India's Daily Figures Reach New High Record 3.79 lakh COVID-19 cases reported in single day; 3,645 fatalities Cumulative death toll increases to 2,04,832

New Delhi, April 29

India saw a record single day rise of 3,79,257 new corona virus infections pushing the total tally of COVID-19 cases to 1,83,76,524, while active cases crossed the 30-lakh mark, according to the Union Health Ministry data updated on Thursday. Registering a steady increase, the active cases have increased to 30,84,814 comprising 16.79 per cent of the total infections, while the national COVID-19 recovery rate has further dropped to 82.10 per cent. The death toll increased to 2,04,832 with a record 3,645 daily new fatalities, the data updated at 8 am showed.

The Health Ministry stated that more than 70 per cent of the deaths occurred due to co-

morbidity. The number of people who have recuperated from the disease surged to 1,50,86,878. The 3,645 new fatalities include 1,035 from Maharashtra, 368 from Delhi, 279 from Chhattisgarh, 265 from Uttar Pradesh, 229 from Karnataka, 174 from Gujarat, 149 from Jharkhand, 142 from Punjab, 120 from Rajasthan, 108 from Uttarakhand and 105 from Madhya Pradesh.

Till now, over 1.5 crore people have recovered from infection. Indian Council of Medical Research ICMR said, over 17 lakh 68 thousand tests were conducted yesterday and till now over 28 crore 44 lakh tests have been conducted across the country.

Media briefed on COVID-19 Avail tele-consultancy facility & avoid visiting Hospitals for minor ailments; Secretary (IP&T) urges people

Port Blair, April 29

The Secretary, IP&T, Shri Sunil Kumar Singh today reiterated to strictly follow COVID appropriate behaviour viz. wearing of face mask and maintaining social distancing to protect themselves, their family members and the society as well from the deadly corona virus. While briefing the media persons in the conference hall of IP&T about the COVID situation in these Islands, he informed that 5 flights with 459 passengers arrived in Port Blair today. Out of this, 9 passengers were tested corona positive.

The Secretary disclosed that a part of Shadipur area has been declared as Containment Zone. He said, the information & the photographs we receive reveal that people are still not following the COVID Protocol. By adhering to COVID appropriate behaviour only we will be able to defeat Corona virus, the Secretary added. He stated that the vaccination drive is continuing and till 2 pm today,



523 eligible persons above 45 plus were vaccinated with COVISHIED vaccine. He stated that there is daily addition of around 40 to 50 corona positive cases in these Islands and a good number of patients are also being discharged after recovery. The recovery of the patients help in reducing the pressure on the medical system, the Secretary said.

The Secretary has also appealed to the people not to move out of their home and they may do so, only if, there is urgent nature of work or medical emergency. He urged the people to avail the tele-consultancy facility instead of visiting G.B Pant Hospital for minor ailments. Visiting G.B. Pant Hospital and other hospital or health centres will increase the chances of contracting the virus, the Secretary said.

in force in the South Andaman District including the active Containment Zones from 30th April, 2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

With surge in corona cases being reported across the country, the A&N Islands too are witnessing increase in the number of corona positive cases almost on a daily basis. To keep check on the rising cases, people coming to the Islands are being thoroughly subjected to screening at the airport. This has led to detection of many positive cases and timely treatment of the



same is being extended to such persons.

To provide immunity against the virus to the vulnerable population, vaccination drives are being carried out across the length and breadth of the Islands with the focus to inoculate 45 and above age group population at the earliest.

Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De said that even after introducing the tele-consultancy facility people are not availing this facility and about 1000 persons are visiting the G.B. Pant Hospital on a daily basis. He once again urged the people to avail this tele-consultancy facility, which he said, will not only reduce the footfall but the spread of infection. He said airborne infection is the major cause of spreading corona. He also urged people to wear mask properly, wash hands & use sanitizer and avoid touching nose and mouth to restrict the spread of corona virus. The Deputy Director said, the District Office may be contacted, if any person from containment zone is not able to come to collect the medicine from the Hospital.

He said, today (April, 29) the number of new admission of corona cases in G.B. Pant Hospital stood at 12 and after recovery 5 patients were discharged. At present, 87 corona patients are in the G. B Pant Hospital of which 52 are on Oxygen and no patient is on Ventilator, he disclosed.

The Director, IP&T, Shri Alok Kumar and the Deputy Director, IP, Shri RS Meena also attended the press conference.

