Additional restrictions imposed to contain spread of COVID-19

Chief Secretary issues order for

- Complete Lockdown on weekends
- Seven day quarantine for passengers or till tested negative
- Rate for RT-PCR test fixed at Rs. 2400/-
- No convoy movement through Jarawa reserve

Port Blair, July 28

Ever since the outbreak of the COVID-19 in the Islands, the Andaman and Nicobar Administration has taken various measures to contain the spread of Corona Virus. Currently, the UT is conducting 56368 tests per million, which is highest in the country. The fatality rate is only 0.3% which is substantially lower than the national average. Despite the fact that the Administration has taken serious steps towards containing the virus, the number of positive cases has gone up substantially in the past two weeks.

Considering the rise in the number of COVID-19 cases, it became imperative for the A&N Administration to impose additional restrictions in order to control further spread of the virus across the Islands.

Accordingly, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, vide an order dated 28th July, 2020 has imposed additional steps for the containment of the disease in A&N

Islands.

As per the order, complete lockdown will be imposed on weekends i.e. Saturday and Sunday till the situation improves in the Islands. All the Government/UT/Local bodies shops etc., shall remain closed during the lockdown period. In addition to this, all mainland and Inter-Island passengers/travellers shall be home quarantined for 07 days from the day they enter into the Islands/ Districts or till they are tested negative, whichever is earlier. Passengers who are not residents of Port Blair/Ferrargunj Tehsil will have to pay for the Institutional quarantine.

The Government Servants returning from mainland will work from home till they are tested negative for Corona. The rate for RT-PCR test has been fixed at Rs.2400/- per test in line with the rate fixed by the Ministry. Passengers arriving at airport from mainland and destined to tribal areas will be tested with RT-PCR test.

Other directives include no convoy will

pass through Jarawa reserve till further orders and the Shipping Department has been directed to increase the frequency of ships/boats to facilitate smooth transportation for the people of North and Middle Andaman. The Nodal Officer for COVID-19 will take daily samples from crowded places and regular random testing of frontline staff will also be carried out.

Since the commencement of the flight operations to the Islands post unlock-I, there has been huge influx of passengers from COVID-19 hotspots of mainland, resulting in significant increase in the number of COVID-19 cases in the UT. Therefore, to minimize the number of air travellers to the Islands, the UT Administration has requested the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Govt. of India to restrict the flight operations to Port Blair with weekly one flight only. This will help the A&N Administration to tackle the present health care challenge. (Detail order is on page 2)

ORDER

Whereas, as per order F. No. CS/Sr.PS/05/2020 dated 30/06/2020, the Guidelines for Phased Reopening (Unlock 2), issued vide MHA order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 29/06/2020 have been made applicable to whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Whereas, as per Point no.5 of these guidelines, States/UTs, based on their assessment of the situation, may prohibit certain activities outside the containment zones, or impose such restrictions as deemed necessary.

Whereas, in view of increasing of number of COVID-19 cases in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, it is deemed necessary that additional restrictions be imposed.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act 2005, the undersigned in the capacity as Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee, for the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby order that following additional steps will also be taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Andaman and Nicobar Islands:

1. Complete lockdown will be imposed on weekends i.e. Saturday and Sunday till the situation improves in the Islands. All the offices of Government of India/UT/local bodies, shops, commercial and private establishments, industrial establishments, transport services, hospitality services, etc. shall remain closed during the lockdown period. However, essential services such as water, electricity, sanitation, hospitals, veterinary hospitals, medical establishments including their manufacturing and distribution units both in public and private sector such as dispensary, chemists, pharmacies (including Jan Aushadhi Kendra), medical equipment shops, laboratories, nursing homes, ambulance, police, fire and emergency services, Disaster Management, Prison Management, the transportation services involved in logistics of essential services will remain exempted from the lockdown.
 2. All mainland and inter island passengers/travellers shall be home quarantined for seven days from the day they enter into the island/district or till they are tested negative, whichever is earlier.
 3. Passengers who are not residents of Port Blair/ Ferrargunj Tehsil will have to pay for the institutional quarantine on rates fixed by General Administration Department.
 4. The Government servants returning from mainland will work from home, till they are tested negative for Corona.
 5. The rate for RT-PCR test is fixed at Rs.2400/- per test in line with the rate fixed by the Ministry. The passengers who are asymptomatic and not covered under filters and relaxations allowed by the administration, but want to test themselves voluntarily, will have to pay for the test.
 6. The passengers arriving at airport from mainland and destined to tribal areas will be tested with RT-PCR test. All other asymptomatic traveller from mainland will be tested by Antigen test. Symptomatic traveller/ ILI cases to be tested as per existing protocols.
 7. Nodal Officer COVID-19 to take daily samples from crowded places like vegetable market fish market etc. Regular random testing of the frontline staff to be done.
 8. No convoy will pass through Jarawa reserve till further orders. Shipping department to increase frequency of ships/ boats to facilitate smooth communication to the people of North and Middle Andaman District.
 9. Notices to be pasted at a conspicuous place on the houses of the persons who are under quarantine/ isolation and suspect/ confirmed cases.
 10. DCs to coordinate and supervise surveillance and enforcement by Police, Transport Department, local bodies and other departments.
 11. Concerned DCs should ensure effective implementation of the order and penalties be imposed for any violations.
- This order shall remain in force till further orders.
