Financial assistance to poor & destitute widows 6309 beneficiaries receiving monthly pension under 'Widow Pension' Scheme in A&N ISLANDS 1805 persons provided Destitute Allowance

The Department of Social Welfare, A&N Administration is providing 'Widow Pension' as financial assistance to poor and destitute widows. The aim of the scheme is to offer social security by way of financial assistance to the poor and destitute widows of

A&N Islands by providing allowance @ Rs 2,500/- per month to reduce their hardship. In A&N Islands, so far, 6309 beneficiaries are receiving their monthly pension under the 'Widow Pension' Scheme. As per the scheme, only those who are permanent residents of A&N Islands or having

resided in this territory for not less than 10 years immediately preceding the date of applications will be eligible for financial assistance. Altogether, 1805 beneficiaries have been provided Destitute Allowance. Application for 'financial assistance' under the scheme can be submitted in the

prescribed format in the Offices of the concerned Child Development Offices located at Port Blair, Ferrargunj, Rangat, Diglipur and Car Nicobar. The application form shall be available free of cost at the Directorate of Social Welfare, Port Blair and the Sub Divisional Offices of CDPOs.

Over one crore 42 lakh doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered in country so far

New Delhi, Feb. 27

Union Health Ministry said more than one crore 42 lakh COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered to beneficiaries in the country so far. A total of seven lakh 69 thousand doses of vaccine were given to health care and frontline workers in the last 24 hours. Meanwhile, the country's COVID-19

recovery rate stands at 97.14 per cent with recovery of more than 12 thousand patients within 24 hours. The Ministry said, more than one crore seven lakh patients have already recovered from this disease.

Presently, the total number of active cases in the country is one lakh 59 thousand 590 which comprises only 1.44 per cent of the country's COVID-19

Deptt. of Fisheries urges fishers & stakeholders to use ice as preservatives to extend shelf life of fishes

Port Blair, Feb. 27

Icing is the most prevalent method of preserving fish. Ideal icing involves packing crushed ice and fish alternatively in insulated boxes, in the fish to ice ratio of 1:1 (w/w). By this, the temperature of the fish is reduced to 1-2° C in about 2-3 hrs. Keeping fish in ice reduces the temperature to about 0°C. This action mainly prevents surface dehydration and reduces weight losses. Melting water also increases



the heat transport between fish and ice surfaces (water conducts heat better than air): the quickest practical chilling rate is obtained in a slurry of water and ice (e.g., the CSW system). The growth of spoilage and pathogenic microorganisms is reduced, thus

reducing the spoilage rate and arrest almost all enzymatic changes. Icing does not cause any harm either to the consumers or those handling it and it is relatively a cheap method of preserving fish. Using of ice means extension of shelf life of fishes and maintaining acceptable quality and appeal.

Like any other place, ice is the major preservative used during storage, processing, transportation and marketing of fishes in

A&N Islands. The traditional fishermen carry crushed ice in their boat while venturing for fishing to maintain the quality of catch. Earlier in the absence of any private Ice manufacturing unit, the Department of Fisheries has established ice plant and cold storages at various locations in the Islands viz. Port Blair, Hut Bay, Rangat, Mayabunder, Swaraj Dweep, Diglipur and Campbell Bay. The ice is supplied at nominal price to the bonafide fishers. With the introduction of various subsidies, private sectors have also established ice plants in the Islands. The Govt. assistance of 40% is available for setting up of Ice Plant Units under newly introduced scheme, PMMSY.
The Department of Fisheries has urged all fishers/fish farmers/ vendors and other stakeholders to invariably use adequate quantity of ice in all stages of harvest, post harvest, transportation and marketing as it could increase the shelf life, higher return for the catch besides better acceptability by the consumers. The Department also appeals not to use any kind of hazardous chemical directly or along with ice as preservative as it may have serious health concern for the consumers which may attract punitive action, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