Forty countries come forward to provide medical assistance to India says, Ministry of External Affairs

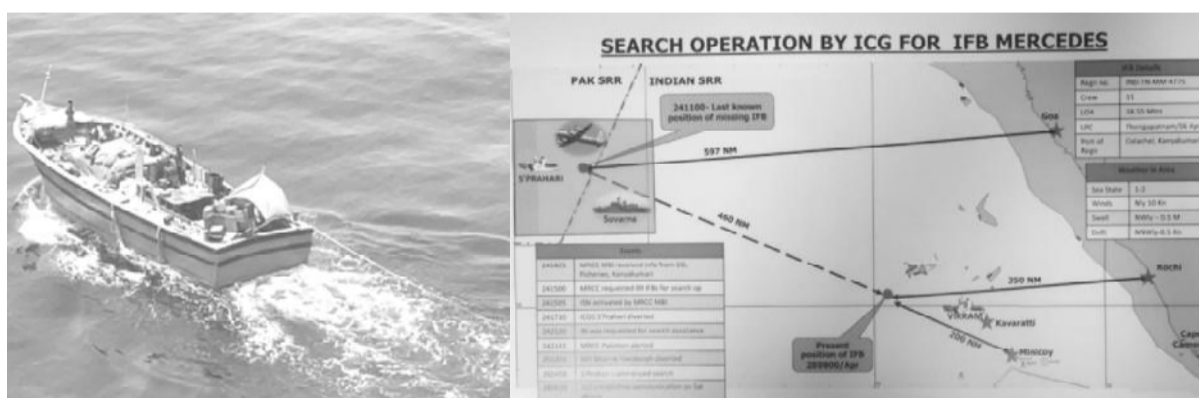
New Delhi, April 29

The Ministry of External Affairs has said that 40 countries have come forward to provide assistance to India to fulfil the requirements of several medical equipment and medicines in the country. Briefing the media in New Delhi today, Foreign Secretary,

Shri Harshvardhan Shringla said, consignments carrying medical equipment and medicines have started to arrive in India from various countries. He said, the US has pledged to help the country in its fight against the pandemic. Shri Shringla informed that three flights are

scheduled to arrive from the United States within a week. He said, two flights will reach tomorrow carrying the oxygen generating equipment and oxygen cylinders. He said, a cargo flight arriving tonight from UAE with ventilators and Favipiravir medicines. (Source:india.gov.in)

Indian Coast Guard locates missing fishing boat Mercedes at high seas



Port Blair, April 29

The Indian Coast Guard in yet another successful search and rescue operation at sea has located the missing Tamil Nadu fishing boat Mercedes in a massive search operation launched since April 24, 2021 at a distance of about 1100 kms (590 miles) from Goa. The fishing boat had sailed for deep sea fishing on 06 Apr 21 with 11 crew onboard West of Kerala for 30 days voyage from Thengapatnam Fishing harbour in Tamil Nadu. The Tamil Nadu Fisheries authorities on April 24 intimated regarding sighting of debris by other fishing boats operating in the area presuming the fishing boat Mercedes to be sunk.

The Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Center (MRCC) of Indian Coast Guard at Mumbai activated International Safety Net to alert merchant vessels transiting near reported position to lookout for the missing boat. Simultaneously, ICGS Samudra Prahari on Concurrent Deployment

was diverted for search. MRCC (Mumbai) coordinated with merchant vessel Maersk Horsburgh to join the search operation alongwith fishing boats operating in the area. As the reported position was located in Pakistan Search and Rescue Region, MRCC Karachi was also requested for assistance as per IMO norms in vogue. Considering the distance from mainland, Indian Navy was requested for launch of Long Range Maritime Patrol aircraft. It was learnt that the fishing boat was not carrying AIS or any other transponder which could have assisted in early locating of the boat by the search units.

After four days of continuous search amidst challenges of distance from mainland and weather, the missing boat was located around 200 miles (around 370 kilometers) from Lakshadweep Islands. ICG Dornier located and corroborated presence of the fishing boat today morning. MRCC (Mumbai) established communication with

the fishing boat on satellite phone held by the boat and ascertained the crew to be safe. In the interim, an information was also received from TN fisheries authorities that the crew of IFB Mercedes had called up home through Satellite phone to indicate that they are safe. ICG ship on deployment off Lakshadweep was diverted to render logistic and medical assistance to the crew. The fishing boat is returning to its base port under escort of ICG ship and would reach around 3rd May, 2021.

The Indian Coast Guard as the National Maritime Search and Rescue Coordinator has saved around 10,000 lives over 3400 missions averaging almost one life saved per two days. The Indian Coast Guard has been advocating fitment of AIS, Distress Alert Transponders and Long Range two way communication mechanism for enhancing safety of fishers proceeding for Deep Sea Fishing, a press release from Coast Guard, A&N Islands said.

