ANPCC creates awareness on single use plastic at Chouldari

200 cloth bags distributed to general public in exchange of plastic carry bags

Port Blair, Mar. 28 As part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' and to eliminate the use of single use plastic in A&N Islands, A&N Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC), Department of Science & Technology, Andaman & Nicobar Administration conducted an awareness programme during which cloth bags were distributed in the Sunday market of Chouldari yesterday. The ANPCC highlighted the ill-effects of single



use plastic and also motivated the public for carrying cloth bag and discouraged the use of single use carry bags. During the awareness programme, the Department distributed around 200 cloth bags to the general public, free of cost in exchange of

plastic carry bags. About 3 kg of plastic bags were collected from general public. The main motive of the programme was to make general public aware of the harmful effect of single use plastic as well as to bring down the usage of single use plastic and to encourage the use of alternatives of

single use plastic. The Hon'ble Prime Minister has reviewed the issue of single use plastic in PRAGATI meeting and committed to eliminate the use of single use plastic by July 2022. As per data available, a total of 6,09,840 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,329 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 8134 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries

DGCA monitors airfares on certain routes on monthly basis to ensure reasonable airfares

New Delhi, Mar. 28 (PIB)

Air fares are not regulated by the Governments. Under the provision of Sub Rule (1) of Rule 135, aircraft Rules 1937, airlines are free to fix reasonable tariff having regard to all relevant factors, including the cost of operation, characteristics of service, reasonable profit and the generally prevailing tariff. Air fare so established by the airlines is published on their respective website under the provision of Sub Rule (2) of Rule 135, Aircraft Rules 1937.

In order to prevent excessive charging and sudden surges in airfares and to promote transparency by scheduled domestic airlines, Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued Air Transport Circular 02 of 2010 wherein airlines are required to display on their

respective websites the tariff sheet route-wise across their network in various fare categories and the manner it is offered in the market.

DGCA has a Tariff Monitoring Unit that monitors airfares on certain routes on monthly basis to ensure that the airlines do not charge airfares outside a range declared by them.

During the last two years, the COVID-19 pandemic has adversely impacted the revenue streams of businesses including aviation sector. Under normal circumstances, airfares are neither regulated by the Government.

However, due to the unprecedented circumstances, fare bands with upper and lower limits were introduced by the Government as a special measure. The fare bands serve the dual purpose of protecting the

interests of the travelers as well as of the airlines.

The fare bands were revised from time to time in view of the substantial hike in price of Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) in order to keep the aviation sector viable while protecting the interests of the passengers. Presently, fare capping is applicable on a rolling basis for a 15 days' cycle.

The Government regularly reviews the situation. Further, decisions regarding the domestic scheduled operations and relaxation in fare capping is subject to prevailing COVID-19 situation, status of operations and passenger demand for air travel.

This information was given by the Minister of State in the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Gen. (Dr) V. K. Singh (Retd) in a written reply to a question in Rajya Sabha today.

India administers 183.26 crore COVID vaccine doses under Nationwide Vaccination Drive



New Delhi, Mar. 28

More than 183 crore and 26 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under N a t i o n w i d e Vaccination Drive.

Health Ministry said, more than four lakh 20 thousand doses were administered in the last 24 hours. During the same period, a total of one thousand 270 new cases were reported in the country. India's Active caseload currently stands at 15 thousand 859 and it is at 0.04 percent. The recovery rate is

currently at 98.75 percent. A total of one thousand 567 people recovered in the last 24 hours and total recoveries touched over four crore 24 lakh.

The weekly positivity rate currently stands at 0.26 percent while the Daily positivity rate is at 0.29 percent. A total of 78 crore 73 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, more than four lakh 32 thousand tests were conducted. (Source: india.gov.in)

Various steps have been taken by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to expand the reach of UPI outside India. This was stated by Union Minister of State for Finance, Dr Bhagwat Kisanrao Karad in a written reply to a question in Lok Sabha today. The steps are given below:-

Partnerships will facilitate Indian travellers to make payments using the BHIM UPI QR for all their retail purchases at international merchant establishments. Currently, BHIM UPI QR has gained acceptance in Singapore (March, 2020), Bhutan (July, 2021) and recently with partners in UAE and Nepal (February, 2022). However, travel restrictions owing to the pandemic over the last two years have impacted overseas use of this facility.

In this regard, RBI has been facilitating engagements for the expansion of UPI in countries which have potential for collaboration. These
