## 15-year contract with M/s SPCL expires on 31st March Work for commissioning of 5 MW DG Power Plants on war footing; likely to start delivering power by Apr 2/3

Port Blair, Mar.29

The Electricity Department has informed that the 15-year contract of M/s SPCL is expiring on 31st March, 2018 due to which there will be power deficit of around 6.5 MW. However, the Department has initiated numerous short and long term projects for resolving the power crisis.

Of the many projects and to offset this shortage, the Electricity Department, under the aegis of A&N Administration and under the guidance of the Ministry of Power, GoI



have signed an agreement with the NVVN (100% subsidiary of NTPC) for establishment of 5 MW and 10 MW DG Power Plants at Port Blair at the earliest.

Of these two power plants, the work for the commissioning of 05 MW

DG Power Plants is going on war footing and is likely to start delivering the power by 2nd/3rd April, 2018. Once this Power Plant is operational it is likely to counter the deficit arrived due to the closure of M/s SPCL. 5 MW site is under development by M/s

Aggreko Energy Rental India Pvt. Ltd. at Chatham Power House.

The tender for 10 MW Power Plant will be opened on 04th April, 2018 and it is expected that 50% of the capacity shall be added in the grid by mid-May, 2018.

Meanwhile, the residents of the Islands have also been requested to conserve electricity and regulate consumption by following prudent practice, a communication from the Superintendent Engineer, Electricity Deptt said here today.

As the sun disappeared over the horizon, a glorious era of Indian Coast Guard Ship Bhikaji Cama came to an end on Mar 27, 2018. Prior de-commissioning, the ship was based at Port Blair under Coast Guard Region (A&N). The ship was decommissioned in a traditional ceremony held at Chennai Port. The ceremony was presided over by Inspector General Rajan Bargaotra, PTM, TM, Commander Coast Guard

Region (East). The occasion was also graced by various military and civil dignitaries besides the previous Commanding Officers of the vessel. ICGS Bhikaji Cama, the fourth ship in the Priyadarsini class of Fast Patrol Vessels of ICG has served the nation for more than 20 years. The ship was built by M/S GRSE, Kolkata and was commissioned

into ICG on Sept 24, 1997. The ship has the honour of serving two Coast Guard regions since commissioning viz Eastern Region and was rebased from Vishakhapatnam on Apr 30, 1999 to A&N region. During the life span, the ship sailed for 2586 days at sea and has covered a total distance of 2,26,937 Nautical Miles. During 20

years in service, the ship has seen twelve Commanding Officers. During the ceremony, an impressive Guard of Honour was paraded and with sunset, the Coast Guard Ensign was hauled down on the ship for the last time. Soon after 'Decommissioning Pennant' which is equal to the ship's length was

**Women's T-20 Tri-nation: India beat England by 8 wickets in Mumbai**



Mumbai, Mar 29  
In Women's Cricket, India defeated England by 8 wickets in the sixth match of the Tri-nation Twenty-20 series in Mumbai. Indian eves achieved the target of 108 runs, losing 2 wickets with 26 balls remaining. Smriti Mandhana made 62

runs and Harman Preet Kaur made 20. Earlier, winning the toss, England made 107 runs. Anuja Patil took 3 wickets and Poonam Yadav, Deepti Sharma and Radha Yadav took 2 wickets each for the hosts. Australia is the third

participating team in the tournament. Today's game was a dead rubber as India was already out of the tournament, after losing all their earlier matches. The final between Australia and England will be played in Mumbai on Saturday.

**17th Sub-junior National Wushu Championship begins in Jammu**

Srinagar, Mar 29  
The four-day 17th Sub-junior National Wushu Championship began in Jammu today. The national level sports event is being organised in the winter capital city of Jammu by the Wushu Association of India in

collaboration with J&K State Sports Council at MA Stadium. The championship was formally declared open by the J&K Youth Services and Sports Minister Shri Imran Raza Ansari during the inaugural ceremony at Police

auditorium Jammu this evening. About 37 teams comprising of over one thousand boys and girls from across the country and 12 boys from Army are participating in the national championship.

**Ganemat Sekhon, first Indian woman to win ISSF World Cup medal in skeet event**

New Delhi, Mar 29  
Seventeen-year-old Ganemat Sekhon still remembers the day when her father Amrinder took her to New Moti Bagh Shooting Range in Patiala for the first time from their Zirakpur home in 2015. There, as her cousin, national-level shooter Indreshwar Singh handed her a double barrel gun, Ganemat's first shot was followed by a fall due to the gun recoil. As the Punjab youngster became the first Indian female skeet shooter to win a medal at an ISSF World Championship where she won bronze at the women's skeet event in the ISSF Junior World Championship in Sydney, Australia, on Tuesday, Ganemat was reminded of the



incident by her father. Since her great grandfather Captain Chattar Singh won royal shooting competitions in the 1940s and grandfather Mohinderpal Singh being a national-level shooter, the youngster always had an interest in shooting. Ganemat started skeet shooting in 2015

and won silver at the Senior National Championships in Pune in 2016 followed by a silver medal at last year's nationals in New Delhi. The youngster shot the best score of 116 last month in the final selection trials but a score of 109 in the first trial meant that the youngster missed the CWG spot by .33 points.

**ICC to review code on players conduct following ball-tampering scandal**

Dubai, Mar 29  
The International Cricket Council (ICC) will conduct a wide-ranging review of the players' code of conduct to curb on-field misdemeanours, chief executive David Richardson said on Thursday. The announcement comes in the wake of the ball-tampering scandal in Cape Town, which resulted in Cricket Australia handing out bans to sacked Australia captain Steve Smith, David Warner and Cameron Bancroft. Richardson told reporters. "With the full support of the board we will be

undertaking a wide-ranging review into player conduct and particularly into the spirit in which the game is played in the code of conduct." Richardson plans to bring together former and current players along with ICC's cricket committee, the Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) and match officials to discuss ways to make the spirit of the game a more integral part of the code. Richardson said the cricket committee will also meet to discuss how to achieve consistency in decision-making around the enforcement of the disciplinary code.

**CWG 2018: Indian contingent arrives in Gold Coast**

About 200 members of the Indian contingent and officials participating in the Commonwealth Games beginning next week reached Gold Coast, Australia, today. An Indian Olympic Association (IOA) release said that the contingent members comprising athletics, boxing, basketball, hockey, lawn bowling and shooting reported at the Games Village as they reached in batches.

Even though Lehmann had no idea about their decision to tamper the ball, the 48-year old has announced that it is the right time to step away. Adding that

this was completely his decision, Lehmann said, "Speaking to my family, they've had enough of traveling 300 days. This was entirely my decision. I have been speaking to the hierarchy in the last couple of days." Lehmann's announcement comes hours after an emotional press conference of Smith, who broke down a number of times as he expressed regret over his decision.
