Gulveer Singh clocks personal best to win silver in men's 1500m at Asian Games 2026

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 28

Indian athlete Gulveer Singh clinched the silver medal in the men's 1500m at the Asian Games 2026 on Monday, clocking a personal best (PB) of 3:36.72 in the final, according to the Athletics Federation of India (AFI).

Gulveer stayed in contention throughout the 12-man final before producing a strong kick in the last lap to secure the silver medal.

Japan's Kazuto Iizawa won the gold medal with a Games Record time of 3:36.35, while another Japanese athlete,



Nagiya Mori, claimed the bronze medal after clocking 3:37.92.

Gulveer finished just 0.37 seconds behind Iizawa's Games Record mark and more

than a second ahead of Mori to secure the silver.

Another Indian athlete, Yoonus Shah, finished ninth in the final with a time of 3:43.88. Gulveer's silver medal marked

an improvement for India in the men's 1500m at the Asian Games, with the country having won a bronze medal in the event at the previous edition.

The 3:36.72 timing also marked a personal best for Gulveer, who produced a career-best performance on the biggest stage to secure a place on the podium. The result added another athletics medal to India's tally at the Asian Games, with Gulveer standing on the podium after a strong finish against the Japanese duo.

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 28

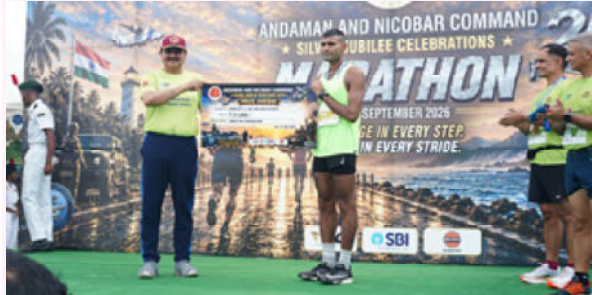
Indian athlete Vithya Ramraj clinched the bronze medal in the women's 400m hurdles at the Asian Games 2026 on Monday, clocking a personal best of 54.75 seconds and breaking a national record that had stood since 1984.

Vithya cleared all 10 hurdles to finish third in the final, producing a record-breaking performance in Aichi-Nagoya, according to the Athletics Federation of India (AFI).

She broke the previous national record of 55.42 seconds, set by legendary Indian athlete PT Usha at the 1984 Los Angeles Olympics. Vithya had earlier equalled the same mark in 2023.
