



PM addresses nation through 'Mann Ki Baat' prog. on Akashvani

Calls Constitution the Nation's guiding light ahead of its 75th anniversary

New Delhi, Dec. 29

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said that Constitution is the guiding light of the nation and stated that it is a matter of great honour that the Indian Constitution is completing 75 years on 26th January next year. Addressing the nation in his Mann Ki Baat programme on Akashvani, Shri Modi said the Constitution has stood the test of time in every sense of the term. The Prime Minister noted that on the occasion of Constitution Day this year, many activities have commenced that will continue throughout the year. He mentioned that a special website constitution75.com has been created to connect citizens with the legacy of the Constitution. Prime Minister urged the listeners of Mann Ki Baat, children and youth to visit the website. People can read the Preamble of the Constitution and upload their video in the website. The website also offers the opportunity to read the Constitution in many different languages and ask questions pertaining to the Constitution.

The Maha Kumbh is going to be held in Prayagraj from the 13th of January. Prime Minister

highlighted that mammoth preparations are going on at the banks of Sangam in Prayagraj. He shared that he went to Prayagraj a few days ago and viewed the entire Kumbh area from a helicopter. Prime Minister exuded pride that the speciality of Maha Kumbh is not only in its vastness, but also in its diversity. He underscored that crores of people congregate for this event, including lakhs of saints, hundreds of sects and many Akharas. He said, no discrimination is done and such unity in diversity is not witnessed anywhere else in the world. He stated that Kumbh is also the Maha Kumbh of unity.

The Prime Minister highlighted that this time in Prayagraj, devotees from the country and the world will also be witness to the digital Maha Kumbh. With the help of digital navigation, people will be able to reach different ghats, temples, and akharas of sadhus. The same navigation system will also help people reach parking spaces. Shri Modi said that for the first time, an AI chatbot will be used in the Kumbh event. All kinds of information related to Kumbh will be available in 11 Indian



languages through the AI chatbot. Prime Minister also said that the entire Fair area is being covered with AI-powered cameras. If someone gets separated from one's kith and kin during the Kumbh, these cameras will help in finding them. Devotees will also get the facility of a digital lost and found center. They will also be provided information about Government-approved tour packages, accommodation and homestay on their mobile phones. Prime

Minister asked people to avail these facilities and upload their selfie with #EktaKaMahakumbh.

Prime Minister was pleased to share that for the first time, the World Audio Visual Entertainment Summit, WAVES Summit, is going to be organised in India next year. He said that during the WAVES summit, giants from the media and entertainment industry and people from the creative world will come to India. He said this summit is an important step towards making India a hub of global content creation. He expressed pride that young creators of the country are joining with full enthusiasm in the preparations for this summit. He stated that as India is moving towards a 5 trillion dollar economy, the creator economy is bringing in new energy. He urged the entire entertainment and creative industry of India to be a part of the WAVES summit.

In this edition of Mann Ki Baat, Shri Modi highlighted two big achievements of India in the field of health. He said the first achievement has been in the fight against malaria. Prime

Minister expressed satisfaction that the World Health Organization report mentions that there has been an 80 percent reduction in India in the number of malaria cases and deaths due to it between 2015 & 2023. He said that this is no mean achievement. He termed it heartening that this success has been achieved through everyone's participation.

The Prime Minister also shared a study of the world-renowned Medical Journal Lancet, which found that the chances of starting cancer treatment on time in India have increased a lot. He elaborated that timely treatment means starting the treatment of a cancer patient within 30 days and the 'Ayushman Bharat Yojana' has played a big role in this. Because of this scheme, 90 percent of cancer patients have been able to start their treatment on time. Shri Modi said the Ayushman Bharat Yojana has reduced the financial problems in cancer treatment to a great extent. He said that people have become more aware than ever before about timely treatment of

Dealers urged to adhere to VAT Regulation & consumers advised to collect tax invoices