With time, even women have perceived their roles differently. This is the story of an educated woman who thought out of the box and became an entrepreneur. Being a Post Graduate in Chemistry with B.Ed, Sandhya aspired to be an independent entrepreneur. After her marriage, she decided to start a pharmacy shop with the guidance of her husband.
She had come to know about the benefits of PMEGP scheme from one of her local friend and intended to avail the benefits and set up a self-employment venture and stand with her husband's dream to make it a reality. But she lacked the capital. She did a market survey and found that there is a scope of opening a pharmacy shop at Calicut since such units were not much then. She approached the A&NI KVIB for guidance and the KVIB cleared the haze around her proposed goal. Sandhya was also given a hope of financial assistance under PMEGP scheme. She went through the required process. Her application was approved by the District Level Task Force Committee (DLTFC) and forwarded to the financing bank for sanction of loan. Corporation Limited (IOCL) as stakeholders participated in the course. During the course, participants were exposed to extensive practical training on handling of oil spill response equipment. An exposure was also provided on health and safety precautions to be exercised during such operations. Wildlife is also prone to high casualties during any oil spill and the methods required for recovery and rehabilitation of wildlife were also imparted during the training by the experts from the Department of Environment & Forest.

As part of the course curriculum, knowledge of Oil Spill Dispersant (OSD) and the relevant environmental concern and health hazards were also imparted to the trainees. Participants also visited Coast Guard Air Enclave at Port Blair and were briefed about the aerial application of OSD by CG aircraft. Further for the first time, topics such as Hazardous and Noxious Substances (HNS Protocol) response option and Net Environmental Benefit Analysis (NEBA) were shared in the course for better updation of latest knowledge about response for combating oil spill.

During the closing ceremony, Commandant Subrata Bhattacharjee, Officer-in-Charge of Pollution Response Team (A&N) drew attention on sensitivity and rich biodiversity of the pristine Islands which needs to be protected from such disasters, a communication from Coast Guard said.

The EPR Committee has finalized the EPR framework subject to which all Producers, Importer & Brand owner (PIBOs) shall be allowed to bring in their packaged plastic goods falling outside the purview of single use plastic ban vide notification no. 186 dated 05.09.2019 under the following conditions:

- All plastic packaged products falling outside the purview of the single use plastic ban vide Notification No. 186 dated 05.09.2019 shall only be allowed for entry into A&N Islands. Further, those falling in the purview of said Notification shall continue to be banned and shall not be allowed to be brought into these islands under any circumstances.
 - They shall collaborate with the concerned local bodies i.e. PBMC, UD and RD&P for finalisation of the modalities of how the plastic will be collected, processed and transported out by deputing manpower and other resources as required.
 - They shall submit receipts in respect of incoming plastic (packaging or otherwise) as well as plastic taken back along with other requisite information as per prescribed format on a monthly basis. The format is available in the Office of Director, Science and Technology as well as department's website <https://dstpcc.andaman.gov.in>
 - The S&T department shall conduct a quarterly review vis-à-vis the plastic taken back on a quarterly basis and in case of any discrepancies between the two or if the administration feels that the company has not taken back the plastic of previous quarter in the following quarter, the conditional permission will be liable for cancellation with immediate effect.
 - The permission shall be granted for a period of one year at a time further extendable subject to quarterly reviews.
 - A report shall be submitted to the office of Director(S&T) on the quantity and type of goods imported to these islands in advance i.e minimum 15 days before shipment arrives in these Islands.
- All PIBOs/traders/wholesalers/retailers are hereby directed to comply with the aforesaid conditions with immediate effect. The PIBOs/traders/wholesalers/retailers failing to comply with the directions herein shall not be allowed to bring/sell their plastic packaged goods/products in the Islands w.e.f 26th January 2020. 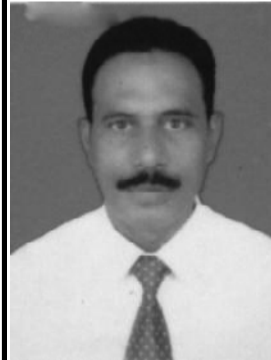

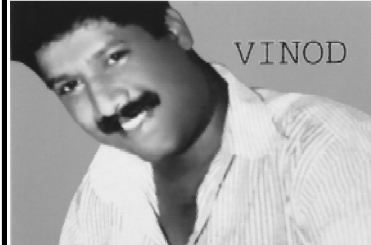
