## Chief Secretary holds meeting with political parties on COVID-19

### Second wave of virus is more lethal and without synchronized efforts we cannot win the war against the Pandemic: CS

### Seeks support of political parties cutting across party lines to save humanity

### Success in the fight against virus depends on people adhering to COVID appropriate behaviour

Port Blair, April 28  
The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain called upon the Political Parties to support Administration in its fight against the pandemic in Isles. "We are fighting a global war against corona", said the Chief Secretary during his interaction with the Representatives of various Political Parties of Andaman and Nicobar Islands on COVID -19 in the conference hall of Secretariat this morning. He pointed out that the second wave of the virus is more lethal and without synchronized efforts, it would be difficult to deal with the situation. Paramount importance is being given to protect lives of Islanders from the



deadly virus and Administration has taken various steps to arrest the spread of the virus in the Islands, he said. He urged the Political Parties to extend their full co-operation to the Administration in its fight against COVID-19. The Chief Secretary observed that success in the fight against COVID-19 mainly depends on people adhering to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) issued by GoI and urged political parties to join hands

with the Administration to sensitize people on this count. The Chief Secretary urged all political parties to work in unison with the Administration. Outlining the steps taken by the Administration to tackle the situation, the Chief Secretary said that the Administration has a augmented medical supplies viz. PPE kit and Oxygen Cylinder since March 1, 2021. He said vacation for schools has been declared from May 1

and to facilitate movement of people, particularly teachers to reach their respective place of stay, ATR will be opened for three days. To facilitate stranded people at Hut Bay, Car Nicobar & Campbell Bay, special vessels will be deployed to bring them back. The labourers too, who are stuck here will be allowed to move out of the Islands. He categorically stated that it will be the sole responsibility of the contractors to feed the labourers, if they keep the

labourers with them, the Chief Secretary said. He further said that for the safety of the Islanders first. As there was no unison among the political parties on whether to keep liquor shops open or not, he said, the Administration will soon take a balanced decision on this. The Chief Secretary further said that we have 40 ventilators as of now. However, we don't have sufficient number of Anesthetists to operate it. At present, we have only 6 Anesthetists, of

which one each have been deputed in Nicobar and North & Middle Andaman Districts and 4 are in Port Blair. To augment the requirement of more anesthetists, a recruitment for the same was done and not a single anesthetist is ready to serve in these Islands, despite being offered handsome salary and other amenities, the Chief Secretary added. In the absence of sufficient number of anesthetist, the Administration is finding it difficult to make operational all the available ventilators. Regarding reducing the RTPCR testing time, the CS said, the testing follows a protocol and therefore it cannot be reduced. The Chief Secretary said that people are not maintaining social distancing in big shops which is a matter of great concern and action has been initiated against some shops for not adhering to COVID protocols. He also disclosed that

## Over 14,400 ha area in Andaman & Nicobar becomes first large territory to get organic certification

New Delhi, April 28  
About 14,491 hectare (ha) area in Andaman and Nicobar has been certified as organic, the first large contiguous territory to be done under a government scheme, Agriculture Ministry said on Tuesday. After Andaman and Nicobar (A&N) Islands, Lakshadweep and Ladakh are proactively taking steps for the transformation of their traditional organic areas to certified organic, it said.



There are traditional areas in Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, north-eastern states and tribal belts of Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh and desert districts of Rajasthan which can be transformed to certified organic, it said.

The organic certification has been given under the Large Area Certification (LAC) Scheme of the PGS-India (Participatory Guarantee System) certification programme.

Under LAC, each village in the area is considered as one cluster/group. All farmers with their farmland and livestock need to adhere to the standard requirements and on being verified get certified enmass without the need to go under conversion period. Certification is renewed on annual basis through verification by a process of peer appraisals as per the process of PGS-India. In a statement, the Ministry said it is working to identify traditional organic areas to transform them into certified production hubs.

"The Government of India has certified 14,491 ha of such area under Car Nicobar and Nancowry group of Islands in A&N Islands," it said.

