PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME) scheme launched

Scheme to benefit 8 lakh units through access to information, training, better exposure and formalization: Minister

New Delhi, June 29

Minister for Food Processing Industries, Smt. Harsimrat Kaur Badal launched the PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME) scheme as a part of "Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan" through a video press conference today. Union Minister said that the Scheme would generate total investment of Rs 35,000 crore and generate 9 lakh skilled and semi-skilled employment and benefit 8 lakh units through access to information, training, better exposure and formalization. The guidelines of the Scheme were released on the occasion.



Highlighting the role of local food processing units, Union Minister said that food products manufactured by the rural entrepreneurs in the villages have a long

tradition of supplying Indian food products to the local population. The importance of these local units and their role has been amply emphasised by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in his Address to the Nation on 12.5.2020.

"In times of crisis, this Local has fulfilled our demand, this Local has saved us. Local is not just the need, it is our responsibility also. Time has taught us that we must make the Local as a mantra of our life. The Global Brands you feel today were sometimes also very local like this. But when people started using them, started

Minimum Wages for various categories of employees across A&N Islands revised; to be effective from 1st July

Port Blair, June 29

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration has revised the Minimum Wages for various categories of employees

across Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The new wages will come into effect from 1st July, 2020 and are as follows:

Category of employee	Minimum wage per day
Unskilled	Rs. 484/-
Semi-Skilled/Unskilled supervisory	Rs. 541/-
Skilled/Clerical	Rs. 626/-
Highly Skilled	Rs. 684/-

All establishments have been asked to ensure that the minimum wages are paid to the workers. The workers and Unions have also been requested to file any such violation in writing to Labour Commissioner & DET for

initiating penal action against the violators as per Section 22 wherein punishment includes imprisonment for a term upto 6 months, a press release from Labour Commissioner & DET said.

The New Look - A&N Administration Fleet

Two new 500 pax-cum-150 ton cargo Inter Island vessels to be inducted within the current year

Port Blair, June 29

The Shipping Department of A&N Administration currently has in its inventory about 70 vessels of different types and sizes, providing essential services to the Islanders across four sectors of operation. However, many of these ships are old and have outlived their fair lives. Further, many of the equipment fitted onboard the current ships is now obsolete, causing difficulties in their upkeep and maintenance due to non-availability of the spares. Thus the vintage of ships currently in the inventory, combined with the problem of non-availability of spares leads to long laid up periods and consequently

frequent disruptions in the essential services. To replace the ageing fleet, the Ship Acquisition Committee of A&N Islands, with the approval of GoI, had drawn up a Ship Acquisition Plan for procurement of 25 new ships of various types and sizes for operations across all sectors. In this regard, 04 new vessels (2x1200 pax and 2x500 pax) are already under construction at Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) as replacement for the existing Mainland and Inter Island vessels. Amongst these, the first 500 pax vessel christened MV Sindhu is currently undergoing final refitting and trials and is likely to be commissioned and inducted into the A&N Fleet by Aug 2020. The second 500 pax namely MV Nalanda is likely to be commissioned by Dec 2020. The delivery for the 2x1200 pax vessels is scheduled in June 2021 and Dec 2021 respectively. In the Harbour sector, the Directorate has already inducted 04 new vessels of 150 passenger capacity each in 2018-19. In addition, there is a plan to induct 3x300 pax Foreshore vessels and 10 Harbour Crafts of various capacities. The induction of



these ships will be taken up in a phased manner in the coming years, to be able to spread the expenditure. The Directorate of Shipping Services has also planned to induct electrically propelled boats in the harbour sector both through new inductions and chartering. The EoI for the same was issued by the DSS in January this year and the

Infrastructure expansion in Education Sector in A&N Islands

90 additional classrooms being constructed in various Schools

Port Blair, June 29

The Department of Education in its endeavour to make quality education accessible to each and every child of these Islands is taking various initiatives including construction of spacious classrooms, laboratories, hostels, retrofitting of school buildings etc. As part of this, the Department has taken up the project of construction of 90 additional classrooms in various schools of A&N Islands at an estimated cost of Rs. 22.44 crore.

Out of these 90 classrooms, work of 42 classrooms have been completed which include 8 each at GSS South Point, GSSS Mayabunder, GSSS Pahalgaoon, GSSS Swarajgram and GSSS

Laxminipur and 2 at GPS VS Palli. Meanwhile, the work pertaining to the remaining 48 additional classrooms are in

different stages of construction. The schools in which the classrooms are being constructed are 8 each at GSSS Rabindra Bangla Vidyalaya, Port Blair, GSS Prothrapur, GSSS Diglipur, GSS Shibpur, GSS Mus in Car Nicobar and GSSS, Champion in Nancowrie. The work shall be completed by the end of the current academic session.

Once completed, this will enable the Education Department to ensure safe and healthy teaching atmosphere in schools, which is a pre-requisite for promotion of education and also paves way in ensuring social distancing in the present scenario, a press release from Education Department said.

