

## Prime Minister dedicates world's tallest 'Statue of Unity', to the Nation on the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel



**Gandhinagar, Oct 31**

**The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today dedicated the world's tallest statue, the 'Statue of Unity', to the nation. The 182 metre statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, was dedicated to the nation on his 143rd birth anniversary, at Kevadiya in Narmada District of Gujarat. At the launch ceremony, the Prime Minister and other dignitaries poured soil and Narmada water into a Kalash to mark the dedication of the 'Statue of Unity' to the nation.**

The Prime Minister pressed a lever to commence a Virtual Abhishek of the statue. He also inaugurated the Wall of Unity. At the feet of the Statue of Unity, the Prime

Minister performed a special prayer. He visited the Museum and Exhibition, and the Viewers' Gallery. This gallery, at 153 metres height, can accommodate upto 200

visitors at one time. It offers a spectacular view of the Sardar Sarovar Dam, its reservoir, and the Satpura and Vindhya Mountain Ranges. The dedication ceremony was punctuated

by flypast of IAF aircraft, and performances of cultural troupes. Greeting the people of India on this occasion, the Prime Minister said that the entire country is

celebrating Rashtriya Ekta Divas today. He said today marks a special moment in the history of India. He said that with the Statue of Unity, India has given itself today, a towering

inspiration for the future. He said the Statue will continue to remind future generations of the courage, capability and resolve of Sardar Patel. He said that the integration of India by Sardar Patel, has resulted today in India's march towards becoming a big economic and strategic power.

The Prime Minister also recalled Sardar Patel's vision of the administrative services as a steel frame. He described the Statue of Unity as a symbol of the self-respect of the farmers who gave soil from their land, and iron from their farming implements for the Statue. He said the aspirations of the youth of India can be achieved only through the mantra of "Ek Bharat, Shrestha Bharat."

He said the Statue would also generate considerable tourism opportunities for the region. The Prime Minister mentioned that several memorials have been made to recall the contributions of freedom fighters and great leaders, in recent years. Besides the Statue of Unity, he mentioned the museum dedicated to Sardar Patel in Delhi, Mahatma Mandir and Dandi Kutir in Gandhinagar, the

**Plans afoot to build Swimming Pools in 3 Districts**

Port Blair, Oct 31  
With the objectives to promote sports in the Islands and to address issues related to sports, a meeting was held in the conference hall of State Library here this evening, in which officials from the Directorate of Sports, office bearers of sports associations in the Islands and sports persons from colleges were present. The Secretary (Education/Sports), Shri D Manikandan presided over the meeting. The Secretary, while speaking on the occasion informed that the Government of India is focused on improving sports in the country, and accordingly, sports talents from the A&N Islands will have to be spotted and nurtured in the right earnest. In this regards, sports associations of the Islands need to provide inputs and suggestions towards improvement of sports in the Islands, he said. Sports policy so framed, need to have vision and mission and the suggestions from the stakeholders will be considered for inclusion in the sports policy so that system can be corrected for further development of sports in the Isles, he said. Shri Manikandan said that available sports infrastructure needs to be upgraded and new facilities to be developed. The Administration is planning to construct swimming pools at different places in all the three districts, which will help in nurturing young swimming talents, he said. Steps have also been initiated to revise the incentives for Islands sportspersons, who achieved success and bagged medals at national and international sports events, he said. The Secretary assured that issues pertaining to sports associations will also be addressed accordingly. He urged the associations to follow the guidelines in election of office



bearers and members and for availing financial assistance so that financial assistance can be made available to them in time. The Director of Education & Sports, Shri Shubhankar Ghosh urged for timely submission of calendar of events by the association, which will help timely sanctioning of grants to them. He also urged for following the mandatory criteria in forming associations. Various issues and suggestions were put forth in the meeting by office bearers of different association. These include amendment of guidelines for forming sports association, the need for sending sportspersons to participate in national and international sports events to be sent through sports associations, development of synthetic tracks for Islands' athletes, making availability of at least two coaches for each sports event, good gym with trainers and counselors for sportspersons, strengthening the Sports Department, selection of association presidents from among sportspersons, timely disbursement of funds to associations and arrangement of at least three to four months training for sportspersons before participating in national sports competitions. It was also suggested that the Islands should have a Logo and State Colour for sportspersons participating at national sports events.

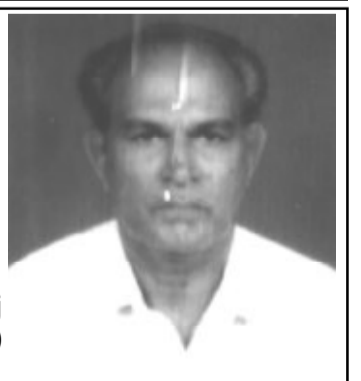
