Providing Child Health Screening & Early Intervention Services through Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram

31260 children screened in Anganwadi Centres & Govt. Schools across Isles

Port Blair, July 29
 The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, under the National Health Mission launched the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), an innovative and ambitious initiative, which envisages Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services, a systemic approach of early identification and link to care, support and treatment. Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is an important initiative aiming at early identification and early intervention for children from birth and

developmental related defects in the age group of 0-18 years. Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services basically refer to early detection and management of a set of 30 health conditions prevalent in children less than 18 years of age. These conditions are broadly defects at birth, diseases in children, deficiency conditions and developmental delays including disabilities-4D's. Children in the age group from birth to eighteen years including the newborn and those attending Anganwadi Centres and Government

Schools have been benefitted through this programme. Any effective health intervention will reduce both direct costs and out-of-pocket expenditure. Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services also aims at reducing the extent of disability, at improving the quality of life and enabling all persons to achieve their full potential. The Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is implemented in these Islands by the Directorate of Health Services. Regular screening of the children is being carried out by the staff of Health Department as

per the age group. For new born (0-6 weeks), facility based new born screening is done at public health facilities especially at the designated delivery points by ANMs, Medical Officers/ Gynecologists. Community based new born screening is done at home through ASHAs during which home visits for new born care in which screening of the babies born at home and the institutions till 6 weeks of age are done. For children 6 weeks to 6 years, Anganwadi Centre based screening is done by the dedicated Mobile Health Teams (MHT) while for children 6 years to 18

years, Government and Government aided school-based screening, is done by dedicated MHT. According to the data available with the DHS, altogether, 31260 children in the age group of 06 weeks to 18 years have been screened in Anganwadi Centres and Govt. Schools across the Islands (April 23-March 24). Those children who needed early intervention for birth and developmental related defects, diseases etc in the age group of 0-18 years were referred to the respective PHC, CHC, District Hospital, G B Pant Hospital for further treatment.

Under 'Kuposhan Mukta Panchayat Abhiyan', various activities are being intensified by convergence of different Departments as mentioned below:

> **Growth Monitoring:** Growth monitoring is conducted at Anganwadi Centers by Anganwadi Workers in consultation with Auxiliary Nurse Midwives (ANMs). The data is regularly entered into the POSHAN Tracker Application. Identified malnourished children are referred to the nearest health center for further assessment and treatment.
 > **Medical Assessment:** In addition to children with Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM), 14 severely underweight children have been identified at Diglipur Sub-division and referred to nearby health facilities for further treatment. Children with medical complications are also



Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) with strict hygiene and sanitation standards. The menu is designed to meet the special nutritional needs of MUW and SUW children, ensuring a balanced intake of protein, carbohydrates, fats, vitamins, and minerals. Local and culturally acceptable foods are included to ensure the meals are palatable and well-received by the children.

> **Sample Menu:**
 ♦ **Breakfast:** Porridge made from fortified cereals, milk, and fruits.
 ♦ **Lunch:** Rice or chapatti with lentils, vegetables, and a serving of protein such as egg or chicken.
 ♦ **Snacks:** Nutritional snacks like roasted chickpeas, boiled eggs, or fruits.
 ♦ **Dinner:** Similar to lunch, with variations in vegetables and protein sources to ensure variety.

> **Nutrition, Health Education and Counseling:** Anganwadi Workers counsel mothers and caregivers on nutrition, hygiene, and feeding practices based on growth monitoring results. They educate families about the importance of balanced

Discovery of a unique upside-down spawning behaviour in Charles Darwin's Frog of India

Charles Darwin's frog mates differently from other frogs and alarmingly uses human trash

Port Blair, July 29

An Indo-American team of Biologists from the University of Delhi and Zoological Survey of India, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Harvard University, and the University of Minnesota (USA) has discovered a unique breeding behaviour in a species of frog endemic to the Andaman group of Islands, India. In a new study published in the Harvard Museum of Comparative Zoology's Journal Breviora, scientists describe a combination of traits that makes reproduction in this frog unique. The Andamanese Charles Darwin's frog, *Minervaryacharlesdarwini*,



belongs to the family Dicroglossidae, a large radiation of Asian frogs that comprises over 220 species. Charles Darwin's frog naturally

breed as well as deposit terrestrial eggs above the water surface on the inner walls of water-filled tree cavities or root buttresses.

