Opining that upgrading the quality of higher education institutions was an essential component in realizing India's demographic dividend, the Vice President asked educational institutions to interact and work with industry to build world class infrastructure to train students to compete in global job market. He also wanted them to attach more importance Knowledge and Skill while designing



curriculum for students to train them to make professional with employable skills. Addressing the gathering after presenting awards at the 'Ranking of Engineering & Management Educational Institutes in India' event

hosted by Jagran Prakashan Group today, the Vice President said that providing high quality education must be a matter of sacred trust between a student and the institution as they would be joining these institutions with a hope for a better future.

Shri Naidu asked educational institutions and their management to consider the fact that most of the students might not have enough resources to fund their education in costly professional institutions and might

Restrictions on the printing of election related pamphlets/posters Printing press/offsets urged to be cautious while printing election related pamphlets/posters

Port Blair, Mar.27

In a letter to managers/ proprietor of all printing press/offsets in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a copy of which was released to the press, the Chief Electoral Officer, A & N Islands has informed that in view of the General Election-2019 to the House of People, all concerned involving in printing of electioneering material viz. pamphlets or posters, that they should comply with the rule and provisions envisaged under the Representation of the People Act 1951, which exhibits requisite mandates for printing of pamphlets or posters during the election period, which is reiterated as under:-

127 A. Restrictions on the printing of pamphlets,

posters etc.

(1) No person shall print or publish, or cause to be printed or published, any election pamphlets or posters, which does not bear on its face the names and addresses of the printer and the publisher thereof.

(2) No person shall print or cause to be printed any election pamphlet or posters:-
(a) unless a declaration as to the identity of the publisher thereof, signed by him and attested by two persons to whom he is personally known, is delivered by him to the printer in duplicate; and
(b) unless, within a reasonable time after the printing of the document, one copy of the declaration is sent by the printer, together with one copy of

the document;
(i) where it is printed in the capital of the State, to the Chief Electoral Officer; and
(ii) In any other case, to the District Magistrate of the District, in which it is printed.

(3) For the purposes of this section:-
(a) Any process for multiplying copies of a document, other than copying it by hand, shall be deemed to be printing and the expression "printer" shall be construed accordingly; and
(b) "Election pamphlet or poster" means any printed pamphlet, handbill or other document distributed for the purpose of promoting or prejudicing the election of a candidate or group of candidates or any placard or poster having reference to an election, but does not

include any handbill, placard or poster merely announcing the date, time and place and other particulars of an election meeting or routine instructions to election agents or workers.

(4) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of sub-section (1) or sub-section (2) shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term, which may extend to six months, or with fine, which may extend to two thousand rupees, or with both.

Therefore, all the printing press/house functioning in the UT, who cause to undertake printing of election related pamphlets or posters should be very cautious and adhere to the above scrupulously for strict compliance, the CEO said.

The Indian Coast Guard had evacuated a 40 year old Filipino crew namely Mr. M Almanon today from merchant vessel ACMA CGM Amerigo Vespucci' at 0320 hrs mid sea. The vessel whilst on planned passage from Singapore to Le Havre, France, one of the crew was reported to be suffering from severe pain in right lower part of back (lumbar) and passing blood in urine.

Meanwhile, the Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Centre, Port Blair had

received a telephonic information from MRCC GRIS NEZ (France) requesting for urgent medical evacuation of an ill crew from the merchant vessel amid sea. MRCC Port Blair immediately launched multifarious swift rescue mission. The Master of the vessel was re-directed to proceed with best steerable speed close to Campbell Bay to effect R/V for safe evacuation of the ill crew. Potential Search and Rescue unit

ICGS C-414 was immediately deployed from Campbell Bay harbor for undertaking medical evacuation of the crew off Campbell Bay seas. The Indian Coast Guard ship redevoured the merchant ship during dark hours at 0135 hrs on March 27, 2019. Braving the prevailing weather conditions and odd hours, the Indian Coast Guard ship successfully evacuated the crew amid sea and

Manu Bhaker-Saurabh Chaudhary bag Gold medal in 10m Air Pistol Mixed event at Asian Airgun C'ship

New Delhi, Mar 27
Exactly a month after a gold medal winning feat at the ISSF World Cup in New Delhi, Manu Bhaker and Saurabh Chaudhary continued their golden exploits in Taipei at the 12th Asian Airgun Championship. They clinched the gold medal in 10m Air Pistol mixed team event after setting a world record during the qualifying stage. The pair shot a combined 784 in the qualification round, breaking the record set by Russia's Vitalina Batsarashkina and Artem Chernousov at the European Championships five



days back, before going on to win the five-team finals with a score of 484.8. Hwang Seongeun and Kim Mose of Korea won the silver medal with a score of 481.1 while Wu Chia Ying and Kou

Kuan-Ting bagged the Bronze medal for the host country with a score of 413.3. A second Indian team pairing of Anuradha and Abhishek Verma also reached the finals to finish fourth with a score of 372.1.