Over 2.12 crore people have registered for vaccination in Co-WIN portal since Wednesday

New Delhi, April 29

The Union government has said that more than 2.12 crore people have registered for vaccination in the Co-WIN portal since yesterday. The Union Health Ministry said, more than 75 lakh people have registered on Co-WIN today. It has requested people to register themselves on www.cowin.gov.in, if they are eligible and get vaccinated on their turn.

The Portal handled more than 50 thousand Application Program Interface API calls per second. The vaccination for people 18 years and above will begin on Saturday. Government said, Co-WIN digital platform continues to work without any technical glitch.

Govt. permits import of 17 critical medical devices to provide relief to COVID patients

New Delhi, April 29

Government has expedited the process of import of critical medical devices amid the growing demands due to Covid-19 pandemic situation in the country. In this connection, the Union Government has permitted importers to import 17 medical devices required to provide relief to the Covid patients.

Relief has been given to import and expedite custom clearances. Under the new provision the mandatory declarations will have to be furnished by the importers

after speedy custom clearance. This will avoid delay in shipment of essential medical equipment due to procedural reasons.

An order issued by the Department of Consumer Affairs yesterday will remain in force for three months. The permission has been granted for the import of nebulizers, oxygen concentrators, CPAP and BIPAP devices, Vacuum Pressure Swing Absorption, Pressure Swing Absorption, Oxygen Plants, Cryogenic Oxygen Air Separation Unit. In addition to these, permission has also been

granted to import of oxygen canister, oxygen filling systems, oxygen cylinders including cryogenic cylinders, ventilators among others.

The Department has directed that the importers shall inform all such imports to the officials in the state where the import will be made. The Department said the decision has been taken in view of the steep demands of medical devices due to emergent health concerns and immediate supply to the medical industry. (Source:india.gov.in)

Centre provides over 16 crore doses of Covid vaccines to States, UTs free of cost

New Delhi, April 29

The Health and Family Welfare Ministry has informed that more than one crore six lakh doses of Covid vaccines are still available with the States and Union Territories. The Union Government has provided over 16 crore 16 lakh doses of vaccines to States and Union Territories free of cost so far. Of this, the total consumption of doses including wastages is over 15 crore 10 lakh.

The Ministry has assured that

more than 20 lakh vaccine doses will be provided to States and Union Territories within the next three days. On the alleged shortage of vaccines in Maharashtra, the Ministry has clarified that over one crore 63 lakh doses of vaccines have been received by Maharashtra so far. Of this, the total consumption including wastage was over one crore 56 lakh. The Ministry said, a total of seven lakh 49 thousand 960 vaccine doses are still available with the State. It added that more than 20

lakh 48 thousand doses of vaccine will be delivered in the next three days. The Health Ministry has said, vaccination is a crucial pillar in the fight against the coronavirus and the third phase of Covid-19 vaccination will be implemented from 1st May. The Ministry has informed that the highest numbers of over 11 lakh 80 thousand doses of vaccines are available in Uttar Pradesh, followed by Bihar wherein 8 lakh 36 thousand doses are left to be administered. 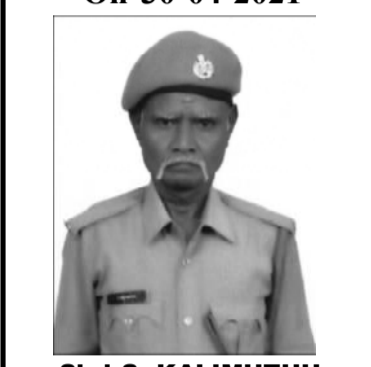

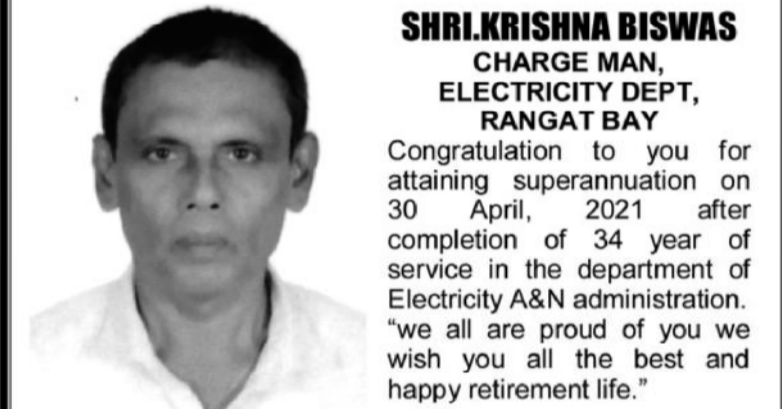
