PM hails countrymen for fighting new wave of COVID with great success

Urges people to not use Single Use Plastic and go 'Vocal for Local'

New Delhi, Jan. 30 Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said India is fighting the new wave of COVID with great success. Addressing the nation in his 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi said it is a matter of pride that about four and a half crore children have been administered vaccine doses till now. He said about 60 percent of youth in the age group of 15 to 18 years have

been vaccinated within just three to four weeks. He stressed that this will not only protect the youth but also help them to continue with their studies. Prime Minister highlighted that within 20 days, one crore people have taken the precautionary dose as well. He termed people's trust on indigenous vaccine as the country's strength. He called the reduction of COVID cases as a

positive sign. He however cautioned people to be safe, and added that the pace of economic activities of the country should be maintained. Today is the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. Shri Modi said the 30th of January reminds everyone of the teachings of Bapu. The Prime Minister noted that Republic Day functions will now start from the 23rd of January on the birth

anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. The celebrations will continue till the 30th of January which is Mahatma Gandhi's death anniversary. Prime Minister said a digital sculpture of Netaji has also been installed at India Gate and thanked people for welcoming this with enthusiasm. He added that in the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, India is re-establishing its

national symbols through these efforts. He said that the Amar Jawan Jyoti near India Gate and the Jyoti lit at Mahatma Memorial in the vicinity, were merged. At the National War Memorial, the names of all bravehearts who have been martyred since Independence have been inscribed. Prime Minister said that some former soldiers have

COVID-19 vaccination for children in the age group of 15-18 years of age which began from Jan. 3 is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands too along with the rest of the country. With the concerted effort taken by the A&N Administration and the Health Department, so far, 22,027 doses of Covaxin have been administered to children between 15-18 years of age, out of the 23,000 approx eligible beneficiaries under this age group. To cover maximum percentage of eligible beneficiaries especially students and to achieve the target, the Health teams are administering Covaxin to the beneficiaries without fail and the vaccination drive to cover



portal.

Apart from the eligible beneficiaries under 15-18 years of age, the administration of COVID precautionary vaccine dose for Healthcare and Frontline Workers and those over 60 years of age with co-morbidities which started from Jan 10, 2022 is continuing smoothly at different parts of A&N Islands. As per the guidelines issued by the Central Govt., no new registration is required to get a COVID precautionary vaccine dose and the precautionary vaccine dose will be the same vaccine as administered previously in the first two doses. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 5457 in the Islands. Those completed 270 days after

written to him saying that the Amar Jawan Jyoti is a symbol of the immortality of the martyrs. He said that just like Amar Jawan Jyoti, the country's martyrs, their inspiration and contribution are also immortal. These post cards have come from different parts of the country as well as abroad. He stated that these postcards show how broad and wide the vision of the new generation is for the future of the country. Prime Minister shared some postcards for the listeners of Mann Ki Baat. The Prime Minister emphasised that the enthusiasm of India's Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav is not limited to the country. He received 75 postcards from Croatia. The Prime Minister stated that India has been the sacred land of education and knowledge. He said great personalities of the country have also had a deep relationship with education. Mentally retarded child entitled to Family Pension: Dr Jitendra Singh

New Delhi, Jan. 30 (PIB) Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh today said that mentally retarded child of a deceased Government employee/ Pensioner is entitled to Family Pension and the spirit of this provision needs to be understood and respected. Giving details, the Ministersaid, this reiteration in public was necessitated by the fact that it has come to the notice of the Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare that in some cases the Banks are not allowing Family Pension in respect of a mentally retarded child through the person nominated by the Pensioner or his/her spouse and they insist for a Guardianship Certificate issued by a Court of Law. Dr Jitendra Singh emphasised that under the leadership of Prime Minister, the Government follows the Mantra of Good Governance for bringing "Ease of Living" to the common man. In that spirit, the provision for nomination for Family Pension is intended to avoid any hassle to the child suffering from a mental disability in obtaining Guardianship Certificate from the Court or in claiming Family Pension after the death of his/her parents. Therefore, he said, insisting for a Guardianship Certificate by a Bank in such cases defeats the very purpose of such nomination and also amounts to violation of the statutory provisions of Central Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 2021. The Department has, therefore, reiterated the provisions of the above rules. CMDs of all Pension Disbursing Banks have been advised to issue suitable instructions to their CPPCs/Pension Paying Branches for payment of Family Pension in respect of a mentally retarded child through the person nominated by the Government servant/ Pensioner/ Family Pensioner in accordance with the statutory provisions of the Rules and not to insist for a Guardianship Certificate issued by Court of Law in such cases.

