### District Administration, SA conducts encroachment eviction drives at various places

Continuing its efforts to contain encroachments over Government lands, the Revenue Officials of Port Blair Tehsil under South Andaman District carried out extensive eviction drives at various places during the last few days against such encroachments.

### POCSO case accused sentenced to 20 yrs of rigorous imprisonment

Port Blair, Apr. 29

Two POCSO cases, FIR No. 66/21 dtd 30/07/2021 U/s 5(m)(n)(1)/6 of POCSO Act 2012 r.w.s 506 IPC and FIR No. 82/21 dtd 09/09/2021 U/s 5(1)/06 of POCSO Act 2012 r.w.s 506 IPC were registered at PS Pahargaon against accused R Muniya Swamy and were investigated by SI Silpi Singha and then SI Gracefield respectively.

On March 22, 2024, Shri Bhawani Shanker Sharma, Hon'ble Additional Sessions Judge -cum- Special Court (POCSO Act), South Andaman District, Port Blair delivered a significant judgment in the above cases of PS Pahargaon sentencing the accused R Muniya Swamy to 20 years of rigorous imprisonment with a fine of Rs. 50,000/-.

This verdict stands as a testament to the unwavering commitment of A&N Police, especially the Investigating Officers, SI Silpi Singha and then SI Gracefield, who tirelessly pursued justice in these cases. Under the exemplary guidance of Insp. Girish Kumar, then SHO PS Pahargaon, and the overarching supervision of the Superintendent of

Police, South Andaman District, their dedication to upholding the rule of law and safeguarding the rights of vulnerable individuals shines brightly.

The Hon'ble Court's sentence on the accused reflects the gravity of the offense and serves as a powerful deterrent against such abhorrent acts. It

**PS Crime and Economic Offence seizes 2.700 kgs of ganja; one person arrested**

Port Blair, Apr. 29

In a significant crackdown on illegal activities, on April 28, 2024, acting on specific intelligence received from a reliable source, a Police team comprising of Inspector Girish Kumar, SHO, PS Crime & Economic Offence, Head Constable Sanjit Madhu, Sanjay Kujur, along with Constables K. Rajendran and Lilly Grace Lakra of PS Crime & Economic Offence under the supervision of Shri Lakshay Pandey, Dy.SP (CID), conducted a raid in the rented house of Abijit Mahapatra, S/o Shri Naba Kumar Mahapatra, 31, Pvt. Worker, R/o Shiv Colony, Dollygunj. During the



operation, the team seized 2.700 kgs of Ganja concealed in the living room of the rented accommodation of Abijit Mahapatra. The accused was arrested on the spot following the due legal procedure. The raid was conducted under the overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID). A case under NDPS Act-1985 has been registered at PS CCS and investigation is in progress. Citizens have been urged to continue their cooperation in reporting any suspicious activities or credible information pertaining to sale or possession of contrabands or any other illegal activity on telephone numbers- 100, 232586, 233307, 9933242204 & 9434280100. The identity of the informer will be kept secret, a press release from SP (CID) said.

Do's

For general population

Stay hydrated:

Drink sufficient water whenever possible, even if you are not thirsty. Thirst is not a good indicator of dehydration.

- Carry drinking water when travelling.
- Use Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS), and consume homemade drinks like lemon water, buttermilk/lassi, fruit juices with some added salt.
- Eat seasonal fruits and vegetables with high water content like watermelon, musk melon, orange, grapes, pineapple, cucumber, lettuce or other locally available fruits and vegetables.

Stay covered:

- Wear thin loose, cotton garments preferably light coloured.
- Cover your head: use an umbrella, hat, cap, towel and other traditional head gears during exposure to direct sunlight.
- Wear shoes or chappals while going out in the sun.

Stay alert:

- Listen to the Radio; watch TV; read the Newspaper for local weather news.
- Get the latest update on weather on India Meteorological Department (IMD) website at <https://mausam.imd.gov.in>.

Stay indoors/in the shade as much as possible:

- In well-ventilated and cool places.
- Block direct sunlight and heat waves: Keep windows and curtains closed during the day, especially on the sunny side of your house. Open them up at night to let cooler air in.

If going outdoors, limit your outdoor activity to cooler times of the day i.e., morning and evening. Reschedule or plan outdoor activities during cooler parts of the day.

Don'ts

Avoid getting out in the sun, especially between 12:00 noon and 03:00 pm. Avoid strenuous activities when outside in the afternoon. Do not go out barefoot. Avoid cooking during peak summer hours. Open doors and windows to ventilate the cooking area adequately. Avoid alcohol, tea, coffee and carbonated soft drinks or drinks with large amounts of sugar- as these actually, lead to loss of more body fluid or may cause stomach cramps.