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 29

Upon Promulgation of Andaman and Nicobar Value Added Tax Regulation, 2017, and Value Added Tax Rules, 2020, the following goods fall under the purview of Value Added Tax in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands:
▶ Petroleum Products: Petroleum Crude, high Speed Diesel, High Speed Diesel (Ship), Petrol, Natural Gas, Aviation Turbine Fuel.
▶ Alcoholic Beverages: Including Indian-made foreign liquor (IMFL), and Beer.
Dealers trading in

these goods are strictly required to adhere to VAT Regulation, including issuance of proper tax invoices upon request by consumers as per Section 50 of the A&N VAT Regulation. Further, the dealers are required to maintain records as per Section 48(6) of the A&N VAT Regulation. Consumers are advised to ensure that they receive tax invoices for every purchase of the aforementioned goods. These invoices must include:
▶ The word "Tax Invoice" prominently displayed.
▶ Details such as the

names, addresses, and registration numbers of the selling registered dealer.
▶ The name and address of the purchaser and his registration number, where the purchaser is a registered dealer.
▶ A unique invoice number, date, description, quantity, and value of goods sold, along with applicable tax details. This release has been issued by Office of the Commissioner, VAT to raise awareness among consumers and ensure compliance with VAT Regulations.

Tragic plane crash at Muan International Airport in South Korea

Seoul, Dec. 29

In South Korea plane crash, 177 people out of 181 died on Jeju Air flight from Bangkok to Muan International Airport around 290 kilometers south of Seoul in South Korea. 175 passengers and six aircraft staff were onboard. South Korea's fire agency reported that two staff members survived while two people are still unaccounted for. The disaster struck when the Boeing 737-800 flight was arriving at Muan International Airport this morning.

The Transport Ministry said over 700 personnel from the police, military, and



coast guard have been mobilized for on-site response efforts. Footage shows the plane came off the runway and crashed into a wall before bursting into flames. South Korea's acting President, Mr. Choi Sang-mok, visited the crash site and instructed emergency responders to mobilize all available equipment and personnel to respond to the crash. The Korea Airports Corporation said, all flights to Muan International Airport remain cancelled. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is set to launch its Space Docking Experiment, SpaDeX, tomorrow. In an interview, Minister of State for Space, Dr. Jitendra Singh said that ISRO's year-end mission will be a historic one as it will seek the rare feat of docking or merging two satellites in space. Dr. Singh said that the SpaDeX mission will mark India's entry into the exclusive league of nations capable of

4th Test Day 4: Australia 228/9 at stumps, lead by 333 runs vs India at MCG

Melbourne, Dec 29

Jasprit Bumrah (4/56) etched his name in the record books by completing 200 Test wickets, but Australia extended their overall lead to 333 runs, finishing at 228 for 9 at stumps on the fourth day of the fourth Test here on Sunday.

Resuming at 135 for six after tea, Australia lost their last recognised batter, Marnus Labuschagne, for a gritty 70 off 139 balls shortly after the break. However, they continued to frustrate



India, fighting the lead, while the last-wicket pair of Nathan Lyon and Scott Boland added an unbeaten 55 runs, further fortifying Australia's position heading into the final day. Skipper Pat Cummins played a crucial knock, scoring a resilient 41 off 90 balls to stretch

Koneru Humpy clinches second women's title at World Rapid and Blitz Championship in New York

New York, Dec. 29

In Chess, India's Koneru Humpy wins her second women's title beating Indonesia's Irene Sukander in the World Rapid and Blitz Championship held in New York. Humpy finished the tournament with 8.5 points from 11 rounds to secure her victory. Aged 37, the top ranked Indian is only the second player after China's Ju Wenjun to clinch the title more than once. Indian Chess Grandmaster Humpy previously won in 2019 at Georgia.



In the men's category, Russia's Volodar Murzin, aged 18, claimed championship. Murzin's victory places him as the second-youngest FIDE World Rapid Champion behind Nodirbek Abdusattorov, who won at age 17. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

ICC has also announced nominations for the Women's T20I Cricketer of the Year, Emerging Men's Cricketer of the Year and Men's ODI Cricketer of the Year award. However, no Indian player was able to make the cut. The ICC Awards 2024 comprises 12 individual awards, with shortlists in nine categories being revealed by the ICC between 28th to 30th December. Winners of the ICC Awards will be announced in late January, next year.