Ration Card holders/members asked to get their Aadhar number seeded

Port Blair, June 29

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that in spite of repeated requests to fair price dealers through various medias, still many ration card holders have not approached the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs for getting their Aadhaar number seeded in respect of the left out members. The list of all such Aadhaar un-seeded members have been provided to their respective Fair Price Shop. All those ration card holders who have till now not got the Aadhaar numbers seeded for self and members may approach their respective Fair Price Shop or the Card Section of the Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Port Blair before 7th of July 2020 and get their Aadhaar number seeded. The card holders residing in other Islands may approach their respective Civil Supply Units immediately to get their Aadhaar seeding. However, those ration card holders/members who have enrolled their Aadhaar and not yet received the Aadhaar numbers may intimate to their respective Supply units. The beneficiaries who have not yet approached the UIDAI enrollment centres for enrollment of Aadhaar may immediately approach the centres for enrollment of Aadhaar and the enrollment slip may be submitted to the

promoting them, branding them, proud of them, they became Global from Local Products. Therefore, from today every Indian has to become vocal for their local, not only to buy local products, but also to promote them proudly. I am confident that our country can do this." Speaking about the challenges faced by food processing sector, Smt. Badal said that the unorganised food-processing sector faces a number of challenges which limit their performance and their growth. She added that these challenges include lack of access to modern technology & equipment, training, access institutional credit, lack of basic awareness on quality control of products; and lack of branding & marketing skills etc. She shared that owing to these challenges, the unorganised food processing sector contributes much less in terms of value addition and output despite its huge potential.

Union FPI Minister said that the unorganized food processing sector comprising nearly 25 lakh units contribute to 74% of employment in food processing sector. Nearly 66% of these units are located in rural areas and about 80% of them are family-based enterprises supporting livelihood rural household and minimizing their migration to urban areas. These units largely fall within the category of micro enterprises.

At Port Blair, the video press conference was attended by Director of Industries, Andaman Nicobar Administration, Director of Fisheries and representatives from Directorate of Agriculture in the Conference hall of Secretariat. Apart from PM FME, the Minister unveiled top to total- New Operation Greens Guidelines and online Skill Programme in Food Processing.

The Scheme envisages an outlay of Rs. 10,000 crores over a period of Five Years from 2020-21 to 2024-25. The expenditure under the scheme would be shared in 60:40 ratio between Central and State Govt., in 90:10 ratio with North Eastern & Himalayan States, 60:40 ratio with UTs with Legislature and 100% by the Centre for other UTs. Under the scheme 2, 00,000 micro food processing units will be directly assisted with credit link subsidy. Adequate supportive common infrastructure and institutional architecture will be supported to accelerate growth of the sector.

The scheme adopts "One District One Product (ODOP)" approach to reap the benefit of scale in terms of requirements of input, availing common services and marketing of products. ODOP will provide the framework for value chain development and alignment of support infrastructure. The States would identify the food product for a District, keeping in perspective the focus of the scheme on perishables. The ODOP product could be perishable produce based products or Cereal based product or Food product widely produced in a District and their allied sectors. The programme has four broad components addressing the need of the sector namely 1) Support to individual and groups of Micro Enterprises 2) Branding & Marketing Support 3) Support for strengthening of Institutions 4) setting up robust project management framework. Individual Micro food processing units would be provided credit link Capital subsidy at the rate of 35% of the eligible project cost with the maximum seeding of Rs. 10, 00,000 per unit. The scheme would also support Clusters and groups such as FPOs/ SHGs/ Producers Cooperatives along their entire value chain for sorting, grading, assaying, storage, common processing, packaging, marketing, processing of agro-produce and testing laboratories. Grant at the rate of 35% with credit linkage and training support would be provided. The scheme also proposes to provide support to SHGs in the seed capital and support for capital investment and training and hand holding supports.

Support for common infrastructure would be provided to FPOs, SHGs, cooperatives by any Govt. Agency or private enterprises. This support includes creation of premises for assaying of agriculture produce, sorting, grading, warehouse and cold storage at the farm gate; common processing facility for processing ODOP produce and incubation centre.

Marketing and branding support would be provided under the scheme. Following the ODOP approach marketing and branding support would only be provided for such product at the State/ Regional level.

Capital building and training is a critical component in technical up gradation and formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises. At the National level, National Institute for Food Technology Entrepreneurship and Management (NIFTEM) and India Institute of Food Processing Technology (IIFPT) would play pivotal role in capacity building and research. The eligible enterprises may seek financial assistance towards research and capacity building. NIFTEM and IIFPT in partnership with State Level Technical Institution would provide training and research support to the selected enterprises/ group/ cluster. Online training module would be used for general training and product specific training would be provided for the District for ODOP.

tenders are presently under finalization. In the entire process of ship acquisition and designing of the new vessels, the special requirements of the A&N Islands have been kept in mind and the intention is to finally have a much leaner fleet of more efficient, state of the art ships. The induction of the electrically propelled vessels would not only cut operational costs but also contribute significantly towards the overall aim of de-dieselization of the Islands.

Commencing August this year, the induction of the new vessels in a phased manner would transform the entire fleet of the Directorate of Shipping Services in the coming years through which the Directorate will be able to provide more efficient and passenger friendly shipping services to the Islanders, a press release from DSS said.

Space over the last one year and some of the important missions planned for the future, Dr Jitendra Singh said that even though because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the training of four Indian astronauts in Russia had to be halted, yet the opinion of Chairman ISRO and the scientific team is that there had been kept a "cushion" both in the training programme and launch deadline. The training of astronauts has now been resumed and the launch is scheduled to take place as planned, before the 75th anniversary of India's independence in 2022, he said.

corrigendum to the Expression of Interest (EoI) for sale of Air India, the Department of Investment and Public Asset Management said the deadline has been extended in view of the request received from the interested bidders due to the prevailing situation arising out of COVID-19. While issuing the EoI in January, the last date for bids was kept at 17th of March which was later extended till 30th April and further extended to 30th of this month.

Besides, the date for intimation to Qualified Interested Bidders has also been extended till 14th of September, 2020. The government in January this year restarted the divestment process and invited bids for selling 100 per cent equity in the state-owned airline, including Air India's 100 per cent shareholding in AI Express Limited and 50 per cent stake in Air India SATS Airport Services Private Limited. In 2018, the government had offered to sell 76 per cent stake in the airline. (Source: india.gov.in)