Savita to lead Indian women's hockey team in Malaysia tour

New Delhi, Mar 27
Goalkeeper Savita will captain an 18-strong Indian women's hockey team for the five-match series against Malaysia starting April 4, Hockey India announced Wednesday. Savita will stand in for regular skipper Rani Rampal, who is nursing an injury. The eight-day tour to Kuala Lumpur will have defender Deep Grace Ekka as Savita's deputy. Speaking about the tour ahead of 2020 Olympic Qualifying events, chief coach Sjoerd Marjine said: "One of the things we wanted to improve after the Spain Tour was our One Vs One defending and create more opportunities after we intercept the ball." "These are the two key areas we want to focus on in Malaysia and we keep working on individual consistency of



players." In the absence of Rani, the experienced Namita Toppo and dragflicker Gurjit Kaur, Marjine said, it would be an opportunity for the youngsters to strengthen their future prospects. "Young players get to show their best performance on international level and it's important for us in case of creating depth in the selection," he said. Rajani Etimarpu has joined the squad as the second goalkeeper. The defence will include

youngster Salima Tete, Reena Khokar, Ekka, Rashmita Minz, and Sushila Chanu Pukhrambam along with Sunita Lakra, who is making a comeback into the squad after missing the Spain Tour. In the midfield, the experienced Monika returns from injury to join Karishma Yadav, Nikki Pradhan, Neha Goyal and Lilima Minz. The forwardline includes Jyoti, Vandana, Katariya, Lalremsiami, Navjot Kaur and Navneet Kaur.

India thrash Canada 7-3, enter final of Azlan Shah hockey tournament

New Delhi, Mar 27
Striker Mandeep Singh scored a hat-trick as India outplayed Canada 7-3 to book a summit clash berth in the Sultan Azlan Shah Cup hockey tournament here on Wednesday. The 24-year-old Mandeep fired in three quick goals (20th, 27th and 29th minutes), all of them coming in the second quarter, after Varun Kumar had given India the lead in the 12th minute of the high-scoring match. At the half time, India were 4-0 up in the match before Canada reduced the margin through a strike from Mark Pearson in the 35th minute. Amit Rohidas (39th), Vivek Prasad (55th) and Nilakanta



Sharma (58th) struck later to take the game beyond the reach of the Canadians who scored two late goals through Fin Boothroyd (50th) and James Wallace (57th). With the win, India continued their unbeaten run in the tournament, with three wins and a draw to top the round-robin league table with 10 points. They

are now assured of a place in the final to be played on March 30, with a game in hand. India play their final league match against Poland on Friday. Korea are at second place with seven points while hosts Malaysia and Canada are on six points each ahead of their final league matches after a rest day on Thursday.

Weightlifting to get all-clear from IOC for 2024 Paris Olympics

Paris, Mar 27
Weightlifting will be given the green light for inclusion in the Paris 2024 Olympics by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) once an anti-doping agreement is in place, ending 18 months of uncertainty for the sport's future in the Games. The IOC said in 2017 that weightlifting had to reform its anti-doping procedures or risk missing out on the Paris Olympics after scores of doping cases in the sport in the past decade alone had tarnished its image as well



as the Olympics. The IOC said at the time weightlifting had a 'provisional inclusion' for Paris pending far-reaching doping reforms. But on Tuesday the Olympic body said it was

satisfied with progress in that respect, with an agreement pending between the International Testing Agency (ITA) and the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF).



PRESS NOTE

Restriction on the printing on pamphlets, posters etc.

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that:-
Section 127A of the RP Act, 1951 imposes restrictions on the printing of pamphlets, posters etc.;

1) No person shall print or publish, or cause to be printed or published, any election pamphlet or poster which does not bear on its face the names and addresses of the printer and the publisher thereof.

2) No person shall print or cause to be printed any election pamphlet or poster:

(a) Unless a declaration as to the identity of the publisher thereof, signed by him and attested by two persons to whom he is personally known, is delivered by him to the printer in duplicate; and

(b) Unless within a reasonable time after printing of the document, one copy of the declaration is sent by the printer, together with one copy of the document;

(i) Where it is printed in the capital of the State, to the Chief Electoral Officer; and

(ii) In any other case, to the district magistrate of the district in which it is printed.

