

Drones light up sky, military bands perform at 'Beating the Retreat' ceremony held at historic Vijay Chowk

President, Prime Minister and others witnessed the show

New Delhi, Jan. 29

Beating the Retreat ceremony was held at the historic Vijay Chowk in New Delhi today evening. Thousand drones dazzled the sky above Delhi for the first time ever, as part of a drone show which was the highlight of the Beating Retreat ceremony. The drone show was organised by a startup 'Botlab Dynamics' and supported by Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi and Department of Science and Technology. Synchronised background music



was also played during the drone show. The drone show was made a part of the ceremony for the first time to commemorate 75 years of Independence, being celebrated as 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. During the ten

minutes drone show, the Government's achievements were showcased through many creative formations in the dark sky. Now, India is the 4th country after China, Russia and UK to carry out such a large scale show with one thousand drones. A

total of 26 performances enthralled the spectators with foot-tapping music played by the bands of Indian Army, Navy, Air Force and Central Armed Police Forces. Besides, a number of new tunes were added to the

ceremony to celebrate 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. These include 'Hind ki Sena' and 'Ae Mere Watan Ke Logon'. The event came to a close with the ever-popular tune of 'Sare Jahan se Acha'.

President, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh and Chiefs of Army, Navy and Air force and others witnessed the show. Martial musical fervour was the flavour of the ceremony this year.

Fisheries Deptt. organizing camps at various locations to expand benefit of KCC to eligible fishers

45 KCC camps conducted so far; 718 applications received are under process for issuance of KCC

Port Blair, Jan. 29

The Department of Fisheries, Govt. of India is organizing a Nationwide KCC Campaign from 15th November 2021 to 15th February 2022, in order to expand the benefit of Kisan Credit Card (KCC) to all eligible fishers / fish farmers in the country. In this regard, the Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration is organizing camps at various locations to

cover all eligible fishers and farmers for aquaculture who are involved in various Fisheries and Aquaculture activities in these Islands.

The KCC is extended to meet the working capital requirements of the fishers / fish farmers for aquaculture activities. Recurring cost towards seed, feed, organic and inorganic fertilizers, lime/other soil

harvesting and marketing charges, fuel/electricity charges, labour, lease rent (if leased water area) etc. is included. In case of capture fisheries, working capital may include the cost of fuel, ice, labouring charges, mooring/landing charges etc. For availing KCC for Aquaculture, farmers must own or lease any of the fisheries related activities such as pond, tank, open

water bodies, raceway, hatchery, rearing unit etc. For Marine Fisheries, the fishers must own or lease registered fishing vessel/boat issued with fishing license. The loan will be in the nature of a revolving cash credit limit. Repayment will be fixed as per the cash flow/income generation pattern of the activity undertaken by the borrower.

Interested farmers are required

to submit documents for issuance of KCC viz. two recent passport size photograph, proof of identity - Self attested copy of Voter's ID Card / Driving Licence / PAN Card / Aadhaar Card / Passport / Photo ID issued by Govt. authority, proof of residence - recent telephone bill / electricity bill / property tax receipt (not older than 2 months) Voter's ID

The 'Beating the Retreat' is a centuries-old military tradition dating from the days when troops disengaged from battle at sunset. As soon as the buglers sounded the retreat, the troops ceased fighting, sheathed their arms and withdrew from the battlefield. It is for this reason that the custom of standing still during the sounding of retreat has been retained to this day. Colours and standards are cased and flags lowered at retreats. Drumbeats recall the days when troops, lodged in towns and cities, were recalled to their quarters at an appointed time in the evening. Hockey Women's Asia Cup 2022: India beat China 2-0 to bag bronze medal

New Delhi, Jan. 29 India women's hockey team may not have been able to defend their Asia Cup title but Savita Punia and her team return home from Oman with a bronze medal after beating former champions China 2-0 in the third-place play-off yesterday.

Goals from Sharmila Devi (13) and Gurjit Kaur (19) helped India beat China in a solid performance in Muscat.

