



Hon'ble Prime Minister interacts with participants of Viksit Vibrant Village Programme 2026

Ms. Sayantika from A&N Islands shares her Maan Village journey in Ladakh with Hon'ble Prime Minister

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi interacted with participants of the Viksit Vibrant Village Programme 2026 on July 26. Highlighting the incredible nationwide participation, he warmly welcomed the enthusiastic young participants representing around two hundred and fifty districts across the country. One among the participants was a 21-year-old Ms. Sayantika Mistry from A&N Islands who undertook a remarkable journey from sea level to an altitude of nearly 17,000 feet. A final-year student of Andaman Law College, Sri Vijaya Puram, and a MY Bharat volunteer, Ms. Sayantika was among the young changemakers who interacted with the Hon'ble Prime Minister.

Under the Viksit Vibrant Village Programme 2026, Ms. Sayantika, along with eight other volunteers from the Islands, visited the remote border village of Maan in Ladakh. During her interaction with the Hon'ble Prime Minister, she spoke candidly about the challenges of high-altitude life, the compassion of ITBP personnel, the warmth of the local community, her interactions with children and the strong spirit of unity and cooperation she witnessed in the border village. The full interaction between Hon'ble Prime Minister and Ms. Sayantika is as follows: **Hon'ble Prime Minister:** How did you go there? How difficult was it to reach there? **Sayantika:** Sir, first of all, I would like to thank you for thinking of a one-stop solution like the MY Bharat Portal, which has given 2.5 crore youth like me an opportunity to become the voice of their country. Under the Viksit Vibrant Village Programme 2026, I had the opportunity to visit the border villages and, in particular, the beautiful Maan village in Ladakh. It was a completely new experience for me



to travel from 0 feet to 17,000 feet. The climate there was very different and harsh, and we were given five days for acclimatisation.

On the very first day, I fell ill. The MY Bharat team and the ITBP soldiers took great care of me. I would like to share an incident that touched my heart. When I fell ill, my oxygen level was dropping due to acute mountain sickness, and I was taken to the ITBP hospital by the 5th Battalion. I heard the doctors telling their own soldiers, "We'll check you later; first we have to treat this girl who has come as our guest." That made me realise that our ITBP soldiers not only protect our borders but also carry immense love and care for their fellow countrymen.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: Sayantika, you have completed the journey from the Andaman and Nicobar Islands to Ladakh from the island to 17,000 feet, in a way from the ground to the peak. How was Ladakh for you? The

difficulties faced by the people there, the cold weather and the thin air, how did you feel and what did you experience?

Sayantika: Sir, going to Ladakh made me realise how easy daily life is where I live. Up there, I could feel the lack of oxygen due to low air pressure, and I realised that simply adapting one's body to such conditions every day is an achievement in itself. We were also worried about connectivity. We assumed the internet would not work and that the roads would not be good. My parents even gave me cash, thinking UPI might not work without internet connectivity. But I was surprised to find that even those border villages, which people often call the "last village", had good internet connectivity, and I was able to use UPI there too.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: Now we call it the "first village"-not the last village. So, you used UPI there?

Sayantika: Yes, Sir, I did.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: Do the



people there know about UPI? Do they use it?

Sayantika: Yes, Sir. It was not exactly as we had imagined. People there also use UPI and keep QR codes. Some cafés and hotels even have Wi-Fi.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: If you had Wi-Fi, you must have been on your phone a lot then?

Sayantika: Not at all, Sir. I hardly looked at my phone. I spent most of my time in the valleys with the lovely people there, especially the children. Their names were so unique, Ghastek, Biskek, Dholkar, Namyal and Tenzing and they became my friends there.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: What questions did those children have in mind? They must have asked how the sea is, as you have come from Andaman and Nicobar?

Sayantika: Yes, Sir. They wanted to know where we had come from. At the Primary School in Maan village, the classroom was beautiful, with lovely paintings on the walls, including a map of

India. But I noticed that the Andaman and Nicobar Islands were not shown on it, so I could not point out where I was from. I explained instead, "This is the sea below India, and here is our Andaman and Nicobar Islands." I would also like to share one small incident, Sir. I asked a girl if she would like to come to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, where I live. She said, "I'll come to Andaman. I know I'll have to study a lot for it, but I will definitely come when I grow up." There were so many lovely children there, Sir.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: Sayantika, what did you observe in that village? How people there do everything collectively and together, in a way we see very little of in cities? Did you experience anything like that?

Sayantika: Yes, Sir. I observed many things that showed how strong the community spirit is there. We were fortunate to witness a wedding. Unlike in

cities, where weddings are often organised by booking hotels and arranging everything separately, everyone there was involved. People cooked together, arranged chairs and decorated the venue as a community.

The local monasteries are also deeply connected with the people. Whenever a religious event takes place, everyone comes together and participates. I would also like to share an incident that I did not witness myself but heard from the Numberdar (traditional village headman) there. Once, a mobile tower fell, and instead of waiting for any authority, the villagers decided among themselves to rebuild it. Not only that, they even built a common warehouse for storing the batteries required for the tower. That is the kind of community spirit the people there have, and I learnt a lot from it.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: Sayantika, this journey will definitely have a great impact on your life.

Sayantika: Yes, Sir.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: When you share joy, it multiplies. Talk to your family members and friends. Share your experiences in schools and colleges. Keep writing about it. These experiences should become a book or an article. Spread awareness among others about how big this country is, how its people feel, and the sense of attachment and experience your journey has given you towards the nation. Share all of this, teach others and help them understand.