An expert committee has verified their organic status and recommended for declaration of the area as certified organic under the PGS-India certification programme, it said, adding that this area becomes the first large contiguous territory to be conferred with organic certification.

According to the Ministry, Car Nicobar and Nancowry group of Islands have been traditionally organic for ages. The Administration has also banned the sale, purchase and usage of any chemical inputs of genetically modified seeds in these Islands.

numbers are not coming down which, he said, is a matter of grave concern. The Secretary further informed that an important decision has been taken by the Administration today to create a 'Rescue Cell' which will be headed by the Secretary (IT) with two members viz. Secretary (Personnel) and Secretary (APWD). The focus of the Cell is to co-ordinate on matters related to medical supplies, food, transportation of stranded labourers in any kind of eventuality during the pandemic and bringing back stranded islanders from mainland. The needy people can contact the Control Room of the South Andaman District on phone numbers 240127, 238881, toll free no. 1077 and a Whatsapp No. 9531888844 in which they can send the information and their grievances. Any crisis related to food, transportation, medical supplies and evacuation of stranded labourers can be intimated in these numbers for its immediate solution, the Secretary said.

As far as the medical supplies are concerned, the Administration is in a comfortable position as of now. He said, the Administration is closely monitoring the COVID situation, the number of active cases, the number of supplies and the amount of medical supplies required.

The Secretary informed that the Govt. of India is launching the vaccination drive for the persons aged 18 to 44. The Administration has placed orders with the Serum Institute of India for sufficient doses of COVISHIELD vaccines to cover the eligible persons in the age group of 18-44 years. The A&N Administration will chalk out a plan for vaccination for the new age group as soon as the vaccine is received from Serum Institute of India.

The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Shri Amitabha De answered the queries raised by the media.

The Director, IP&T, Shri Alok Kumar and the Deputy Director, IP, Shri RS Meena also attended the press conference.

(Contd. from page 1) communities prepared the island-wise and farmer wise database of land holding, practices being adopted, input usage history among others.

Stating that there are still traditional organic areas in hills, tribal districts, desert and rained areas in India that continue to remain free from chemical input usage, the Ministry said, "With little efforts, such traditional/default organic areas can be brought under organic certification almost immediately."

The Ministry said it is, in consultation with states, working to identify such areas, transform them to certified organic and facilitate the marketing of area-specific niche products through branding and labelling.

Additionally, to bring isolated individual farmers to the certified organic fold, the Ministry has also launched an organic certification support scheme under PKVY (Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana).

Under the scheme, individual farmers can avail financial assistance for certification under any of the prevailing certification systems of NPOP (National Programme for Organic Production) or PGS-India. Assistance will be available as reimbursement of certification cost directly to certification agencies through the States, the Ministry said.

The organic certification will help farmers get direct access to the emerging organic food market of the country.

India now has more than 30 lakh hectare area registered under organic certification and slowly more and more farmers are joining the movement.

As per the international survey report (2021) India ranks at 5<sup>th</sup> place in terms of area and is at the top in terms of total number of producers (base year 2019), the Ministry added. (Source: The Economic Times quoting PTI)

**Over 3,60,000 fresh cases reported in country; Over 2,61,000 people recover in last 24 hours**

New Delhi, April 28 The Health Ministry informed that at present, there are over 29 lakh 78 thousand active cases in the country which comprises 16.55 per cent of the total positive cases. The Ministry has said, more than 2,61,000 people have recovered from the coronavirus infection in the last 24 hours. The country has informed on Wednesday that over 3,60,000 fresh cases have been reported in the country within 24 hours. This is the highest number of cases registered in a day since the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in several States and Union Territories. The Ministry has

the Administration is also contemplating to close down shops, except essential items viz. bakery, meat & chicken shop, ration, medicine shop. The Chief Secretary further stated that to facilitate people with essential items, efforts will be made to ensure such items are made available within the vicinity of the people to avoid unnecessary movement. The Chief Secretary requested the general public and said, "remain indoors, be with your family at home". He called upon the political parties to motivate the workers and eligible beneficiaries to come forward for vaccination.

