been reduced by 80%.

The Minister added that emphasis has been laid on using Digital means. Every application is now processed online from start to finish, hearings are conducted on phones, people don't have to travel to patent

offices now. Shri Goyal also made a few suggestions to make the whole process more user friendly. He called for more efforts to increase awareness about GI tag and its significance. He also asked to consider instituting scholarships for students studying the Intellectual Property law as well as engage faculty from renowned institutions on a part time basis to help in the patent examination process.

Simplified procedure, growing innovation Officials of CGPDT briefed how the IP process has been simplified and streamlined than before and also about the re-engineering of the whole process including new timelines for disposal and shift to digital mode to promote ease of filing and obtaining services. For example, under Trade Mark Rules 74 Forms have been replaced by 8 Consolidated Forms. They also mentioned that special care is being given to expedite

examination of patents filed especially for applications filed by Startups, Women Entrepreneurs etc. While assessing impact of measures taken, it is noted that E-filing has increased from 30% to more than 95%.

India has also seen a rapid increase in grant of patents, copyrights in the last 5-6 years. The number of patents granted has gone up from 6,326 in 2015-16 to 28,391 in 2020-21, while Trade Marks registration has shot up from 65,045 in 2015-16 to 2,55,993 in 2020-21. Similarly, while 4,505 Copyrights were granted in 2015-16, a total of 16,402 were granted last fiscal.

These developments have reflected positively in improvement of India's ranking in Global Innovation Index. India has climbed 33 notches from 81st position in 2015-16 to 48th in 2020.

State Governments or PSUs or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force, all eligible Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers who have their pregnancy on or after 01.01.2017 for first child. The date and stage of pregnancy for a beneficiary would be counted with respect to her LMP date as mentioned in the MCP card.

As per this scheme, the mother is entitled to a cash incentive of Rs. 5,000 in three installments. For institutional delivery, an additional amount of Rs. 700/- is released under Janani Suraksha Yojana to women who fall under BPL category. The cash incentive is directly released into the bank account of the beneficiary.

All eligible pregnant and lactating mothers as mentioned have been urged to contact the nearby Anganwadi Worker along with Aadhaar Card, Bank & ANC details for registration and availing the benefit.

have been vaccinated. Meanwhile, a total of 33 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands and all were in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 93,415 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

Gross GST collection in July crosses 1 lakh 16 thousand crore rupees indicating recovery of Economy at a faster pace

New Delhi, Aug. 1 GST collection, after posting above 1 lakh crore mark for eight months in a row, dropped below 1 lakh crore in last month. With the easing out of COVID restrictions, GST collection for July has again crossed one lakh crore rupees. The Gross GST collected in July was 1,16,393 crore rupees, of which CGST is 22,197 crore rupees, SGST is 28,541 crore and IGST is 57,864 crore rupees.

This includes 27,900 crore rupees collected on import of goods and Cess is 7,790 crore rupees. The above figure includes GST collection received from GSTR-3B returns filed between 1st July to 31st July as well as IGST and cess collected from imports for the same period. (Source:india.gov.in)

Over 60 lakh COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in 24 hours in country; Recovery rate stands at 97.36%

New Delhi, Aug. 1 More than 47 crore 2 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under the nationwide vaccination drive. Health Ministry said, more than 60 lakh vaccine doses were administered during the last 24 hours. More than 39 thousand patients recovered during last 24 hours. The National Covid Recovery rate is now at 97.36 per cent. Till now, more than three crore eight lakh people have recovered from COVID-19. India reported over 41 thousand 831 new cases in the last 24 hours. India's active caseload is now over 4 lakh ten thousand. Active cases constitute 1.30 per cent of total cases. Daily case positivity rate is at 2.34 per cent and it remains below 5 per cent. 541 deaths have been reported in the last 24 hours. (Source:india.gov.in)

No...../F.No.3-117/DIET/GC/2019.-- In exercise of the Powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. U-14939/2/83-ANL dated 21st February, 1985 and in pursuance of DOPT's OM No. AB.14017/13/2016-Estt.(RR) dated 09-08-2016 and in supersession of Administration's Notification No. 66 dated 05.04.2005, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi as received vide letter No. 3/30(5)/2020-RR dated 07.04.2021, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands is hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the Group 'A' posts of Lecturer (Gazetted, Group "A" Non-Ministerial) in the District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), Department of Education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration namely :-

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENTS:-

(i).These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, DIET, Department of Education (Group "A" post in the DIET of Department of Education), Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(ii)They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. NUMBER OF POSTS, ITS CLASSIFICATION AND LEVEL IN PAY MATRIX:- The number of said post, its classification and level in pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT, QUALIFICATIONS ETC.:- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in the columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. DISQUALIFICATIONS:- No Persons-

(a) Who has entered or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation to this rule.

5. POWER TO RELAX:- Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do he may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, if necessary, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class of category of persons.
