



## Media briefed on COVID-19 management in A&N Islands

### COVID appropriate behaviour and vaccination must to contain spread of virus: Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health)

Port Blair, April 27

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health), A&N Administration, Dr. V. Candavelou has appealed to the people of the Islands to join the mass movement against COVID-19 and said, "this global pandemic can only be fought with the cooperation of all citizens". Addressing a press conference held in the conference hall of IP&T here today, Dr. Candavelou said that we are in a critical stage in the second wave of corona. During the last wave with the active co-operation of general



public, we were able to overcome the pandemic situation and this time too, we shall. It has been observed that despite several proactive steps taken by the Administration, the COVID cases are increasing. To combat this challenging situation, the A&N Administration, District Administration, the Health Department and other stakeholders are working in unison to control the surge of the cases in these Islands.

Dr. Candavelou said this airborne infection spreads from person to person and we have to strictly adhere to the COVID appropriate behaviors like wearing mask, washing hands and avoid gathering in public places and unnecessary travels. He said, we should be sensitive towards the situation and realize the fact that the surge in cases can only be controlled by strictly following COVID appropriate behaviors.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health) further stated that the Administration is

## Preventive measures in view of COVID-19 pandemic

### Banking business hours in all banks in A&N Islands to be from 10 am to 2 pm

Port Blair, April 27

In a special Union Territory Level Bankers Committee meeting it was decided that the banking business hours in all branches of banks in A&N Islands will be from 10 am to 2 pm instead of 10 am to 4 pm which will be in force from tomorrow (April 28) to May 15 or till further

notice, if any. The decision has been taken following surge in COVID-19 cases in A&N Islands. However, essential banking services like accepting deposits and cash withdrawals, clearing of cheques, remittance and Government businesses will be provided.

All SOPs regarding social distancing, management of the customers, health and sanitation, wearing masks, gloves etc and sanitization of Branches and ATMs should be strictly followed by all Banks, a press release from Lead District Manager, Port Blair said.

## District Administration initiates stern action against violators

### Shops violating COVID appropriate behavior challaned; 17 shops & 1 bar sealed

Port Blair, April 27

The District Administration in its efforts to fight COVID -19 has been enforcing COVID protocols to prevent the surge of positive cases and its spread in the South Andaman District. In congruence with this, District Administration carried out crackdown on shops which were violating COVID appropriate behaviour and guidelines and consequently sealed 17 shops and 1 bar. Challans to the tune of Rs.25,000/- were also issued to many shopkeepers for not maintaining social distance, not having thermal scanner and sanitizers in shops.

Shopkeepers were directed to show responsible behaviour in this grave situation of pandemic by following all the orders and protocols issued by the Administration in letter and spirit. General public have also been requested to follow COVID SOPs for the benefit of entire populace of South Andaman.

Further, it is reiterated that the five-fold strategy of Testing,



Tracing, Isolation Treatment and Vaccination will be meticulously implemented in South Andaman for control and management of COVID, a press release from DC (SA) said.

## COVID vaccination drive in A&N Islands

### 1,04,198 doses of vaccine administered till date



Port Blair, April 27

The health teams designated in various vaccination centres spread across the Islands are vaccinating all the beneficiaries above 45+ of age who visit the centres on a daily basis. The vaccination sessions are continuing in more than 88 designated vaccination centres, set

up in different parts of the Islands towards the fight against Corona virus. 1433 doses of vaccines were administered to the eligible beneficiaries by the health teams today (April, 27), taking the total number of doses of vaccines administered so far to 1,04,198. The district wise data pertaining to

administering of COVISHIELD doses to the eligible beneficiaries on April 27 released by the Health Department states that in South Andaman 1225 persons above 45+ were administered the vaccine, in North & Middle Andaman District 137 persons and in Nicobar District 71 were vaccinated.

continuing the vaccination drive to vaccinate all eligible persons aged 45 and above and almost 20 percent of the population have been covered. So far, more than 1,00,000 doses have been administered. He mentioned that more thrust will be given for vaccination of people above 18+ from May 1.

Outlining the steps taken by the Administration in combating COVID-19, he said the Administration is also imposing various restrictions in a graded manner as a precautionary measure such as curtailing the movement of passenger convoys on the Andaman Trunk Road, reducing the inter-island ship movement etc. These restrictions may pose some difficulties for the general public but we should understand the gravity of the situation and realize that the steps taken are for the safety of the Islanders.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary further mentioned that District Administration is doing a commendable job by reaching out to every household where people are kept under home quarantine besides conducting contact tracing, delivering medicines and monitoring them 24x7 through phone calls. Surveillance are being carried out by field functionaries where ILI cases are detected.

In his address, the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Sunil Anchipaka said that the Administration is working relentlessly at the grassroot level since the last couple of weeks, especially after this second wave of COVID surge. He said, we expect public to extend their cooperation by following COVID appropriate behavior. He disclosed that the District Administration has been forced to seal 10-15 shops for flouting COVID appropriate behavior. This shows that people are not at all serious about this surge, said the Deputy Commissioner once again requesting the general public to adhere to the COVID appropriate behaviour. He said that doctors and paramedical staff are working round the clock to contain this pandemic and without the support of the general public, it will be difficult to contain the virus. The DC also requested the people to immediately intimate the Control Room number 1077, if they feel unwell and have symptoms similar to COVID-19. He opined that early diagnosis can save patients. The DC further stated that Administration is working round the clock to ensure zero casualty and without the support of general public we cannot achieve this target. We are distributing the pulse oxymeters, activated all the CHCS, UHCs, PHCs and Sub Centres.

