Commemoration of 50th anniversary of historic victory over Pakistan Army

Swarnim Vijay Varsh Victory Flame will be at A&N Islands from Aug. 3 to 28

Port Blair, July 29

In December 1971, the Indian Armed Forces had secured a decisive victory over Pakistan Army, and a new nation 'Bangladesh' was created. The victory also resulted into the largest Military surrender post World War-II wherein approximately 93,000 soldiers of the Pakistan Army surrendered to the Indian Army.

To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the historic victory,



the nation is celebrating Year 2021 as 'Swarnim Vijay Varsh'. The celebrations commenced with the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi lighting the Victory Flame on December 16, 2020. The Victory Flame was lit from the eternal flame of the National War Memorial and signifies the bravery of our heroic soldiers during the war. Since then the Victory Flame is travelling across the length

and breadth of India and a large number of commemorative events have been conducted during its journey.

On 31st July, 2021, the Victory Flame would be handed over to the Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC) at Chennai. The Victory Flame would be received by the Joint-Services team of ANC and on the same day it will travel on an Indian Navy Ship from Chennai to Port Blair.

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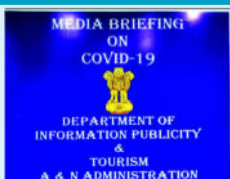

Media briefed on COVID-19 RT-PCR tests on incoming flight passengers instrumental in tracing & controlling spread of virus in Isles: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, July 29

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening reiterated the need to strictly adhere to COVID Appropriate Behaviour to protect oneself from the virus. He said, the cases in few States in mainland are witnessing an increasing trend and we cannot be complacent and let our



guard down. RT-PCR tests on passengers coming by flight from mainland are regularly being conducted and this to a large extent has been instrumental in tracing and controlling the spread of the virus in the Islands, he said. During the RT-PCR

test conducted on 330 passengers, who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. He informed that 325 persons bound for Middle & North Andaman were tested at Ferrargunj and one positive case was detected. Today, 2 flights with 330 passengers arrived here and the results of RT-PCR reports are awaited. The District Administration conducted mobile RAT

Tokyo Olympics: Men's Hockey team, P V Sindhu, Satish Kumar storm into quarter finals of their respective games; Pugilist Mary Kom bows out

Tokyo, July 29
In the Tokyo Olympic Games, India's campaign got a boost on 7th day today when Men's Hockey team, Shuttler P.V. Sindhu, Boxer Satish Kumar stormed into the quarter finals while Archer Atanu Das entered in the pre-quarter finals of their respective games.

Ace Indian shuttler P.V. Sindhu entered quarterfinals of women's singles event at Tokyo Olympics. She defeated Denmark's Mia Blichfeldt 21-15, 21-13 in just 41 minutes to cruise into the quarterfinals. Sindhu will now face Japan's 4th seed Akane Yamaguchi tomorrow at 1.15 pm in quarter finals.

In men's hockey, India beat defending Olympic champions Argentina 3-1 to enter the quarterfinals at Tokyo Olympics. By virtue of this win, India have consolidated their position in the second spot of Pool 'A' with three wins and one loss out of four games, behind Australia. The top-four make the last-eight stage from each group. India will play hosts Japan in their final pool match tomorrow at 3 pm and women's hockey team will meet Ireland at 8.15 am.

Indian boxer Satish Kumar has entered the quarterfinals of Men's Super Heavyweight category at Tokyo Olympics. He defeated Jamaica's Ricardo Brown 4-1 to reach the last eight in plus 91 kilogram category. In quarterfinals Satish Kumar will take on B. Jalolov of Uzbekistan on Sunday.

Indian archer Atanu Das progressed to the pre-quarterfinals of men's individual archery event at Tokyo Olympics. He defeated South Korea's Oh Jin-Hyek 6-5 this morning. In pre-quarterfinals Atanu Das will meet T. Furukawa of Japan on Saturday. Deepika Kumari, who yesterday defeated Jennifer Mucino Fernandez of US in the elimination round will meet Ksenia Perova of Russia olympic committee in pre-quarter finals at 6 am tomorrow.

Indian golfer Diksha Dagar has qualified for the Tokyo Olympics 2020 after South Africa's Paula Reto withdrew and Austria decided not to make a reallocation for their golfer Sarah Schober. International Golf Federation has reallocated that vacant spot to Diksha Dagar.

In boxing 49 kg women's category, Mary Kom lost to Columbia's Ingrid Lorena Valencia Victoria in the round sixteen bout 3-2. Mary Kom lost in a split decision against the 2016 Rio bronze medallist.