Sayantika: Thank you, Sir.

Hon'ble Prime Minister: It was a pleasure talking to you. Congratulations.

A&N Administration intensifies efforts to restore LPG supply to Campbell Bay

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 28

The residents of Campbell Bay have been informed that the A&N Administration is taking all necessary steps to restore regular LPG supplies to Campbell Bay. The availability of domestic LPG cylinders has been affected due to disruption in regular shipping services over the past few months.

It is further informed that the supply and distribution of domestic LPG cylinders in the Islands is undertaken by the Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) through its authorized LPG

distributor. The Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs (CS&CA), on behalf of the A&N Administration, continuously monitors the availability and distribution of LPG across

the Islands.

Owing to the disruption in scheduled vessel services, transportation of LPG cylinders to Campbell Bay could not be undertaken for the past few months. This has

resulted in depletion of stocks and a temporary shortage of LPG cylinders in the area.

In a significant move to bolster the local "Concert Economy" and provide a global platform for the youth of the archipelago, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, officially launched the "Gems of India" Challenge today during the Senior Officers' Meeting held in the Conference Hall of the Secretariat.

The 'Gems of India' Challenge is a prestigious national initiative spearheaded by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MoIB) in collaboration with Prasar Bharati. Its primary objective is to identify and encourage emerging digital creators from every district to showcase India's unique culture, heritage, and tourism potential through

authentic digital storytelling. Notably, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands is one of only six States/UTs selected across the nation to participate in this exclusive pilot phase.

Speaking at the launch, the Chief Secretary emphasised that the initiative is part of the broader framework for the second edition of the World Audio Visual and Entertainment Summit (WAVES) 2027, scheduled to be held in Mumbai in February 2027. immediately took up the matter with the Indian Navy. Through the coordinated efforts of the Indian Navy, Andaman & Nicobar Command, IOCL and other stakeholders, a special consignment of 250 filled LPG cylinders was successfully transported to Campbell Bay, providing immediate relief to consumers.

As the requirement of LPG cylinders in Campbell Bay continues to remain higher than the quantity supplied, the Directorate has once again requested the Indian Navy to extend assistance for transportation of an additional consignment of 250 filled LPG cylinders. The cylinders will be dispatched based on the operational feasibility of the Indian Navy. Simultaneously, efforts have also been initiated to transport around 200 LPG cylinders through MV Chuglam during the first week of August.

Further, efforts are also being made to transport adequate quantities of LPG cylinders through the scheduled voyages of MV Manav Star and MV Sakthi. It is expected that sufficient LPG cylinders will reach Campbell Bay by the first week of August, which is likely to restore normal availability of LPG in the area.

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration expresses its sincere appreciation to the Indian Navy and Andaman & Nicobar Command for their timely support and close coordination in ensuring the supply of this essential commodity to the remote Island. The Administration also assures the residents of Campbell Bay that every possible effort is being made to restore normal LPG supplies at the earliest, a press release from Deptt. of CS&CA said.

Narain, Director General, Centre for Science and Environment (CSE), addressed the participants virtually, while Shri Atin Biswas, Programme Director, CSE, along with the CSE team, participated in person. The inaugural programme was also live-streamed through the SOVTECH YouTube channel.

The workshop witnessed the participation of around 63 representatives from 23 stakeholder organisations, comprising Government Departments, District Administrations, Urban and Rural Local Bodies, Bulk Waste Generators, operators of waste processing facilities, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs), Civil Society Organisations (CSOs), and Self-Help Groups (SHGs).

Technical sessions on the first day focused on key aspects of solid and plastic waste management, including source segregation, waste characterisation, Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs), Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR), compliance requirements for Bulk Waste Generators (BWGs), and sustainable waste management practices. The programme also included practical field exercises to provide participants with hands-on exposure to best practices in waste management.

The capacity-building programme is intended to develop a cadre of UT-level Master Trainers who will facilitate knowledge dissemination, provide technical support, and promote coordinated implementation of waste management regulations across the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a press release from Deptt. of S&T said.

Mock Drill on earthquake conducted at Deptt. of S&T

A Mock Drill on Earthquake was conducted at the Department of Science and Technology, A&N Administration, Dollygunj, Sri Vijaya Puram on July 23 by the Directorate of Disaster Management in coordination with the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), A&N Police, A&N Fire and Emergency Services, and Health Department.

The mock drill commenced with the activation of the earthquake emergency scenario. On hearing the emergency alarm, all officers and staff immediately followed the prescribed "Drop, Cover and Hold" procedure. After the simulated



tremors ceased, the Incident Response Teams of the Directorate initiated the evacuation process and safely moved all occupants to the designated assembly area through identified evacuation routes.

The mock drill concluded with a debriefing session, during which observers from the participating Departments highlighted the strengths, observations, and areas requiring improvement.

The Dy. Commandant, NDRF and other officials emphasized the importance of maintaining updated Disaster Management Plans, conducting regular mock drills, ensuring the operational readiness of emergency equipment and enhancing awareness and capacity building among employees to enable an effective response during earthquake emergencies, a press release from Deptt. of S&T said.

Veterinary Health camps conducted at Break Water, Ongi Tikery & Harminder Bay

249 animals received treatment. On the same day, another health camp was held at Harminder Bay, wherein 517 animals were treated.

In total, 1,019 animals were provided treatment and healthcare services during these three camps.

The veterinary teams carried out general health check-ups, treatment of sick animals, deworming and other necessary interventions to improve the overall health and productivity of livestock, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.