The Chief Secretary expressed his concern over the continued large gathering at many religious places and asked political parties and religious leaders to support the Administration on this issue. He said for the easy access of the Islanders in different States, the Administration has started a Rescue Cell with dedicated officers. People who need help can contact the Officers at the Rescue Cell for assistance.

The Chief Secretary directed the Deputy Commissioner to devise some mechanism so that the livelihood of the fishermen continues and their safety is taken care of.

Political parties functioning in A&N Islands cutting across party lines assured all possible support and cooperation to the Administration in the war against the pandemic. They offered several suggestions and the Chief Secretary gave necessary directions to look into it on priority.

**DRDO conducts maiden trial of Python-5 Air to Air Missile**



New Delhi, April 28 (PIB)

Tejas, India's indigenous Light Combat Aircraft, added the 5th generation Python-5 Air-to-Air Missile (AAM) in its air-to-air weapons capability on April 27, 2021. Trials were also aimed to validate enhanced capability of already integrated Derby Beyond Visual Range (BVR) AAM on Tejas. The test firing at Goa completed a series of missile trials to validate its performance under extremely challenging scenarios. Derby missile achieved direct hit on a high-speed maneuvering aerial target and the Python missiles also achieved 100% hits, thereby validating their complete capability. The trials met all their planned objectives.

Prior to these trials, extensive missile carriage flight tests were conducted at Bengaluru to assess integration of the missile with aircraft systems on board the Tejas, like Avionics, Fire-control radar, Missile Weapon Delivery System and the Flight Control System. At Goa, after successful separation trials, live launch of the missile on

a Banshee target was carried out. Python-5 missile live firing was conducted to validate target engagement from all aspects as well as beyond visual ranges. In all the live firings, missile hit the aerial target.

The missiles were fired from Tejas aircraft of Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) flown by Indian Air Force (IAF) Test pilots belonging to National Flight Test Centre (NFTC). The successful conduct was made possible with years of hard work by the team of scientists, engineers and technicians from ADA and HAL-ARDC along with admirable support from CEMILAC, DG-AQA, IAF PMT, NPO (LCA Navy) and INS HANSA.

Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh has congratulated the teams of DRDO, ADA, Indian Air Force, HAL and all involved in the trial. Secretary Department of Defence R&D and Chairman DRDO, Dr G Satheesh Reddy appreciated the efforts of scientists, engineers and technicians from various organisations and industry.

State wise status above was reviewed and shared with all the participants. It was decided to

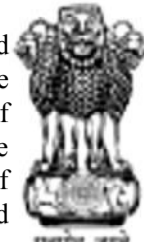

**ICMR intensifies efforts to enhance availability of Covid testing kits, newer innovative testing solutions**

The Indian Council of Medical Research has intensified its efforts to enhance availability of COVID-19 testing kits and newer innovative testing solutions amid the rising cases of coronavirus in India. ICMR has proposed to exempt several reputed



global agencies from validation criteria for RTPCR, RAT, home based testing solution, antigen, antibody ELISA and rapid antibody tests. It further proposed to accord marketing permission by Drugs Controller General of India on the basis of existing approvals. Several global agencies of Europe, Japan, South Korea, Australia, Brazil and the agencies listed in the World

Health Organization's emergency use listing will benefit from this move. At present, kits approved by the US Food and Drug Administration under regular or emergency use are exempted from validation in India. It qualifies for direct marketing permission from the Drug Controller General of India. (Source:india.gov.in)

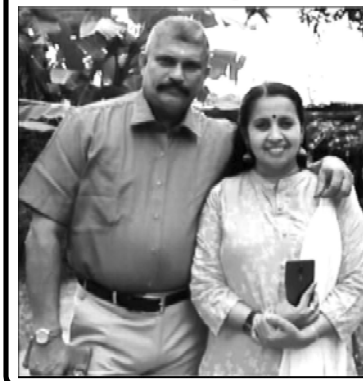