Directorate of CS&CA conducts enforcement drive in markets; offenders booked under Legal Metrology Act, 2009

Traders & vendors urged to refrain from unfair trade practices

Port Blair, July 29
Rigorous enforcement drive was conducted by the Enforcement Wing of the Department of CS&CA in all leading markets in and around Port Blair under South Andaman District to safeguard the interest of the Consumers throughout this month of July, 2021.

During inspection, it was noticed that 41 shopkeepers were using unstamp weighing & measuring instruments which is an offence committed under the Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2011 and 2 shopkeepers were found violating the provisions of the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 2011. All the offenders have been booked under appropriate provisions of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and the Rules framed there under.

So far, 20 offenders have appeared before the Assistant Controller, Legal Metrology to get their offences compounded and imposed an aggregate fine amounting to Rs. 71,000/- on them.

The remaining 21 suspected offenders have been given an opportunity to appear in person before AC(LM) of this Directorate to get their offence compounded. A compounding notice to this effect has also been issued to them directing them to appear within 7 days, failing which action shall be taken ex-parte.

Further, all the traders and vendors have been advised to refrain themselves from any unfair trade practices and get their weighing and measuring instruments duly verified and stamped as required under law. It is appealed to all the consumers that in case of any complaints regarding violation in weights & measures may be brought to notice in writing to the Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Port Blair. The consumers can also lodge their complaint over Toll Free Phone No. 18003453197 or landline No. 03192-230337, a press release from Directorate of CS&CA said.

launched today will make the student future oriented and will pave the way for AI-driven economy. Similarly, National Digital Education Architecture, (NDEAR) and National Education Technology Forum (NETF) will go a long way in providing a digital and technological framework to the entire country, the Prime Minister said.

The Prime Minister highlighted the openness and absence of pressure in the New Education Policy. He said that there is an openness at policy level and openness is also visible in the options available to the students. Options like multiple entry and exit will free students from the restrictions of staying in one class and one course. Similarly, modern technology based Academic Bank of Credit system will bring revolutionary change. This will give confidence to the student in choosing stream and subjects. 'Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning Levels', SAFAL will take away the fear of examination. The Prime Minister reiterated that these new programmes have the capability to change India's destiny.

Quoting Mahatma Gandhi, the Prime Minister emphasized the importance of local languages as medium of instructions. The Prime Minister informed that 14 Engineering Colleges of 8 States are starting to impart education in 5 Indian languages Hindi, Tamil, Telugu, Marathi and Bangla. A tool has been developed for translating engineering course in 11 languages. This emphasis on mother tongue as the medium of instruction will instil confidence in the students from poor, rural and tribal background. Even in the elementary education mother tongue is being promoted and Vidya Pravesh programme, launched today, will play a big role in that. He also informed that Indian sign language, for the first time, has been accorded the status of language subject. Students will be able to study it as language also. There are more than 3 lakh student who need sign language for their education. This will give a boost to Indian sign language and will help the divyang people, said the Prime Minister.

Underlining the critical role of teachers, the Prime Minister informed that from the formulation stage to implementation, teachers are active part of New Education Policy. NISHTHA 2.0, launched today will provide training to teachers as per their needs and they will be able to give their suggestions to the department.

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 2,92,004 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 3197 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1412 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 1007 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 1604 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 1472 were in the age group of 18-44 years. In Nicobar District, 181 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 91 were in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 90,486 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

No. /F.No.3-117/DIET/GC/2019 - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. U-14939/2/83-ANL dated 21st February, 1985 and in pursuance of DOPT's OM No. AB.14017/13/2016-Estt(RR) dated 09-08-2016 and in supersession of Administration's Notification No. 66 dated 05.04.2005, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi as received vide Letter No.7-77(2)/Edn/2018-19/114 dated 7.04.2021, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands is hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the Group 'A' posts of Lecturer (Gazetted, Group "A", Non-Ministerial) in the District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), Department of Education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely :-

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:-

(i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, DIET, Department of Education (Group "A" post in the DIET of Department of Education), Recruitment Rules, 2021.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. NUMBER OF POSTS, ITS CLASSIFICATION AND LEVEL IN PAY MATRIX:- The number of said post, its classification and Level in Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

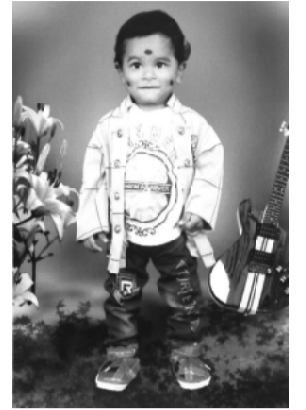
