

## District Administration conducts eviction drive against encroachment on Govt. revenue land

### 3.1985 hecsts at Manjery & 60 sq. mtrs & 120 sq. mtrs areas at Aberdeen village restored

Port Blair, Sept. 1  
The District Administration has been carrying out eviction drives against encroachment on Government revenue land in the South Andaman District. In this connection, an unauthorized occupation over Sy. No 231 area 3.1985 hecsts situated at village Manjery identified for water aerodrome has been removed today in the presence of Tehsildar, Ferrargunj and same has been restored in favour of Revenue



Department. Further, the Khasra Register depicting the unauthorized occupation has also been corrected and the entry has been cancelled. In a landmark move, the District Administration has taken back the possession of land bearing Sy.No.1969/2 and 1971/4 area 60 sq. mtrs and 120 sq. mtrs, situated at Aberdeen village under Port Blair Tehsil which was allotted on lease basis



for a period of 5 years, which had expired on 06.01.1992 and the land revenue was also stopped from 1992. Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner (SA) lauded the efforts of the Revenue Field Staff and further cautioned the general public to refrain from indulging in such illegal encroachments. ## 64.98 % of population vaccinated in Isles so far

### Health Department urges remaining beneficiaries to get themselves vaccinated to fight corona virus

Port Blair, Sept. 1

Ever since the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the A & N Administration has taken all precautionary measures, to protect



its citizens from the virus. The COVID-19 vaccine introduced in India is as effective as any vaccine developed by other countries. The safety and efficacy data from clinical trials of vaccine candidates are examined by drug regulator of the country before granting license for the same. Hence, all the COVID-19 vaccines that has been granted license is safe. The vaccination of eligible beneficiaries was initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands keeping the safety of the

citizens at the fore. The vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with co-morbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway. About 64.98 % of population in the Islands have been vaccinated with first dose, however, many are still left behind. Therefore, Islanders who have not yet received their

## Citizen Centric Initiative by A&N Administration

### About 28218 certificates amounting to Rs.1216929/- generated through online e-stamping facility so far

Port Blair, Sept. 1  
The A&N Administration in collaboration with Stock Holding Corporation of India Limited had launched the online payment for stamp duty and printing of e-Stamp Certificate on 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2020, which has become very popular among the general public, as the system allows them to buy e-stamps upto a maximum of Rs.1000/- as per their convenience from their place. It is



worthwhile to mention that around 28218 certificates for an amount of Rs.1216929/- has been generated through this system, since its launch in A&N

Islands till 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2021. The basic requirements for online e-stamping is any handheld device with internet connection and printer. Citizen may visit the website www.shcilestamp.com and login as guest or proceed to register. After registration with basic details, a URL will be sent to the registered mail id for activation which has to be activated by the user. This user credentials can be used across all online products of e-Stamping (non-judicial) and e-Court fee (judicial). The same user credentials are

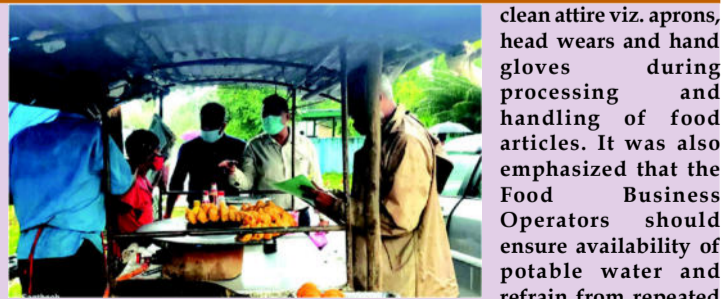

processing and handling of food articles prepared and displayed for sale in their respective premises. All street food vendors were instructed to be dressed in proper

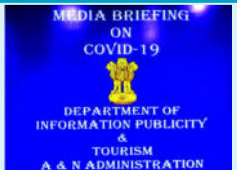

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening said that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 703 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 4



flights with 699 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 81 passengers bound for

The eligible beneficiaries who are also due for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose have been asked to reach their nearest COVID Vaccination Centres and get their doses of vaccine. As per the data available, 3,66,192 eligible beneficiaries have been inoculated in these Islands so far, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 2011 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. A total of 147,855 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date. Meanwhile, 1614 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 1218 were in the age group of 18-44 years. 385 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 324 were in the age group of 18-44 years while 12 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 7 were in the age group of 18-44 years


