

Women to get 26 weeks maternity leave, President's nod to new law

New Delhi, Mar 30

President Shri Pranab Mukherjee has given his assent to the Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act, 2017. Women employees will now get paid maternity leave of 26 weeks.

The 26-week maternity leave is effective from the date of publication in the official gazette, which is 28th of March. The amended law is not applicable retrospectively and its benefit can be

availed by women who proceeded on maternity leave on or after 28 March this year.

The new law makes it mandatory for every establishment with fifty or more employees to have the facility of crèche within a prescribed distance. The mother will be allowed four visits to the crèche in a day.

The Maternity Act also allows flexible work options so that women can achieve a balance between

work and care of the newborn.

Women and Child Development Minister Smti Maneka Gandhi said the new Act will mark a paradigm shift in the health and nutrition state of mother and child in our country. She extended her gratitude to Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, Labour Minister Shri Bandaru Dattatreya and MPs for the Maternity Act.

Property Tax to be calculated on Unit Area Rental Value basis

New methodology of assessment to be applicable from April 1, 2017

25% discount for widow & handicapped persons; 10% discount for women

Port Blair, Mar 30

The Port Blair Municipal Council has resolved to adopt the method for calculation of Annual Value for Property Tax on land and building on Unit Area Rental Value basis. Further, the Council in its meeting held on March 11, 2017, has resolved to revise the property tax calculation. However, the rate of Property Tax will remain un-changed i.e. as provided in the By-Law-4 of the PBMC Property Tax Bye-Laws-1999.

Sea Route connecting Port Blair-Baratang Isles

Work progressing in full swing; to be completed by October 2017

A sea route connecting Port Blair with Baratang Islands will be ready and put to operation for the passenger service soon. The Ministry of Shipping, Govt. of India has decided to develop sea route & land route parallel to Andaman Trunk Route (ATR) segment that passes through the Jarawa Tribal Reserve.

The proposed sea route will reduce the traffic, especially that of tourists, on the Andaman Trunk Road (ATR) passing through the Jarawa Tribal

Reserve, and also attract more tourists as the voyage will be passing through Mangrove Creek which can be enjoyed by the nature lovers. The project has already been cleared from environmental angle, work which is under progress, is expected to be completed by October 2017, ALHW sources informed 'The Daily Telegrams'.

Sources further informed that for the first time, the participating bidders were allowed to design and to do engineering works for the proposed Jetty on the Engineering, Procurement

and Construction (EPC) foundation of size 100 meters x 14.50 meters alongside the existing Vehicle Ferry Ramp at Baratang, sources added. The dredging works were taken-up through Dredgers owned and operated by M/s Dredging Corporation of India, a Govt of India Undertaking, and the work was completed by July 2016. The works for the Jetty are in progress while the Approach Jetty works were already completed and piling works of Berthing Jetty is under active progress.

The fund amounting of Rs.45.16 Crores for the project has been provided by Ministry of Shipping under Central Sector Plan Scheme and the project is undertaken by the Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works (ALHW). The project envisages components viz dredging of sea bed upto (-) 5.00mtrs in the channel at the mouth of Middle straight creek, dredging 3.40 Lakhs Cum Cum, construction of 12 Navigational aids founded on RCC bored cast in situ piles and construction of RCC Jetty on pile

ICC Rankings: KL Rahul climbs to career best 11th; Ravindra Jadeja, Ravichandran Ashwin retain top two spots

Dubai, Mar 30

India opener Lokesh Rahul, who hit two half-centuries in the deciding Dharamsala Test against Australia, on Thursday jumped 11 places to a career-high rank of 11th in the latest ICC chart for Test batsmen.

The 24-year-old Karnataka batsman had started the series in the 57th position and has gained 46 places over four Tests following scores of 64, 10, 90, 51, 67, 60 and 51 not out. Rahul is now India's third highest-ranked batsman after Cheteshwar Pujara (4) and Virat Kohli (5), who lost two and one place respectively.

Rahul is ahead of Ajinkya Rahane (14th, up by three places) and Murali Vijay (34th, down by four places).

In the bowling table, spin duo of Ravindra Jadeja and Ravichandran Ashwin have retained the top two bowling spots, while paceman Umesh Yadav has claimed a career-high 21st position following his performance in the fourth Test. Yadav took two for 69 and three for 29 in the match, earning him a rise of five places.

In the all-rounders' list, Jadeja



replaced Ahwin in the second position to be behind top-ranked Bangladeshi Shakib Al Hasan. Jadeja took four wickets and scored 63 runs in Dharamsala to walk away with the player of the series award.

Australia captain Steve Smith has successfully defended his number-one position and is currently 61 points ahead of his New Zealand opposite number, Kane Williamson, who has moved up two places to

second following his 176 in the Hamilton Test. Smith had entered the series against India, leading Kohli by 38 points, and finished as the most successful batsman with 499 runs in eight innings.

New Argentine FA president vows to get Lionel Messi ban reduced

Buenos Aires, Mar 30

The Argentine FA, lacking proper leadership since 2015 and fearful its national team might not reach the World Cup finals without banned captain Lionel Messi, elected a third-tier club chairman and former roadsweeper as its president on Wednesday. Claudio Tapia of Barracas Central, who play

in the Primera B Metropolitana division, was the sole candidate in the election but still needed the support of a majority of delegates, which he achieved by scooping 40 of 43 votes cast. He will serve a four-year term, but some of the power behind the scenes is expected to be wielded by his deputy Daniel Angelici, who is president of top

flight Boca Juniors and was a key figure in promoting Tapia's candidacy. Tapia, who is also known as "Chiqui" (little one), said one of his first tasks would be to get Messi's four-match suspension reduced and said it was imperative everyone got behind beleaguered coach Edgardo Bauza.

