## Land ordinance to lapse; government to include suggestions in Bill

New Delhi, Aug 30  
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said the government has decided to allow the land acquisition ordinance to lapse tomorrow. In his address on the eleventh edition of Mann Ki Baat on All India Radio, Shri Modi made it clear that his government will not promulgate land ordinance, but include 13 points to reform the land acquisition law. It will extend the compensation and resettlement benefits under the law to land acquired under 13 Central Acts which were not covered so far, including highways and railways laws. The law provides compensation upto four times the market value in rural areas and twice the market value of land in urban



He also talked about misinformation campaign launched against the ordinance which has created a sense of fear and confusion in the minds of the farmers. He said the lapse of the ordinance would mean that the situation prevailing before NDA government came to power, would now prevail.



Shri Modi also said that government has moved forward in the direction of creating a department for agriculture and farmers welfare as announced in the Independence Day speech. Highlighting financial inclusion schemes, Shri Modi said over 11 crore families have joined the

social security schemes, namely Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Yojana and Prime Minister Suraksha Bima Yojana. Expressing happiness over the success of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, the Prime Minister said, nearly 17 crore 74 lakh bank accounts have been opened and 22 thousand crore rupees deposited within one year. He urged people not to discontinue their saving bank accounts. The Prime Minister said the recent Gujarat violence over the quota issue had upset the entire nation. He appreciated the people of Gujarat, saying their cooperation helped in controlling the situation. Shri Modi asked people to work together to resolve all problems through development.

## Centre launches SAHAJ scheme for online release of new LPG connections

New Delhi, Aug 30  
As parts of its consumer friendly initiative, the government today launched a scheme SAHAJ for online release of new LPG connections for the consumers. Launching the scheme at a function in New Delhi, Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan said, under the scheme, people can apply online for new connection and they need not visit to the LPG distributors for it. He said, the scheme has also been launched in twelve other cities.



The cities are Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Chennai, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, Patna and Pune. He said, the distributors can not force the consumer to purchase gas stove from their stores and it will depend on customer's choice. Shri Pradhan also said, the SAHAJ

scheme will be extended to other parts of the country in near future. Speaking on the Prime Minister's appeal of giving up the subsidised LPG connection, Shri Pradhan informed that around 25 lakh connections have been surrendered since January 2015. He also said, 22 lakh

new connections have been issued to BPL families in lieu of the surrendered connections. SAHAJ facility will enable the prospective customers to post online request for a new connection by filing Know Your Customer, KYC form, uploading photographs and bank account details. After submission, the

customer will receive the registration number to know the connection status. The customer may opt for online or offline mode of payment for connection. Electronic subscription voucher will be mailed to the customer and physical delivery of the Gas cylinder, regulator with hose pipe will be made by the distributor.

## Centre identifies 305 cities, towns for implementing 'Housing for All' scheme

New Delhi, Aug 30  
The government has identified 305 cities and towns across nine states for implementation of its ambitious 'Housing for All' scheme. As many as 305 cities and towns have been identified in nine states for beginning of construction of houses for the urban poor under the scheme, said a senior Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation (HUPA) Ministry official. The HUPA Ministry would provide assistance of over 2 lakh crore rupees over the next six years for enabling two crore urban poor own

their own houses. The selected cities and towns are in Chhattisgarh 36, Gujarat 30, Jammu and Kashmir 19, Jharkhand 15, Kerala 15, Madhya Pradesh 74, Odisha 42, Rajasthan 40 and Telangana 34. Under the 'Housing for All' initiative of the central government, named as Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana and launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on June 25 this year, two crore houses are targeted to be built for the poor in urban areas by year 2022, coinciding with 75 years of Independence.

**Sports Minister defends awards selection policy**

New Delhi, Aug 30  
Union Sports Minister Sarbananda Sonowal on Sunday said there was no need to review the selection policy for the National Sports Awards.

Paralympian H.N. Girisha moved a Bangalore court against Sania Mirza being conferred with the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna while wrestling coach Vinod Kumar moved Delhi High Court against Anup Kumar Dahiya being given Dronacharya award.

When asked about the controversies, Mr. Sonowal defended all the decisions taken by the selection panel.

"I believe everybody in this country has the democratic right to ask why [I didn't get the award]. But our selection panel did a very fair and transparent job and I don't see any reason to review the selection process," Mr. Sonowal told reporters. He expressed confidence that



India's Olympic preparation is going on in right earnest and the contingent will better its performance from six medals at the London Games.

"Everyone knows that we have created the TOPS [Target Olympic Podium Scheme]. We have identified potential medal winners and we hope they will

perform well," said the Sports Minister.

Mr. Sonowal also didn't read too much into the dismal performance of the Indian athletics contingent at the World Championship. "They have tried their best and they will certainly do better. I have confidence in them," he said.

India gained a handy 111-run first innings lead but Sri Lanka hit back with three early strikes to roar back into the game on a topsy turvy Day 3 of the third and final cricket Test in Colombo on Sunday. Rain stopped play in the final session of Day 3 of the deciding Test match.

On a dramatic day which saw fortune fluctuating from one team to the other, India had the game firmly in control by taking a decent lead which could have been much bigger but for some audacious counter attack by debutant Kusal Perera (55) and Rangana Herath (49). India was left gasping at a precarious 21 for three in the second innings allowing the islanders to neutralise the advantage.

Captain Virat Kohli (1) and Rohit Sharma (14) were at the crease when play was called off for the

day because of rain. It turned out to be a highly eventful day which saw as many as 15 wickets fall at the Sinhalese Sports Club. Though India had an overall lead of 132 with seven wickets in hand, the series decider was interestingly poised with both the teams in a position to wrap up the series with two full days still left.

**Usain Bolt sweeps third gold at Worlds as Jamaica wins relay**

Beijing, Aug 30  
Usain Bolt secured a sweep of the sprint gold at World Championships for the third time when he helped Jamaica's relay team to a fourth successive 4x100 metres title on Saturday.

The 29-year-old, who had already won the 100 and 200 metres events, ran the anchor leg as the Jamaicans took gold in 37.36 seconds at the Bird's Nest Stadium. Behind him, the United States was far back in second place. But Justin Gatlin, who had been unbeaten in two seasons of sprinting, lost the chance for a third silver when the American team was disqualified for a bad exchange on the anchor leg. "I saw the mess after 300 meters and was happy we were not in it," Bolt said. To the delight of the tens of thousands of fans in the Bird's

Nest, China moved up to silver and Canada took bronze. It was Bolt's third sprint triple in a row, starting at the London Olympics and continuing through the 2013 worlds in Moscow, and fifth overall. It was a record-extending 11th world gold for Bolt, who also won three sprint titles at the 2009 and 2013 world championships.

**Women hockey team qualifies for Olympics**

New Delhi, Aug 30  
The Indian women's hockey team has become the 10th side to qualify for next year's Rio Olympics. India had last played in the Olympics in 1980, the year in which women's hockey made its debut in the mega event, and finished fourth after losing to the Soviet Union in the bronze medal match.
