LG calls on Hon'ble Prime Minister Apprises him about various important issues of Isles

Port Blair, Aug 28
The Lt Governor of A&N Islands, Prof Jagdish Mukhi called on the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi at New Delhi on 27th August 2016, and apprised him about various important issues such as green power, under sea cable project and bridges & roads in A&N Islands. He informed that the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), GoI has sanctioned 100 MW Solar Power projects at various locations in these Islands which are expected to be completed by December 2018. He stated that there is a tremendous potential for harnessing Wind and Tidal/Wave Energy for power generation in the A&N Islands and urged that the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy may be requested to set up such projects in these Islands. Stating that inadequate telecom connectivity is one of the major problems faced by residents of A&N Islands, the Lt Governor informed that the present



mode of connectivity is through satellite medium and bandwidth, which is around 1.02 Gbps as against the requirement of 55.65 Gbps. The project of connecting under sea cable optical fibre between Chennai and Port Blair with five Islands has now been taken up by the Department of Telecommunication and cabinet approval is awaited. He further informed that

two bridges are being constructed over the creeks at Middle Strait and Humphrey Strait. Coastal Regulatory Zone (CRZ) clearance for the above projects has been sought from Ministry of Environment & Forests, GoI which may be expedited. Further NHIDCL has been recently entrusted the task of upgradation of NH 223 and the project may be expedited, the Lt Governor observed.

Govt invites public comments on changing financial year

New Delhi, Aug 28
Government has sought public comments on the desirability of replacing the existing period in a bid to improve budgetary process and cash management. The government as well as most corporates in India follow April 1 to March 31 as the financial year. A post on mygov site said there are many arguments for and against the change in financial year which revolve around issues of budget and cash management by government, seasonality of government revenues and expenditure and impact of monsoon on budget forecasting. Public comments are invited by September 30. To examine the feasibility of having a new financial year, the government has already set up a committee headed by former CEA Shankar Acharya.

The committee, which will submit its report by December, will have to provide reasoning for the suitability of the financial year from the point of view of correct estimation of receipts and expenditure of central and state governments. Besides Acharya, the members of the committee are former Cabinet Secretary K M Chandrasekhar, former Finance Secretary Tamil Nadu P V Rajaraman and Centre for Policy Research Senior Fellow Rajiv Kumar.

New Delhi, Aug 28
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said any life lost in Kashmir is a loss for the nation. Expressing deep concern and pain over the violence in Kashmir, Shri Modi said those who using children to create unrest in Kashmir, have to answer those children some day. Addressing his 23rd edition of 'Mann Ki Baat' in All India Radio, Prime Minister said all the political parties expressed their sentiments unanimously. Speaking at length about country's performance in Rio Olympics, Shri Modi said time has come to change the thought process that sports is a waste of time. He urged all state governments, sports



associations and individuals to brain storm on how to improve country's performance in sports. Shri Modi asked individuals to send their suggestions on Narendra Modi App and also asked the different sporting bodies to submit Memorandum to the government. Saying a far sighted thinking is needed to have a better roadmap for 2020, 2024 and 2028 Olympics, Shri Modi said he has set up a committee to prepare a comprehensive action plan for the next three games. He also appealed to the state governments to set up such committees and choose one or two athletes who performed extremely well but failed to get a medal. The Prime Minister lauded badminton coach P Gopichand for being a guru to P V Sindhu, and eulogised the role teachers play in our lives. Shri Modi also remembered the Hockey legend Dhyan Chand, whose

Community interaction programme by Coast Guard Fishermen & tribals sensitized on various safety aspects at sea

Port Blair, Aug 28
Coast Guard has been interacting with fishermen and tribal population in A&N Islands for last 25 years as part of their programme for developing social connect with coastal community. During these interactions, the fishermen and tribals are informed on various safety aspects at sea while fishing such as use of life jackets, life buoys, safety equipments and functioning of distress alerts transmitters (DATs). The fishermen are trained and demonstrated on life saving techniques and procedures for passing distress message. Basic first aid tactics are also taught during such interactions. Medical camps are also conducted



in remote tribal areas during such community interactions by Coast Guard doctors. The coastal populations are sensitized on various security issues such as whom to inform when foreign poaches are sighted are how to report any suspicious activity at sea. The fishermen are informed about toll free

helpline numbers of Coast Guard Maritime Rescue Coordination Center (1554 and police marine force center 1093) to pass safety information without any delay. These interactions have enabled establishing relation between the fishermen, security

No.1-59/2011-UD. - In exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-Section 2(a) of Section 203 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Municipal) Regulation, 1994 and in supersession of Schedule-XLVI of Notification No. 152/2006/F.No.3-132/2005-LSG dated 25-08-2006, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands hereby proposes to make the following Rules regulating the method of Recruitment to **Group 'C' post of PA System Operator** borne in the Establishment of Port Blair Municipal Council, Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

And, WHEREAS, no suggestions/objections received from any quarter to this effect.
Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-Section 2 (a) of Section 203 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Municipal) Regulations, 1994 and in supersession of earlier Recruitment Rules framed to this effect, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Island hereby proposes to make the following Rules regulating the method of Recruitment to the Group 'C' post of PA System Operator borne in the Establishment of Port Blair Municipal Council with immediate effect, namely:-

1. **Short Title and Commencement:-**
(i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Port Blair Municipal Council) Recruitment Rules, 2015.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **No. of posts, its classification and the scale of pay:-**
The number of said posts, classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be specified against serial numbers 2,3 & 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications:-**
The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be specified in paras 5 to 14 of the Schedules annexed hereto.

4. **Disqualifications:-**
No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living.
(OR)
(b) who having spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), A&N Islands, may it, satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law, applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

5. **Power to relax:-**
Where the Lt. Governor (Administrator), A&N Islands is of opinion, that it is necessary or expedient, to do so, it may by order, for reason to be recorded in writing and if necessary relax any of the provisions of these rules, with respect to any class or category of person(s).

6. **Savings:-**
Nothing in those rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, ex-serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

ISRO successfully conducts scramjet engine test

Srihrikota, Aug 28
The Indian Space Research Organization ISRO has successfully test launched the Supersonic Combustion Ramjet engine, called Scramjet, this morning. The national space agency says its first ever experimental mission using the engine on-board the sounding rocket ATV02 has met all the specified goals. Scientists

claim, it is a major step towards realising an Air Breathing Propulsion System, that uses oxygen from the atmosphere for burning the fuel in rockets. At present, oxidizing agents are being used along with the fuels in the rockets, making the vehicles heavy and expensive. Once the new technology is adopted, the cost of satellite launches

would come down significantly and heavier satellites can also be launched using smaller vehicles. The rocket carrying Scramjet engines weighed 3277 kg at lift-off. With today's success, India has joined the select league of four space faring nations that have demonstrated flight testing of Scramjet engines.

RBI asks banks to provide loans to women SHGs at 7% per annum

Mumbai, Aug 28
RBI has asked banks to provide loans to women self-help groups in rural areas at 7 per cent per annum, as per the government's revised guidelines for the current financial year. The Reserve Bank said in

a notification that all women self-help groups (SHGs) will be eligible for interest subvention on credit up to three lakh rupees at 7 per cent per annum under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural

Livelihoods Mission in 250 districts. It said, SHGs availing capital subsidy under the Swarnajayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana in their existing credit outstanding will not be eligible for benefit under this scheme.
