

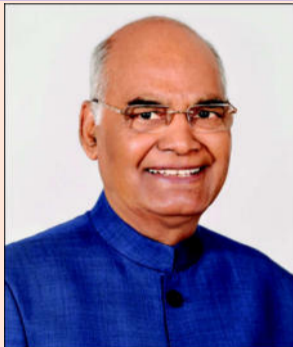


Our real success lies in building a Society and the Nation according to the values and ideals of Babasaheb: President

Lucknow, June 29 (PIB)

Our real success lies in building a society and the nation according to the values and ideals of Babasaheb, said the President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind. He said that we did make progress in this direction but still needed to cover much ground. He was speaking at the foundation stone laying ceremony of Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar Memorial and Cultural Centre in Lucknow today.

The President said that the multi-dimensional personality and invaluable contribution of Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar to the nation-building revealed his extraordinary capability and talent. He was not only an educationist, economist, jurist, politician, journalist, sociologist and social reformer, but also made invaluable contribution in the fields of culture, religion and spirituality.



The President said that Morality, Equality, Self-respect and Indianness are four most important ideals of

Babasaheb's vision. The glimpses of these four ideals are found in his thoughts and actions. His cultural thinking was basically laid on harmony. Dr Ambedkar spread the thoughts of Lord Buddha. Objective of his efforts was taking Indian values like compassion, fraternity, non-violence, equality and mutual respect to the masses and to realize the ideal of social justice. Lord Buddha's message of compassion and harmony was the basis of his life and politics. Babasaheb stressed on the need of politics based on the cultural values of morality and harmony. He used to say that he is an Indian first, an Indian later and an Indian at the last.

5887 beneficiaries vaccinated in A&N Islands in a single day

Port Blair, June 29

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. Accordingly, the vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline



workers and vulnerable population with comorbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

As per data available, a total of 1,72,916 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 48,475 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years

have been vaccinated till date. A total of 5887 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands.

2899 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which

The District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be holding National Lok Adalat in the District Court Complex at Port Blair, District Court Complex at Mayabunder and Circuit Court building at Diglipur on July 10, 2021 by adopting all COVID SOP issued by the MHA

from time to time. Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in different courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-litigation disputes include NI Act cases u/s 138; Money recovery

cases; Labour dispute cases; Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non-compoundable); Maintenance cases; other (Criminal Compoundable) and other Civil disputes, before those had not reached the door step of any court.

The general public having any such dispute at the pre-litigation

stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair before July 5, 2021 so that their disputes may be processed and made ready for hearing before the National Lok Adalat on 10.07.2021, a press release from Secretary, District Legal Services Authority said.

Hunting of birds prohibited under Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972

Port Blair, June 29

Andaman and Nicobar Islands are endowed with very rich biodiversity both in terms of flora and fauna. It is so rich that it is designated as one amongst the mega biodiversity hotspots of this world, a fact that every Islander is proud of, and very rightly so!

Protecting the biodiversity is the onerous responsibility

entrusted to the Department of Environment and Forests, and the conservation efforts have been translating into real time protection of the wildlife only with the active involvement of the aware citizenry.

During the monsoons and with the setting of fruiting cycle of trees like figs, jamun, etc. many animals, particularly the

birds and bats, most of which are endemic to these islands, congregate for feeding. The

India at UN raises issue of drones being used for terror activities

New York, June 29
India has raised at the UN, the issue of drone being used for terror activities. It came days after explosions at Air Force Station in Jammu with the help of low-flying drones. New Delhi said, being a low-cost option and easily available, utilization of these aerial and sub-surface platforms for sinister purposes by terrorist groups such as intelligence collection, explosives delivery and targeted attacks have become an imminent danger for security agencies worldwide. This was stated by Special Secretary in the Home Ministry, Shri V.S.K. Kaumudi, while addressing the 2nd UN High Level Conference of the Head of Counter Terrorism Agencies of the Member States. He added that the possibility of the use of weaponized drones for terrorist purposes against strategic and commercial assets call for serious attention by the member States. Shri Kaumudi said, today, misuse of information and communication technology such as internet and social media for terrorist propaganda and misuse of new payment methods and crowd funding platforms for financing of terrorism have emerged as the most serious threats of terrorism. The Special Secretary also emphasized that the international community should call out those who provide safe havens to terrorists and hold them accountable. He said, it is high time that the international community calls upon Pakistan to take effective, verifiable and irreversible actions against terror outfits operating on the territory under its control. diversion from the mundane life for any person who can take out some time to marvel at the nature and its bounty. However, during such fruiting cycles, many miscreants have been apprehended in the act of hunting these birds and bats, which, being wild, is prohibited under the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. It is seen that a range of tools and equipments are used for hunting, like, stones, catapults and the more precise air-guns and rifles. Glue traps have also been recovered from various areas where decoy bird is put up to lure the wild birds into the traps.

