## Excellent opportunity for entrepreneurs Financial assistance under PMEGP scheme for setting up units for manufacturing of leaf cup & plates

Port Blair, Oct 28 In pursuance to the decision taken during the meeting held recently under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, the A&N Islands Khadi & Village Industries Board has decided to promote few leaf cup/plates manufacturing units under PMEGP scheme as a substitute for plastic and thermocole cup/plates which are non-biodegradable. Arecanut is an important plantation crop in A&N



Islands. The leaf of the arecanut tree is invariably wasted at present. It is a hard material and has good tensile strength. It does not have the manure value as it takes more time for natural decomposing nor does it have fuel value due to low calorific worth. Hence it is burnt in the field

**India to host 1 of 3 men's Hockey Series Finals from June 6 to 16**

New Delhi, Oct 28  
India will host one of the men's FIH Hockey Series Finals from June 6 to 16, a tournament from where two teams will make the cut for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics qualifiers. The top two teams from each FIH Series Finals will secure a place in the Tokyo Olympics' qualification events to be held in November next year. Besides hosts India, other teams in the event are Asian Games champions Japan, Mexico, Poland, Russia, South Africa, USA. One more team is yet to be confirmed. The venue for the India-leg of Hockey Series Final will also be finalised later.

Three pools of eight teams each for men as well as women will compete in these events, which will gather the best-ranked teams not involved in the FIH Pro League. The Malaysian capital of Kuala Lumpur and Le Touquet (France) will host the other two legs of the men's competition. The Malaysian leg will be held from April 26 to May 4 and will be contested by Malaysia, Austria, Brazil, Canada, China, Italy, Vanuatu and Wales while Chile, France, Ireland, Korea, Scotland, Singapore and two more unconfirmed teams will compete in the Le Touquet leg from June 15 to 23. All teams have qualified

through the Hockey Series Open. Five more teams — two men's and two women's teams from Africa as well as one men's team from Asia — will qualify for the FIH Series Finals through the remaining Hockey Series Open events due to be played in Africa (December 7-9 in Zimbabwe) and Asia (date and venue to be confirmed). The women's competition will be hosted by Ireland (June 8 to 16), Japan (June 15 to 23) and Valencia (June 19 to 27). The Indian women will feature in the Japan leg of the Hockey Series Finals which will also have Chile, Fiji, hosts Japan, Mexico, Poland, Russia and Uruguay.

**Virat Kohli becomes 1st Indian with 3 consecutive centuries in ODI cricket**

Pune, Oct 28  
Indian skipper Virat Kohli on Saturday became the first Indian player to hit three consecutive hundreds on ODI cricket. He also became the first player to score centuries in four successive ODI innings against the opponent. Kohli, who led team India in the third ODI against West Indies, had struck 140 runs off 107 balls in the first ODI against Windies. India had won the 1st match by 8 wickets. The Indian skipper then scored 157 runs in the second match against the touring team. The second match however ended in a tie. The third match also saw Kohli in a clinical form when he struck 107 off 119 balls. Kohli had been dismissed twice in the series. Prior to series with West Indies, Kohli had also struck a century against New Zealand in the ODI match. The record for most tons against an opponent in ODI cricket is



still held by Sachin Tendulkar who has nine ODI centuries against Australia. Prior to this, Kohli achieved another milestone when he surpassed Sachin Tendulkar's record and became the fastest batsman to reach 10,000 runs in ODI cricket. Kohli has accumulated 10,000 runs in just 205 innings with an average of 58.69 which is the highest in ODI cricket amongst batsmen who have played at least 50 matches. Legendary batsman Sachin Tendulkar achieved the feat in 259 innings while Sourav Ganguly and Ricky Ponting

needed 263 and 266 innings respectively. Kohli enjoys the unique distinction of scoring 15 more hundreds than Sachin Tendulkar after 205 innings in ODI Cricket. He also emerged as the second youngest batsman after the "Little Master" to aggregate 10,000 ODI runs in cricketing history. Kohli has been in excellent form for India in recent times especially during the away tour against England where he emerged as one of the highest run-getters. He has retained the same form during the ODI series against West Indies despite being rested for the Asia Cup.

**Pranjala Yadlapalli qualifies for main draw of WTA tennis tournament**



Mumbai, Oct 28  
India number three Pranjala Yadlapalli qualified for the main draw of a WTA tennis event for the first time in Mumbai today. Pranjala outclassed her Georgian opponent Oksana Kalashnikova in straight sets in the second and final qualifying round match of the L&T Mumbai Open at the Cricket Club of India (CCI). With this qualification, Pranjala joined

her Indian compatriots - India number one Anika Raina and wild cards Karman Kaur Thandi and Rutuja Bhosale in the main draw of 32. The tournament will commence on Tuesday after tomorrow's rest day introduced at the last moment to avoid the matches clashing with the fourth cricket ODI between India and the West Indies to be played at the same venue.

**Fourth ODI between India and West Indies to be played in Mumbai today**

Mumbai, Oct 28  
In cricket, the fourth One-day International match between India and the West Indies, will be played at the Cricket Club of India (CCI) in Mumbai tomorrow. The match will begin at 1.30 p.m. The series is tied at 1-1 with two matches to go. With the defeat in the third ODI by 43 runs in Pune yesterday, India ended up as the losing side for the first time in the home series against the West Indies. Another win for West Indies will make them the only team to beat India twice in a home ODI



series since October, 2016. India will, therefore, be in a must win situation at the Cricket Club of India. With tomorrow's encounter, international cricket returns to the CCI, which last hosted a Test in 2009 and an ODI back in 2006.

**Indian golfer Khalin Joshi clinches Panasonic Open India title**

New Delhi, Oct 28  
Indian golfer Khalin Joshi clinched the Panasonic Open India title at the Delhi Golf Club today. With this win, Joshi became the seventh Indian to win the Panasonic Open India title in the last eight editions of the tournament. It was also his maiden Asian Tour title. Overnight joint leader Joshi carded four under 68 on the final day to win the title by one



stroke with a four day aggregate of 17-under. Bangladesh's Siddikur Rahman finished second best after finishing with a par on the 18th.

**Nishikori, Anderson reach Vienna final**

Vienna, Oct 28  
Kei Nishikori will have a chance to win his first ATP title in over two years on Sunday after beating qualifier Mikhail Kukushkin 6-4 6-3 to reach the Vienna Open final. The Japanese, ranked 11th in the world, will face this year's

Wimbledon runner-up Kevin Anderson after the South African beat Spaniard Fernando Verdasco 6-3 3-6 6-4. Nishikori, who won the last of his 11 titles in Memphis in 2016, will attempt to end a run of eight successive defeats in tournament finals. On Saturday, he missed three break points in the first set before finally breaking in the 10th game with an aggressive forehand winner. Another break early in the second set was enough to ensure victory against his 71st-ranked opponent.