3) For the purposes of this section:-

a. Any process for multiplying copies of a document, other than copying it by hand, shall be deemed to be printing and the expression "printer" shall be construed accordingly; and

b. "election pamphlet or poster" means any printed pamphlet, and bill or other document distributed for the purpose of promoting or prejudicing the election of a candidate or group of candidates or any placard or poster having reference to an election, but does not include any handbill, placard or poster merely announcing the date, time, place and other particular of an election meeting or routine instructions to election agents or workers.

4) Before undertaking the printing of any election pamphlets or posters, etc., printer shall obtain from the publisher a declaration in terms of Section 127A (2) in the pro-forma prescribed by the Commission. This declaration shall be duly signed by the publisher and attested by two persons to whom the publisher is personally known. It should also be authenticated by the printer when it is forwarded to the Chief Electoral Officer or the District Magistrate, as the case may be.

5) The printing presses shall send the copies of the printed material (along with three extra copies of each such printed material) and the declaration obtained from the publisher as required under Section 127A (2) within three days of its printing.

6) It is also informed that any violation of the provisions of Section 127A and the above directions of the Commission would be very seriously viewed and stern action, which may in appropriate cases include even the revocation of the license of the printing press under the relevant laws of the State, would be taken.

7) The printer shall furnish four (4) copies of the printed material, along with the declaration of the publisher, within three (3) days of the printing thereof. Along with such printed material and the declaration, the printer shall also furnish the information regarding number of copies of document printed and the price charged for such printing job. Such information shall be furnished by the printer, not collectively but separately, in respect of each election pamphlets, posters, etc., printed by him within three (3) days of the printing of each such document.

(8) It should be brought to the notice of all concerned that hoardings, flex boards etc. containing any election related advertisement shall be treated as coming within the purview of "poster" as defined under Section 127A. The requirement for giving the name and address of the publisher should be followed in the case of hoarding, flex board including on hoardings of photos of party leaders.

(9) In terms of directions of the Commission in the case of hoarding, flex board etc, prior permission is required to be obtained from the owner of the property before displaying them. In case of such materials whether in public place or private premises, the party/candidate concerned has to give information to the Returning Officer as per format attached with the Commission's letter no. 3/7/2008/J.S. II dated 7th October, 2008 along with two photographs of such hoardings/flex boards.

It is further brought to the notice of all Candidates and Political Parties that in respect of surrogate advertisements that appear in print media, especially newspapers for and against particular political parties and candidates during election period. In many cases such advertisements are for the prospects of election of particular candidate. As per section 77 (1) of the Representation of People Act, 1951, expenditure involved in such advertisements in connection with the election of any candidate has to be added to the account of election expenses of the candidate, required to be maintained under that Section.

(a) In the case of advertisements, the source which is not traceable, the following action shall be taken:-

(i) If the advertisement is with the consent or knowledge of the candidate, it will be treated to have been authorized by the candidate (s) concerned and will be accounted for in the election expenses account of the candidate (s);

(ii) If the advertisement is not with the authority from the candidate, then action will be taken for prosecution of the publisher for violation of Section 171H of IPC-(incurring expenditure in advertisement without written authority from the candidate (s) concerned.

(iii) Identity of the publisher should be indicated in the advertisement.



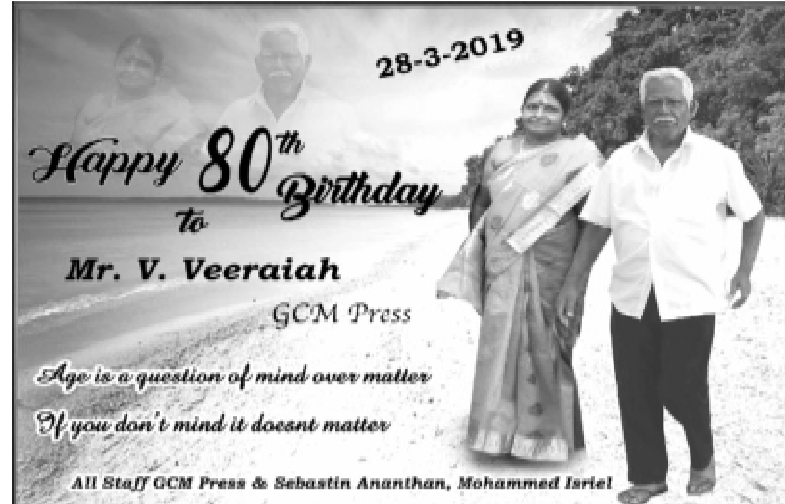


