The meeting was the third in a series of meetings between Shri Narendra Modi and MPs which would continue till 31st of this month.

Supreme Court bans sale of BS-III vehicles from 1 April

New Delhi, Mar 29 The Supreme Court has refused to grant any relief to manufacturers of BS-IV non-compliant vehicles and has directed that such vehicles will not be sold in India with effect of April 1, 2017.

The Supreme Court today banned the sale and registration of vehicles which are not compliant with BS-IV emission norms from April 1 across the country. The apex court observed that the "health of the people is far more important than the commercial interest of automobile manufactures". A bench of Justices Madan B Lokur and Deepak Gupta prohibited registration of any vehicles which do not meet the Bharat Stage-IV emission norm standards from April 1. The BS-IV emission norms will come into force from April 1, 2017. The top court had yesterday reserved its verdict on pleas seeking ban on the sale and registration of BS-III compliant vehicles after April 1. The Society of Indian



Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM) had earlier submitted data on manufacturing and sale of BS-III vehicles on a monthly basis from January 2016 and told the court that the companies were holding

stock of around 8.24 lakh such vehicles including 96,000 commercial vehicles, over six lakh two-wheelers and around 40,000 three-wheelers. The manufacturers had also told the court that they were

CBDT refuses to grant relief to those who failed to submit 1st installment under IDS

New Delhi, Mar 29 The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has refused to grant any relief to those black money declarants who failed to submit their first installment of tax and penalty under the Income Disclosure Scheme, IDS. The Income Tax Department made it clear that such condonation of delay in making payments by the deadline of November 30, 2016 will be discriminatory against those declarants of the IDS, who adhered to the deadline and paid the tax, surcharge and penalty on the stash declared by them. The Board issued an order

yesterday clarifying its position after some declarants who have paid the first installment either belatedly, after November 30 last year, or have not yet made the payment, requested it to extend the due date. The CBDT, early this year, had made it clear through an order that any payment of first installment made by November 30 will be valid if the amount was credited even by 5th of December 2016. Under the IDS 2016 scheme, a declarant was required to pay the first installment of the 25 per cent of total liability of tax, surcharge and penalty on or before 30th of November last year.

Country's coast line is totally secure: MoS Home

New Delhi, Mar 29 Minister of State for Home Affairs Shri Kiren Rijiju has said that the country's coast line is totally secure. Replying to supplementaries during Question Hour in the Rajya Sabha today, he said the effective steps taken after 26/11 attack in Mumbai have resulted as no such incident could take place after that.

He said, Indian Navy and other central and state agencies are working in a synchronized way to protect the over 7,500 km coastline. Space based transponders have strengthen the coastal security. Shri Rijiju informed that four abandoned boats have been seized this year. He said 11 abandoned boats were seized last year and four were seized in 2015.

NEET: CBSE gives 4 days to candidates for revising options for exam centres

New Delhi, Mar 29 The Central Board of Secondary Education, CBSE has given four more days to the candidates appearing in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test for revising the options for examination cities centres. The NEET, for admission to MBBS and BDS courses will be held on 7th of May this year. Now students can change the option of cities of examination centres till 31st of this month by logging on to NEET website. Besides, the CBSE has also added one more city- Nanded of Maharashtra for conducting the examination.

Maternity Benefit Programme

Financial assistance to pregnant & lactating women for first two births

Port Blair, Mar 29 With an aim to improve the health and nutrition status of pregnant and lactating women as part of compensation for wage loss during pregnancy and lactation period to individuals fulfilling specific conditions linked to maternal and child care behavior and responses, the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Gol has approved Maternity Benefit Programme (MBP) for all the districts in the country. The scheme was initially implemented in South Andaman District during the year 2010 while from Feb 1, 2017 onwards, it is being extended to other Districts of North & Middle Andaman as well as

Nicobar District. Under the Maternity Benefit Programme (MBP), a cash incentive of Rs. 6000/- will be provided to every pregnant and lactating woman of 19 years and above, for their first two live births, subject to the woman fulfilling specific conditions relating to maternal child health and nutrition. He said, the cash benefit will be provided in three installments. The first installment of Rs. 3000 would be provided before delivery with the minimum condition of registration of pregnancy and one antenatal checkup. The second installment of Rs. 1500/- would be provided after delivery of the child on producing a certificate from the Medical Officer

that the delivery has taken place in a medical facility approved by Health & Family Department. The third and final installment of Rs. 1500/- would be provided after completion of the first cycle of immunization of the child. The first installment will be released preferably within four months of pregnancy and the last installment will be provided after three and half months to four months after delivery while the final installment shall not be delayed by more than six

months after delivery, informed the ICDS Programme Officer of Directorate of Social Welfare, Shri James. The mode of payment to the beneficiaries will solely be made by Direct Benefit Transfer through Public Financial Management System (PFMS). The beneficiaries' account number bank/post office account has to be seeded with Aadhaar number for receiving the amount, he said. (Contd. on last page)

Packaged drinking water not to be sold beyond MRP: Civil Supplies Deptt



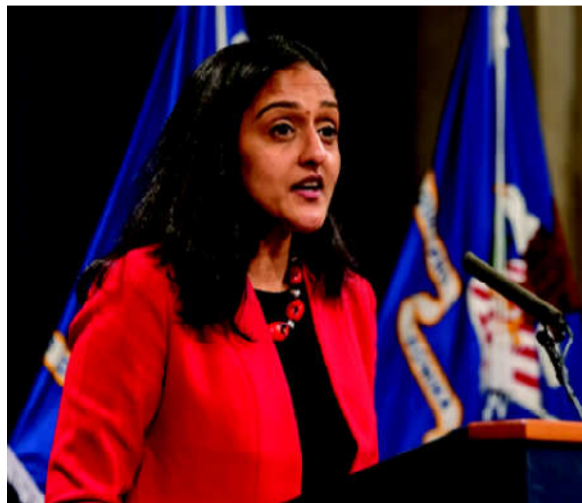

Under the MBP scheme, so far 3055 beneficiaries have been identified in South Andaman District under ICDS Project, Urban & Ferrargunj during 2016-17. The remaining ICDS Projects, Rangat, Diglipur and Car Nicobar have been included from Feb, 2017 and the beneficiaries will receive their benefits once the numbers of beneficiaries have been identified.
As per the guidelines, this scheme is not applicable to pregnant and lactating mothers in regular employment with the Central Government or the State Government or the Public Sector Undertakings or those who are in receipt of similar benefits by law for time being in force.