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh was also present during the press conference.

The Director, Health Services, Dr. Omkar Singh said that an additional helpline no 03192-239669 has been started in DHS office which will be a mixed one i.e. Administrative as well as clinical. If the case is clinical, then it will be diverted to doctors and if Administrative, it will be diverted to DC office. Apart from this, a Rapid Response Team has been constituted under the leadership of Dr. P. Lal. The team will immediately reach out to the needy, if the case is of emergency nature. He said, vaccination drive is going on effectively in Nicobar District wherein 85 percent of the population has been covered.

Dr. Avijit Roy, Nodal Officer, COVID-19 informed that today 8 flights carrying 371 passengers and 10 children arrived at Port Blair. Of this, 7 passengers have been tested positive.

The Director (ANIIMS), Dr. A.K. Mandal, the Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar, Deputy Director (Malaria), GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De also attended the press conference.

Simple Ayurvedic Procedures

- Nasal application - Apply sesame oil / coconut oil or Ghee in both the nostrils (Pratimarsh Nasya) in morning and evening.
- Oil pulling therapy - Take 1 table spoon sesame or coconut oil in mouth. Do not drink, Swish in the mouth for 2 to 3 minutes and spit it off followed by warm water rinse. This can be done once or twice a day.

During dry cough / sore throat

- Steam inhalation with fresh Pudina (Mint) leaves or Ajwain (Caraway seeds) can be practiced once in a day.
- Lavang (Clove) powder mixed with natural sugar / honey can be taken 2-3 times a day in case of cough or throat irritation.
- These measures generally treat normal dry cough and sore throat. However, it is best to consult doctors if these symptoms persist.



## More than 14 crore 52 lakh people administered COVID-19 vaccines so far

New Delhi, April 27

The world largest Covid-19 vaccination drive is smoothly progressing in the country. The Health and Family Welfare Ministry has informed that over 33 lakh 59 thousand doses of Covid-19 vaccines were administered to the beneficiaries in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said, over 14 crore 52 lakh people have already been inoculated with

Covid-19 vaccine jabs in the country so far. From the 1st of next month, which is also the third phase of the largest vaccination drive, everyone above the age of 18 years will be eligible to take COVID vaccines. The



registration for the 3rd phase will begin from tomorrow on the COWIN platform and Aarogya Setu App.

## One sentenced to life imprisonment for committing offence under POCSO Act

Mayabunder, April 27

Shri Jimut Bahan Biswas, Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge -cum-Special Judge under POCSO Act, North & Middle Andaman, Mayabunder has found guilty the accused namely Subham Mazumder, S/o Shri. Subhash Chandra Mazumder (24 years), R/o Subhash Gram, Ward No.1, Diglipur and sentenced him to undergo imprisonment for life for the offence under section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 under the provision of 235 (2) of Cr.P.C and also to pay fine of Rs.2,00,000/- (rupees two lakhs only), out of which 90 percent amount is to be paid to the victim as compensation under section 357 Cr.P.C, in default of payment which he will have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year more. This is the story of minor girl of seventeen years at the

time of incident and who has been raped, ravished and sexually exploited by wrongdoer. Consequence of such incident, the victim became pregnant. The factual matrix as reflected in a nut-shell is that the victim and accused both have consented physical relationship and on medical check-up it was detected and confirmed that minor girl was pregnant. For that reason, FIR No.32 of 2020, dated 12/03/2020 under section 5/6 of POCSO Act, 2012 read with section 376 of IPC has been lodged at Police Station Diglipur.

It was learnt that accused tried to flee away from this islands to mainland before pronouncement of judgment but the quick alertness of Investigating Officer and Inspector N. Stalin, SHO, PS Diglipur under the close supervision of Superintendent of

Police, Mayabunder, the effort of accused has gone in vain.

For the rehabilitation of victim girl, an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (rupees five lakhs only) has been awarded as compensation as per provision u/sec. 357A Cr.P.C read with section 33 (8) of POCSO Act and rule 7 of POCSO rule, which will be paid by the Government from Government Fund through NEFT. The entire case was investigated by SI Shiju Kumar which was appreciated for good performance and the Charge-sheeting Officer was Inspector Pritam Behari, former SHO, Police Station Diglipur. The prosecution case was jointly conducted by Shri. Keshab Chandra Mondal and Shri. Uttam Kirtania, Learned Special Public Prosecutors under POCSO Act, Mayabunder, a press release received said.

## Over 2,50,000 people recover from COVID-19 in last 24 hours

New Delhi, April 27

Amid the second wave of COVID-19 pandemic, the country today witnessed some respite from a record number of coronavirus cases. The Health Ministry said, over three lakh 23 thousand fresh cases have been reported in the country within 24 hours which is around 30 thousand less than the cases reported yesterday.

However, the active caseloads in the several States and Union Territories are still rising. As a

result, the recovery rate is continuously declining in the country. The Ministry has informed, at present, there are over twenty eight lakh eighty two thousand active cases in the country which comprises 16.34 per cent of the total positive cases. The Ministry informed that more than two lakh fifty one thousand people have recovered from the corona virus infection in the last 24 hours. So far, more than one crore 45 lakh patients have been recovered from this infectious disease in the

country. The Health Ministry has said, over two thousand seven hundred deaths have been reported in the country within 24 hours, taking the toll to over one lakh 97 thousand across the country. Meanwhile, Indian Council of Medical Research has informed that over 16 lakh 58 thousand tests of corona virus samples were conducted within 24 hours.

With this the total number of tests reached to 28 crore in the country. (Source:india.gov.in)