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage crosses 165 crore 70 lakh under nationwide drive

New Delhi, Jan. 30 Over 165 crore 70 lakh COVID-19 Vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive in the country. More than 62 lakh Vaccine Doses were administered in the last 24 hours. Meanwhile, India's active COVID-19 caseload currently stands at over 18 lakh 84 thousand. The recovery rate is currently at 94.21 percent. Over three lakh 52 thousand patients have recovered in the last 24 hours. Over two lakh 34 thousand new cases were reported in the last 24 hours. Over 75 percent of the eligible population in the country is now fully vaccinated. In a tweet, Union Health Minister, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya said, with the mantra of Sabka Saath and Sabka Prayas, India has achieved the goal of vaccinating 75 percent of its adult population with both doses of COVID-19 vaccine. ICC U-19 World Cup: India beat Bangladesh by 5 wickets to enter semi-final

Antigua, Jan. 30 In the ICC Under-19 cricket World Cup, India beat Bangladesh by five wickets in the Super League quarter-final at Antigua last night to set up semi-final clash with Australia. Put into bat first, Bangladesh batters were all out on a paltry score of 111 runs in 37.1 overs. Indian pacer Ravi Kumar struck three wickets while spinner Vicky Ostwal took two



wickets. In reply, under-19 captain Yash Dhull won the victory target in just 30.5 overs losing five wickets with the help of Angkrish Raghuvanshi's 44 runs and Shaik Rasheed's 26 runs. For Bangladesh, Ripon Mondol scalped four wickets. Indian bowlers took two wickets. With this win, India will now lock horns against Australia in the Super League semi-final on Feb. 2.

Rafael Nadal writes history with 21st Grand Slam win, beats Daniil Medvedev in Australian Open 2022 final

Melbourne, Jan. 30 Rafael Nadal beat Daniil Medvedev in the Australian Open Men's Singles final and clinched a record 21st Grand Slam title. Sixth seed Nadal defeated World No. 2 Medvedev in a 5-set thriller 2-6, 6-7, 6-4, 6-4, 7-5 at the Rod Laver Arena in Melbourne on Sunday to lift Australian Open title. With this victory, the Spaniard has become the first man to win 21 Grand Slam titles. After being two sets down, Nadal



defeated Danielle Collins of the United States in the Women's Singles final at the Rod Laver Arena. Top seed Barty defeated 27th seed Collins in straight sets, 6-3, 7-6. With the win, Barty became the first Australian to claim a Grand Slam title on home soil in 44 years since Christine O'Neill in 1978.

Over 7400 Air India employees will get EPFO cover for social security benefits: Govt.

New Delhi, Jan. 30 Government has said that the social security benefits will be provided to around 7,453 Air India employees for whom contributions have been filed by Air India with EPFO for the month of December 2021. Labour and Employment Ministry said, these employees will receive extra two per cent employer's contributions in their Provident Fund Accounts at 12 per cent of their wages. The Ministry said, a guaranteed minimum pension of one thousand rupees will be available to employees and pensions to family and dependents in case of death of employee. An assured insurance benefit in case of death of member will be available in the range of minimum two lakh 50 thousand and maximum seven lakh rupees. The Ministry said, no premium will be charged to the EPFO covered employees for this benefit. (Source: india.gov.in)

No. 107/2021/F.No. 1-878/2019-D-IV.-- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. U-14039/2/83-ANL dated 21.02.1985 and in concurrence of the UPSC vide Letter F.No.3/30(02)2020-RR dated 20.09.2021 and also in supersession of all previous Notifications issued in this regard the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following amendments to the Recruitment Rules to Group 'A' Gazetted, Non-Ministerial posts of Assistant Professor of various discipline borne in the establishment of Jawaharlal Nehru Rajkeeya Mahavidhyalaya, Port Blair and Mahatma Gandhi Govt. College, Mayabunder.

1. Short title and commencement:-

(i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration Group "A" Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post of Assistant Professor Recruitment Rules, 2021.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application:-

These rules shall apply to the post specified in Column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay:-

The number of posts, its classification and the Level of Pay/Pay Scale attached thereto shall be as specified in Para 2 of 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in paras 5 to 13 of the said Schedule annexed to these rules.

5. Disqualification:-

No person-

- a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living, or
- b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under any personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

6. Powers to relax:-

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Savings:-

Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.


