Hon'ble Lt. Governor hoists National Flag at Flag Point commemorating the 82nd Anniversary of the First Flag Hoisting by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose in Isles



Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 30

The commemoration of 82nd Anniversary of the first Flag Hoisting in A&N Islands by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was observed today. This event marks a pivotal moment in India's history when the National Flag was first hoisted on the Islands, symbolizing the spirit of freedom and unity during the country's struggle for

independence.

The Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) hoisted the National Tricolor at a solemn function held at Flag Point today. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, Director General

of Police, A&N Islands, Shri HGS Dhaliwal, IPS, PCCE, Shri Sanjay Kumar Sinha, IFS, Adhyaksh, ZPSA, Shri Prakash Adhikari, Councillors of SVPNC, Senior Officers of the Administration and general public were present on the occasion.

The commemoration serves as a poignant reminder of the enduring legacy of the A&N Islands in India's freedom struggle. It was on these

Islands that Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, during his historic visit in December 1943, declared the A&N Islands as the first Indian Territory liberated from colonial rule and hoisted the tricolor. This annual event continues to inspire patriotism and a sense of collective pride among the citizens and serves as a tribute to the values of freedom and unity that define India as a nation.

District Administration (SA) reclaims 4,500 sq. mtr. Govt. land from encroachers

Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract finalized for 4 Fast Interceptor Boats of A&N Police

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 30

In a significant step towards strengthening Coastal Security and ensuring sustained operational readiness of maritime assets, A&N Police has finalised the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) for 04 Nos. 12-Ton Fast Interceptor Boats (FIBs) with M/s Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers Ltd. (GRSE), Kolkata, on nomination basis, in the presence of Cmde Samir Bera (Retd.), AGM, GRSE, and Shri Hargobinder Singh Dhaliwal, IPS, DGP, A&N Islands.

The 12-Ton Fast Interceptor Boats were supplied to the A&N Police during 2010-11 under the Coastal Security Scheme (CSS) Phase-I by the Ministry of Home Affairs. These vessels were designed, constructed and supplied by M/s GRSE, a



Government of India PSU under the Ministry of Defence.

Earlier, the AMC of

these FIBs was successfully executed by M/s GRSE up to July 2017. Subsequent attempts to

finalise maintenance through open tendering did not yield successful results due to non-participation of competent bidders. Interim and piecemeal repairs undertaken thereafter were found to be inefficient, costly and unsustainable. Considering the importance of Fast Interceptor Boats in coastal surveillance, the

26 to FY 2029-30 vide its Tariff order dated 28.10.2025 towards the Petition No. 151/2025 and has come into force w.e.f. 1st November, 2025.

The tariff structure and its applicability in the A&N Islands have been

revised as per the new JERC guidelines issued in December 2024. The objective of JERC for this revision is to rationalize the retail tariff framework by introducing simplified and uniform consumer

Precautionary & regulatory measures to be observed by Resort/ Hotel/ Bar establishments during New Year celebration

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 30

In view of the forthcoming New Year celebrations and the expected increase in public gatherings, all Bar/ Hotel/ Resort owners are advised to strictly adhere to the following precautionary and safety measures in the interest of public order, health, and safety:

1. Strict Adherence to the Bar Licence conditions by all Bar/ Hotels/ Resort
2. Crowd Control and Security Arrangements
3. Responsible Service of Alcohol
4. Fire Safety and Emergency Preparedness
5. Noise Regulation and Public Order

◆ All activities shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the license issued by the competent authority.

◆ Identity and age verification shall be ensured wherever necessary.

◆ Service of alcoholic beverages shall be carried out responsibly and strictly as per rules and licence terms.

◆ Adequate arrangements

for crowd management, including deployment of trained security personnel, shall be made.

◆ Entry and exit points, including emergency exits, shall remain unobstructed at all times.

◆ CCTV surveillance systems shall be kept operational and recordings preserved as required.

◆ Service of alcohol to intoxicated persons and to persons below the legally prescribed age is strictly prohibited.

◆ Fire safety equipment, including fire extinguishers, shall be available, functional, and easily accessible.

◆ Staff shall be briefed and trained in basic fire safety and emergency evacuation procedures.

◆ Overcrowding in confined areas such as dance floors, stages, or corridors shall be strictly avoided.

◆ Noise levels shall be maintained within

FIBs were being maintained by in-house PMF technical staff. However, the non-availability of OEM spares and proprietary components in the Islands led to delays in procurement and extended vessel downtime, necessitating the Annual Maintenance Contract, thereby ensuring OEM level technical support, assured supply of genuine spares, and reduced downtime.

The CAMC shall be valid for a period of 03 years, after a mobilisation period of 60 days, and covers preventive, routine and breakdown maintenance, deployment of trained technical personnel, supply of spares and consumables, and maintenance of minimum operational performance parameters. The contract also includes regular performance monitoring and reporting. The CAMC will significantly enhance the operational availability of PMF vessels and reinforce coastal security of A&N Islands, a press release from SP (PMF) said.

permissible limits and in accordance with prescribed timings under applicable laws.

♦ Any activity causing public nuisance or disturbance to neighboring residential areas shall not be permitted.

6. Cleanliness, Hygiene, and Sanitation

♦ Adequate sanitation and cleanliness shall be maintained in all areas, including restrooms and common spaces.

♦ Proper arrangements for waste collection and disposal shall be ensured.

7. Coordination with Enforcement Agencies

♦ Full cooperation shall be extended to Police, Excise, Municipal, Fire, and other Enforcement authorities during inspections.

♦ Any incident affecting public safety or order shall be reported immediately to the nearest police station or control room.

All concerned Bar/ Hotel/ Resort owners and proprietors are required to act responsibly and ensure that New Year celebrations in safe and orderly manner.

Any violation of the rules and regulations shall attract penal action under the relevant provisions of law, including suspension or cancellation of license, apart from other legal consequences.

This circular shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain applicable for the duration of the New Year celebration, a press release from SDM (SA) said.
