cases globally and emergence of a new variant of the virus in the United Kingdom. Accordingly, Containment Zones continue to be demarcated carefully, and prescribed

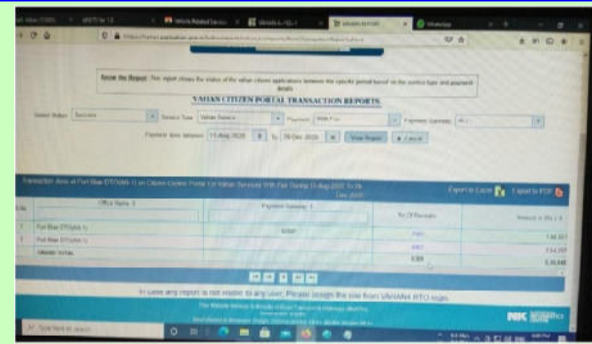
containment measures strictly followed within these zones, COVID-appropriate behaviour promoted and strictly enforced and the Standard Operating Procedures

The A&N Administration is making constant effort to deliver better & efficient services to the citizens of A&N Islands. In this direction, the Transport Department has shifted its motor vehicle registration related activities from 'VAHAN 1.0' to 'VAHAN 4.0' software version on Aug. 15, 2020. VAHAN is the flagship e-Governance application under National Transport Project, a Mission Mode Project initiated in the year 2006. The purpose of the application was to automate the Road Transport Office (RTO) operations related to vehicle registration, permit,



taxation, enforcement in the whole country. With the launch of 'VAHAN 4.0' version on August 15, 2020, services of road tax payment, fee for new registration of motor vehicles and acquiring fancy numbers have been made available to the citizen online in the first instance and the citizen has started availing this facility

by making fee payment for the above services online. According to a data received from the Transport Department, altogether 8443 people have done transactions for road tax payment, fee for new registration of motor vehicles and acquiring Fancy Numbers since its launch on August 15,

2020 up to Dec. 29, 2020. This has resulted in the revenue collection of Rs. 26,27,448 lakhs. Other services such as fee payment for fitness, renewal, hypothecation etc. will be made through online shortly. And, whereas, under the scheme, grant of financial assistance (hereinafter referred to as the benefits) is given to the individual farmers (hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries) by the Implementing Agency as per the extant of Scheme guidelines.

And, whereas, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of India.

(3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agency is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar Enrolment Centre located in the respective areas of said beneficiaries in the UT, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the scheme shall be given to such individual, subject to the production of the following documents, namely:

- a) if he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification Slip; and
- b) any one of the following documents, namely:-
 - i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with photo; or
 - ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - iii) Passport; or
 - iv) Ration Card; or
 - v) Voter Identity Card; or
 - vi) MGNREGA Card; or
 - vii) Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (S9 of 19BB); or
 - viii) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or
 - ix) any other document as specified by the Department :

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an Officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.


