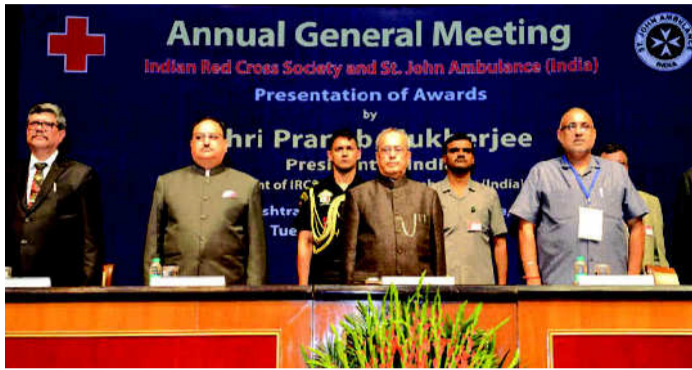

Luggage/ goods not permissible beyond specified

Passengers advised to carry baggage as per DSS Rules & Regulations

Port Blair, Aug 30
It has been noticed by the Directorate of Shipping Services that passengers while travelling on board Inter Island and Mainland Island vessels tend to carry heavy and bigger luggage which not only impedes the smooth embarkation process but also creates obstacles/ obstruction in the accommodation area, thereby causing inconvenience to fellow

passengers. Keeping heavy and bigger luggage in the accommodation area is also not recommended as it may cause obstructions and impediment during evacuation of passengers in exigency.

As per laid down Rules & Regulations of Directorate of Shipping Services, A & N Administration, the passengers in Mainland bound vessel are permitted

to carry personal luggage upto 55 Kg for Bunk Class and 125 Kg for cabin class, as accompanied baggage.

Similarly, in the Inter Island bound vessel the passengers are permitted to carry free baggage, personal belongings upto 40 Kg for Cabin Class, 30 Kg for Bunk Class and 25 Kg for Deck Class. The baggage in excess of free baggage allowances or any

100-year-old runner from India
inspires at Masters Games

Vancouver, Aug 30
Man Kaur from India needed almost a minute-and-a-half to cross the finish line in the 100-metre dash, but she still picked up a gold medal on Monday at the American Masters Games. That's because the 100-year-old Kaur was the only female competitor in her age category at the competition for older athletes. When she crossed the finish line in Vancouver, her competitors many of them in their 70s and 80s were there to cheer her on. Ms. Kaur's energy and drive to compete have become an inspiration to participants in the unique international event for athletes over 30. "When she wins, she goes back to India, and she's excited to tell others, 'I have won so many medals from this country,'" said her son Gurdev Singh (78), translating for his mother. "Winning makes her happy." After Kaur finished the sprint in one minute and 21 seconds, she stood smiling with her hands raised in the air. Asked how she felt, she breathed heavily and clutched a bottle of water, unable to speak. Earlier, she won gold medals in the javelin and shot put. Mr. Singh (78), who also is competing in the Games, said he encouraged his mother to start running at age 93 because he knew she could become a star. "I asked her, 'You