Hatchlings then drop into the water below and complete their development through a free-swimming tadpole stage. The posture of the mating pair at the time of egg-laying also makes Charles Darwin's frog unique: the pair orient themselves in a vertical, upside-down posture on the tree cavity walls with their bodies completely out of the water.

The uniqueness of this frog does not end there. Male frogs produce complex advertisement calls comprising three different call types for attracting females. They also produce an aggressive call. When aggressive vocalizations fail to ward off competing males, physical combat begins. These

The South Andaman District Police has successfully traced out a 16 years old girl who had been reported missing/kidnapped from a Computer Center at Middle Point, Port Blair on 24/06/2024. Through swift and diligent efforts, the dedicated team of Police Station Aberdeen worked tirelessly to ensure the safe return of the minor from Kolkata.

On July 5, 2024, the parents of a 16 years old girl made a complaint at Police Station Aberdeen regarding missing of their daughter since June 24, 2024, wherein it was mentioned that the girl left for computer class on that day but did not return back home. Upon this, an FIR No. 118/2024, dated 05/07/2024 U/s 363 IPC was registered at the Police Station against unknown accused person and investigation was entrusted to SI Nixon Isaac.

Following an intensive investigation with utmost sensitivity and professionalism, the location of the missing/kidnapped girl was traced to Kolkata. Immediately, a team led by Sub Inspector Nixon Isaac (Investigating Officer), Sub Inspector Arthi Roy and Head Constable Shiv Nath of Police Station Aberdeen was deputed to Kolkata to ensure the safety of minor girl and to apprehend the accused.

fights include kicking and boxing using hands and legs, and biting of body parts or even the entire head. Males compete aggressively to mate with females. If a male successfully mounts a female, nearby unpaired males may physically fight with the amplexant pair. They may even try to insert their head between the bodies of the pair from the back side to separate them. The defending male often kicks the intruding males with his hind legs. Simultaneously, and to avoid attacks, the female climbs the wall of the tree hole with the male on her back. The study suggests that the upside-down spawning behaviour in this frog may have evolved as a means of preventing aggressive unpaired males from displacing the amplexant pair from behind and disrupting egg-laying.

Although *Minervaryacharlesdarwini* appears to be an obligate phytotelm- breeder, the research team frequently observed frogs breeding in unnatural sites in disturbed forests, ranging from artificially watered plastic sapling bags in adjacent plant nurseries to rain-filled, discarded plastic, glass or metal containers left as trash at the forest edge. The lack of adequate breeding sites due to habitat loss and competition for limited resources may be driving the Charles Darwin's frog to breed in such unnatural sites. However, this species may not be able to survive in the face of increasing human dominance and rapidly changing landscapes on the small islands where they live.

The study calls for increased attention to the conservation of this endemic and threatened species (currently IUCN Red listed as "Vulnerable"), and to protection of its specialized and vulnerable microhabitats to maintain adequate availability of natural breeding sites. This field-based project was carried out over three years in the remote islands of the Andaman archipelago, which lies in the Bay of Bengal. Researchers spent over 55 nights during the monsoon season to study the secretive reproductive behaviour of these tiny frogs. The findings are published in "Tree holes to trash: unique upside-down terrestrial spawning, agonistic interactions, complex mating calls and unnatural breeding alterations in *Minervaryacharlesdarwini* (Anura, Dicroglossidae)," which appears in the current issue (29 July 2024) of *Brevoria*.