Birds like pigeons, teals, doves, parakeets, hill mynas, fruitbats, etc. are covered under various schedules of the Act. and therefore, hunting of these wildlife amounts to grave violations, punishable with fines and at times even imprisonment depending upon the schedule.

Responding to the call of conservation earlier, many nature-loving and citizens have come forward to surrender their air-guns and many have pledged their support for conservation of the wild.

This time too, the Department of Environment & Forests, A & N Administration makes a fervent appeal to the citizenry to come forward and join hands with the Administration for voluntarily surrendering air-rifles/air-guns, motivate others, discourage the use of air-rifles/air-guns and take a pledge to conserve the wildlife of these islands, whose rarity and diversity is a matter of pride for each and every Indian.

I am directed to say that the Andaman and Nicobar Administration proposes to fill up one Group 'A' Gazetted post of Harbour Master in Pay Matrix Level-12, Rs. 78800-209200 in the Port Management Board on deputation (ISTC) from amongst the eligible officers of the Central/State Governments/UT Administrations/Public Sector Undertakings, fulfilling the following eligibility criteria:

- (a) (i) Holding analogous posts on a regular basis; or
- (ii) with five years' regular service in Level-11, Rs. 67700-208700 of the Pay Matrix or equivalent; and
- (b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience
- (i) Must hold Certificate of Competency of Master of a Foreign Going issued by DG Shipping or equivalent in the Indian Navy.
- (ii) 5 years' experience as Pilot after attaining competency in Handling all types of ships with unrestricted tonnage.

The department officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation

Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipt of applications

The terms & conditions of the appointment are;

- (i) In addition to the pay, the selected officer will be entitled to Dearness Allowance to Government Servants of his category
 - (ii) Special Compensatory Allowance as admissible under the rules
 - (iii) Rent free unfurnished accommodation, subject to general review from time to time or House Rent Allowance, in lieu thereof
 - (iv) Free Sea Passage once in a year for self and family members while proceeding/returning from leave in accordance with the orders in force from time to time
 - (v) Leave Travel Concession as admissible under the rules
 - (vi) Deputation Allowances as admissible under the rules
 - (vii) Tenure maximum four years
 - (viii) In respect of matters not specified above, the selected officer shall be governed by rules and orders in force from time to time in respect of Government Servants of his category serving under the A&N Administration
- The Harbour Master will be responsible for;
- (i) In-charge for all Pilotage activities in the Ports and shall also Pilotage in case of non-availability of other pilots
 - (ii) Over see maintenance of the flotilla and shall ensure safe navigational in A&N Ports
 - (iii) Overall in-charge for port communication & vessels traffic regulation
 - (iv) Work as Shipping Master
 - (v) Responsible for issuance of port NOC for sailing of outgoing vessels ensuring all statutory provisions
 - (vi) In charge for allowing/entry/exists of any vessels into/from the Ports
 - (vii) Responsible for conduct of survey/repair of all Afloat vessels
 - (viii) Assigned duty of IV Chief Surveyor as per A&N IV rules
 - (ix) Management of safety systems pertaining to Tankers, Explosives and Fire Stations
 - (x) Allocation of Port Office areas to Ship Owners/Agents/Clearing & Forwarding Agents etc
 - (xi) Undertake other works as and when assigned by the Conservator of Port/Chief Executive Officer/Chairman of the PMB
 - (xii) Port Facility Security Officer (PFSO)


