

## Cabinet approves extension of Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana for another 6 months

### Move to benefit poor and vulnerable

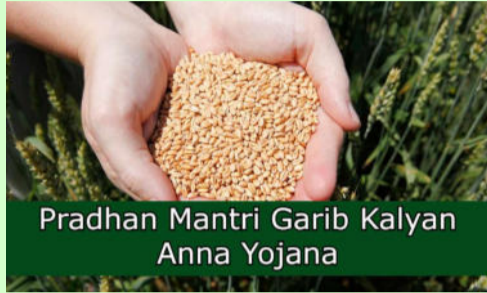
New Delhi, Mar. 26 (PIB)

In keeping with the concern and sensitivity towards poor and vulnerable sections of society, the Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, has extended the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) scheme for another six months i.e., till September 2022 (Phase VI).

The Phase-V of PM-GKAY scheme was to end in March 2022. It may be recalled that the PM-GKAY has been under implementation since April 2020, as the largest food security program in the world.

The Government has spent approximately Rs. 2.60 Lakh Crore so far and another Rs. 80,000 Crore will be spent over the next 6 months till September 2022 taking the total expenditure under PM-GKAY to nearly Rs. 3.40 Lakh Crore.

This will cover nearly 80 crore

about 759 LMT of free foodgrains under the PM-GKAY till Phase V. With another 244 LMT of free foodgrains under this extension (Phase VI), the aggregate allocation of free foodgrains under the PM-GKAY now stand at 1,003 LMT of foodgrains.

The benefit of free ration can be availed through portability by any migrant labour or beneficiary under One Nation One Ration Card (ONORC) plan from nearly 5 lakh ration shops across the country. So far, over 61 Crore portability transactions have benefitted the beneficiaries away from their homes.

This has been made possible due to highest ever procurement despite the century's worst pandemic with highest ever payment to farmers by the Government. For this record production in the agricultural fields Indian Farmers 'Annadata' deserves to be complimented.

beneficiaries across India and like before would be fully funded by the Government of India.

Even though the COVID-19 pandemic has significantly abated and economic activities are gathering momentum, this PM-GKAY extension would ensure that no poor household goes to bed without food during this time of recovery.

Under the extended PM-GKAY each beneficiary will get additional 5 kg free ration per person per month in addition to his normal quota of foodgrains under the NFSA. This means that every poor household would get nearly double the normal quantity of ration. It is worth highlighting that the Government had allocated

## Vaccination- shield against the virus 7347 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, Mar. 26

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,09,760 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 and above have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands. Similarly, 23,329 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 7347 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 9901.

A total of 1988 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands. 1459 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 1156 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 45 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 13 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 70.

458 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 398 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 4 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 35.

71 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 40 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 17, a press release from DHS said.

## Department of Telecom tests EMF...



EMF radiation level testing by DOT A&N team at Manjeri & Wandoor on 26.03.2022

Department of Telecom (DoT) has created a mechanism to ensure that radiation limits from telecom towers are maintained by all Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) within limits. All TSPs have to give periodic self-certificates to this effect and DoT field offices have been mandated to audit 10% BTS every year.

As part of this, the DOT A&N team today surveyed BTS network working in Wandoor Gram Panchayat area and measured radiation level of towers working of all Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) therein and radiation level found well within permissible limits.

It is pertinent to mention that so far, DoT A&N has tested 361 out of 744 BTS till 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 in A&N UT and found radiation level for all tested towers are well within the permissible radiation level.

In addition to this, DoT has created a portal www.tarangsanchar.gov.in wherein there is a provision for the general public to see the radiation level of towers in their vicinity by entering their area postal PIN code.

Considering the mobile expansion plan for introduction of 5G the number of towers is to be increased from 309 to 520 within the next 2 years. Therefore, DoT A&N Port Blair has requested the co-operation of stakeholder including the general public to shed all misconceptions about mobile tower radiations and come forward to extend all possible support for faster roll out of telecom infrastructure to meet the unprecedented demand for telecom services and improve quality of telecom service in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a press release from Department of Telecom, A&N Port Blair said.

## Nicobari farmers imparted capacity building training by CIARI Scientists

Car Nicobar, Mar. 26

A scientific team of ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Garacharma visited Tapoiming, Kinyuka, Chukchucha, Tamaloo, Perka and Big Lapathy villages of Car Nicobar between March 15 & 22, 2022 and conducted capacity building programmes for Nicobari tribal farmers on 'Regenerative agricultural practices for Island based Cropping System' and 'Agricultural technologies for enhancing the income and nutritional security of tribals'. During the programme, Dr. I. Jaisankar, Senior Scientist (Forestry) explained about the use of multipurpose tree species for efficient resource utilization, conservation of endemic plant biodiversity to mitigate the impact of climate change. Dr. R. Jayakumara Varadan, Scientist (Agricultural Economics) explained about the CIARI technologies and package of practices of potential vegetable crops for a nutritious kitchen garden while Dr. K. Venkatesan, Scientist (Economic Botany) explained about the nutritional benefits of millets and pulses; and package of practices of ragi.

About 350 farmers from 6 villages participated in the training programme and all were given quality planting materials and farm implements for establishing nutritious kitchen gardens in their backyard. Shri John, Project Assistant demonstrated the cultivation of planting material and usage of the tools in Nicobari language, a press release from CIARI said.

## Women's World Cup 2022 India to take on South Africa in a must-win match today

Heading into the most important match of the Women's World Cup 2022 so far, India will be up against South Africa in a must-win match on March 27. South Africa, who has already qualified for the semi-finals has nothing to lose but, India's qualification into the knock-out stage is completely dependent on this particular match. The match will be played at Hagley Oval and begin at 6.30 am IST.

In the last five matches between India and South Africa, the Proteas women have won four matches while India only claimed one victory. During the warm-up match of 2022 World Cup, team India won the thriller by 2 runs, with Harmanpreet Kaur scoring 114 runs.

Throughout the tournament, India has been very inconsistent and hence has found itself in a tough spot to qualify for the knock-out stage. However, all the matches that India has won so far, they were won by a huge margin and hence have a decent NRR. On the other hand, South Africa has been brilliant and have already qualified for the semi-finals. They only lost one match in the group stage yet which was against Australia.



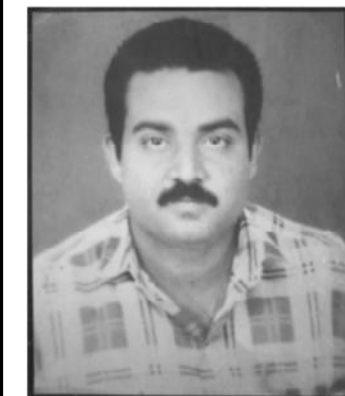