Saurav Ghosal enters Montreal Open semis

Chennai, Mar 30

India's top men's squash player Saurav Ghosal has entered the semi-finals of the Montreal Open, a PSA world tour event, in Montreal.

According to information received here, Ghosal overcame Arturo Salazar of Mexico 11-8 9-11 9-11 11-4 15-13 in the quarterfinal match of the tournament, which the Indian is considering as a preparation for the Asian Championship here next month.

The Indian, who is the top seeded in the event, registered a comfortable first round win over a qualifier, again a Mexican Alfredo Avila 11-2 11-7 11-3. Salazar, who had beaten an eighth seeded player, proved a tough customer. Showing greater firepower around the court, the Mexican had the Indian in knots. However, Ghosal showed a lot of resilience to shut out his rival. Ghosal will take on third-seed Omar Adel Meguid of Egypt next.

Rajeev Shukla to continue as Chairman of IPL GC

New Delhi, Mar 30

Rajeev Shukla will continue to serve as the Chairman of Indian Premier League's (IPL) governing council, Vinod Rai, the Chief of Committee of Administrators (CoA), confirmed on Thursday (March 30).

In February this year, Rajeev had addressed the IPL franchises as chairman of the Governing Council despite the CoA requesting all Board of Control for Cricket in India's (BCCI) members to self-assess

their eligibility to participate in the auction. The 57-year-old was the IPL Chairman until 2013, but he resigned from the post in the wake of spot-fixing scandal. However, he was reappointed as the Chairman of the powerful Governing Council in 2015. Meanwhile, the CoA revised the method for allocation of IPL funds in order to release payments to various state associations before they host their respective IPL matches.

New methodology..

2. The rate of Property Tax on Land shall be 3% of the Annual Value as per clause-4 (a) of the PBMC Property Tax Bye-Laws notified vide gazette notification dated 16.12.1999

3. Total Property Tax payable shall be sum of (1) & (2) above.

Discounts for Residential Properties

The total property tax calculated as per above under the Unit Area Rental Value method, will be subject to following discounts. However eligible person can avail only one of the discounts at a time:

1. 25% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of widow as per the Revenue Records.
2. 25% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of handicapped person as per the certificate issued by the Social Welfare Department.
3. 10% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of a female as per the Revenue Records.

Rebate for early payment of property tax on all type of properties will be provided. It will be based on total property tax minus discount as per above, will be eligible for 10% rebate on payment of property tax in advance of the financial year i.e by 30th June. For example to avail this rebate, the property tax for the year 2017-18 need to be paid before 30th June 2017 and the property tax for the year 2018-19 needs to be paid before 30th June 2018 and so on. This rebate will not be available for payment of earlier dues of property tax.

Exception: For the period upto 30th June 2017, if some eligible person chooses to clear the past dues of property tax (for 2016-17 and earlier years) under the Revised Unit Area Rental Value method, the rebate of 10% will be available as an exception. Thereafter, the rebate of 10% for early payment will not be available for dues of property tax for earlier years.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment will be applicable w.e.f 01.04.2017.

2. For the period prior to 01.04.2017, the revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment can be adopted by the eligible persons as their choice. Accordingly, those persons who have not yet paid property tax for the year 2016-17 or of earlier years, they may either pay as per the existing system (where the assessor will visit and calculate the tax) or may avail following options:

- i) In case of hotels to have self-assessment as per the revised Unit Area Rental value method of assessment and clear the dues by 30.06.2017 with interest @12% per annum from 01.01.2011 onwards.
- ii) In case of other properties to have self-assessment as per the revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment and clear the dues by 30.06.2017.

3. Those persons, who have already paid their applicable property tax, are not eligible for re-assessment and claim of refund.

All concerned may download the self-assessment form from the website of www.andaman.gov.in. Further the self-assessment forms can also be obtained from the Revenue Section, Port Blair Municipal Council on any working day, a communication from the Secretary, PBMC Shri Yashpal Garg said.

Turkey's Abeylegesse stripped of 1 world silver, 2 Olympic silver medals

Istanbul, Mar 30

Turkish runner Elvan Abeylegesse was today stripped of two Olympic silver medals and one world silver medal after a re-analysis of an in-competition doping test dating back to 2007.

The Ethiopian-born middle and long-distance runner tested positive on August 25, 2007, after winning silver at the 2007 World Athletics Championships in Osaka.

Track and field's world governing body, the IAAF, said in a statement Wednesday that her results from August 25, 2007, to August 25, 2009, have been removed.

The 34-year-old runner was also retrospectively banned from September 29, 2015, to

September 28, 2017.

That means Abeylegesse is set to be stripped not only of that world silver but also the 5000 metre and 10,000 metre silver medals she won at the 2008 Beijing Olympics.

The double distance gold she won at the 2010 European championships in Barcelona still stands.

Abeylegesse's name was the most prominent among 28 athletes cited in Turkey in 2015 as failing drug tests in re-analysis of samples from both the 2005 and 2007 world championships.

She reportedly tested positive for stanozolol, a steroid, but tried unsuccessfully to sue the IAAF for making technical errors in the testing.

Trainees of DBRAIT sensitized on fire fighting & rescue methods

In order to sensitize the private boat operators, the A&N Fire Service Training Centre imparted a special training for the candidates undergoing G.P. Rating (I.V) course at Dr. B.R.
