E-rupee launch a landmark moment in history; will transform the way business is done: RBI Governor

Mumbai, Nov. 2
RBI Governor, Shri Shaktikanta Das today said that the e-rupee launch was a landmark moment in the history of currency in the country as it will transform the way business is done and transactions are conducted. He was addressing FIBAC 2022-organized jointly by the Federation of Indian Industry and Commerce (FICCI) and IBA, banking organizations in Mumbai. Shri Das said that the RBI wants to solve all aspects of Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) before launch. He added that the Central Bank hopes to launch digitized Kisan Credit Card loans in a full-fledged



manner by the calendar year 2023. The RBI Governor informed that last month Pilot Project was launched on Kisan Credit Card loans with end-to-end digitization. It is a digitized process for grant of loans and farmers need not go repeatedly to banks for sanction of the loans. On the inflation front, the RBI Chief said the Central Bank is closely

monitoring inflation trends and the effect of previous actions. He said that the RBI is seeing considerable improvement in sales of goods in the festive season. Speaking at the conference, Shri Das said that with monetary policy actions and policy changes due to a change in regime in the advanced countries, financial conditions have tightened across markets the world over and increased the financial stability risks. He noted that under uncertainties, the Indian economy has been growing steadily drawing strength from its macroeconomic indicators and buffers. India today presents a picture of resilience and optimism for the world.

The Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) was launched by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India with the aim to provide assured, comprehensive and quality antenatal care, free of cost, universally to all pregnant women on the 9th of every month. Launched in the year 2016, it guarantees a minimum package of antenatal care services to women in their 2nd / 3rd trimesters of pregnancy at designated Government Health Facilities and it envisages to improve the quality and coverage of Antenatal Care (ANC) including diagnostics and counseling services as part of the Reproductive



Maternal Neonatal Child and Adolescent Health (RMNCH+A) Strategy.

The Directorate of Health Services is implementing PMSMA in A&N Islands since 9th September, 2016. On 9th day of every month, all essential maternal health services are provided at identified Public Health Facilities

including examination by Medical Officers/Obstetrician. Under this scheme, 2643 pregnant women were examined during the period from January 2022 to October 2022 of which, 222 pregnant women with high risk were referred to G B Pant Hospital during the same period.

Extended-PMSMA has been added in addition to the existing PMSMA in order to improve individual High Risk Pregnancy (HRP) tracking and strengthening follow-up activities with additional three ANC visits for identified HRP by a Doctor /

In compliance of section 25 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or take any

steps to establish any industry, operation or process, or any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or

sewer or on land. As per section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981, subject to provisions of this section, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board,

establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.

It is the responsibility of the industrial unit to obtain Consent to Establish (CTE) from

On inflation, Shri Das further said that, domestic inflations remain elevated and the Central Bank is keeping a close eye on it. Financial conditions have tightened sharply across the markets and have accentuated financial stability risks.

Capital outflows have led to reserve losses, spiraling imported inflation, and currency depreciation, he added. RBI Governor maintained that Indian recovery and growth are more broad based. 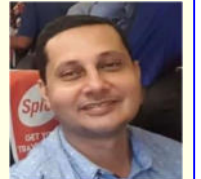

Under financial provisions, case based incentives are provided to ASHA Workers. Rs 100/- per HRP is provided to ASHA for mobilization of HRPs for a maximum of three follow up ANC visit to PMSMA clinics/ nearest facility for check up by a Doctor/Obstetrician. Similarly, Rs 500/- per HRP is provided to ASHA on achieving a healthy outcome for both mother and baby at 45th day after delivery after due verification by concerned ANM and MO.

Case based incentives of Rs.100/- per visit is provided to the identified HRP to meet transportation costs for attending a maximum of three PMSMA session/nearest facility for follow up ANC check-ups by a Doctor/ Obstetrician.

Non-compliance of this is in violation of the provisions made under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

Therefore, it is informed to all the stakeholders and general public that it is statutory responsibility of all the industries or units to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry & CTO after establishment in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The industrial unit/entrepreneur shall apply for CTE & CTO using the URL: www.anocmms.nic.in for the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974, Air(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

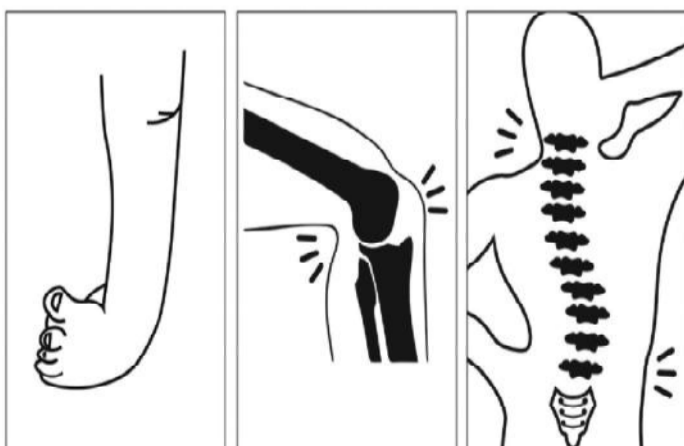