After thrashing lowly Malaysia 9-0 in their opener, India suffered a 0-2 defeat against Asian Games champions Japan before thrashing Singapore 9-1 to qualify for the semifinals. But in the semifinals, some sloppy defending and poor penalty corner conversions put paid to India's hopes as they were beaten 2-3 by Korea.



Simple Ayurvedic Procedures

- Nasal application - Apply sesame oil / coconut oil or Ghee in both the nostrils (Pratimarsh Nasya) in morning and evening.
- Oil pulling therapy - Take 1 table spoon sesame or coconut oil in mouth. Do not drink, Swish in the mouth for 2 to 3 minutes and spit it off followed by warm water rinse. This can be done once or twice a day.

During dry cough / sore throat

- Steam inhalation with fresh Pudina (Mint) leaves or Ajwain (Caraway seeds) can be practiced once in a day.
- Lavang (Clove) powder mixed with natural sugar / honey can be taken 2-3 times a day in case of cough or throat irritation.
- These measures generally treat normal dry cough and sore throat. However, it is best to consult doctors if these symptoms persist.

Govt. proposes to allow modification in replacement of diesel engines with CNG and LPG engines in BS-VI vehicles

New Delhi, Jan. 29 Government has proposed to allow modification in replacement of diesel engines with CNG and LPG engines, in case of Bharat Stage, BS-VI vehicles less than 3.5 tonnes. As of now, retro fitment of CNG and LPG kit is permissible in motor vehicles under the BS-IV emission norms. In its notification on 27th of this month, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has laid down the type approval requirements for retro fitment. The Ministry said, this has been formulated in consultation with stakeholders. CNG is an environment friendly fuel and will reduce the emission levels of Carbon monoxide, Hydrocarbon, particulate matter and smoke, as compared to petrol and diesel engines. No.5-11/EC/A&N/2020: Whereas, for every Panchayat Samiti in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the total number of seats to be filled by persons chosen by direct election from the territorial constituencies and the number of seats to be reserved for women in every Panchayat Samiti have been determined by the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands vide Notification No.77/2015 F.No.3-1/2015/PF/GP dated 12.05.2015 and Order No.3-1/2015/PF/GP dated 12.05.2015 in compliance with sub-sections (1) and (4) of Section 107 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) Regulation, 1994 respectively;

And whereas, sub-rule (1) (c) of Rule 7 of Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995 states that "Constituencies in which seats are reserved for the Schedule Tribes, women belonging to those Tribes and women shall, as far as practicable, be distributed in different parts of the Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and the Zilla Parishad and they shall be rotated by the Commission by draw of lots so it is ensured that seats are so reserved in all the Constituencies of a Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and the Zilla Parishad as the case may be, at least once during three or more consecutive general elections";

And whereas in consequence thereof, a draw of lots was held at Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Institutes of Technology Auditorium, Dollygunj, Port Blair on 28.01.2022 by the Election Commission in the presence of representatives of political parties and others interested in the subject;

Now, further to the draw of lots and in compliance with Section 11(7), section 107(4) and proviso to sub-section 5 of section 112 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) Regulation, 1994 read with Rule 7(1) (c) of Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995, the Election Commission for the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby allots the seats reserved for women in all Panchayat Samities in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, as shown in Table-I and Table II appended to this Order.

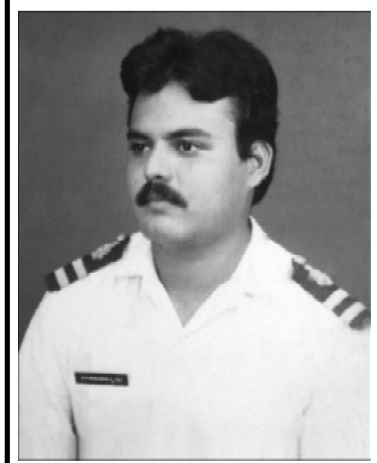
