

## PM chairs high level meeting to review preparedness to deal with Cyclone 'Jawad'

### Directs officials to take all necessary measures to ensure safe evacuation of people

New Delhi, Dec. 2 (PIB) Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi chaired a high level meeting today to review the preparedness of States and Central Ministries & concerned agencies to deal with the situation arising out of the likely formation of Cyclone 'Jawad'.

Prime Minister directed officials to take every possible measure to ensure that people are safely evacuated and to ensure maintenance of all essential services such as Power, Telecommunications,



health, drinking water etc. and that they are restored immediately in the event of any disruption. He further directed them to ensure adequate storage of essential medicines & supplies and to plan for unhindered movement. He also directed for 24x7 functioning of control rooms.

India Meteorological Department (IMD) informed that low pressure region in the Bay of Bengal is expected to intensify into Cyclone 'Jawad' and is expected to reach coast of North Andhra Pradesh - Odisha around morning of Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2021, with the wind speed ranging upto 100 kmph. It is likely to cause heavy rainfall in the coastal districts of Andhra Pradesh, Odisha & West Bengal. IMD has been issuing regular bulletins with the latest forecast to all the concerned States.

## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

### 5,57,222 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Dec. 2 The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,57,222 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in Isles, out of the target



beneficiaries of 2, 86, 600 (approx.). Today, a total of 2362 people were vaccinated. 1988 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 9 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,75,952 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

**One awarded rigorous life imprisonment for offence committed under POCSO Act**

Mayabunder, Dec. 2

Shri Jimut Bahan Biswas, Hon'ble Special Judge under POCSO Act, North & Middle Andaman, Mayabunder has convicted one accused person namely Robin Majhi, R/o Kadamtala and sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life for the offence punishable under section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 and also to pay fine of Rs.2,00,000/-, out of which, 90 percent amount is to be paid to the victim girl as compensation u/s 357 of Cr.P.C, in default of payment which, the convict will have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year more.

A case under POCSO Act was registered in the Police Station, Kadamtala vide FIR No. 17 of 2021, dated 13/04/2021 on the basis of written complaint lodged by the victim girl. The fact of the case is that during September or October, 2021 when the parent of victim girl left their house leaving the victim to the house of accused, the accused dragged her into the room and forcibly raped her in the said locked room and also threatened her with dire consequences. As a result, the victim girl became pregnant.

For the rehabilitation of the victim girl, an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has been awarded as compensation as per provision of 357A of Cr.P.C from Victim Compensation Fund.

The entire prosecution case was conducted by Shri Keshab Chandra Mondal, learned Special Public Prosecutor (POCSO Act) Mayabunder, a press release from Office of Special Public Prosecutor (POCSO Act) Mayabunder said.

**Formation of cyclonic storm over Bay of Bengal; likely to reach west-central Bay of Bengal off North Andhra Pradesh - South Odisha coasts**

Port Blair, Dec. 2

Yesterday's Low Pressure area over central parts of Andaman Sea moved west-northwestwards and became a well marked Low Pressure Area over Southeast Bay of Bengal & adjoining Andaman Sea in the early morning on Dec. 2. It lay over southeast Bay of Bengal at 0830 hrs IST of today and it is likely to move west-northwestwards and concentrate into a Depression over southeast & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours. Then it is likely to move northwestwards and intensify over a Cyclonic Storm over Bay of Bengal during the subsequent 24 hours. It is likely to reach west-central Bay of Bengal off north Andhra Pradesh - south Odisha coasts around 4<sup>th</sup> December morning. Thereafter, it is likely to move north - northeastwards. Gale wind speed reaching 65-75 kmph gusting to 85 kmph is likely to prevail over central Bay of Bengal from the morning of 3<sup>rd</sup> December and gradually increase becoming 90-100 kmph gusting to 110 kmph over northwest & adjoining west-central Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours. For any emergency/assistance at sea, call Coast Guard SAR Agency at Toll Free number 1554, a press release from Disaster Management said.

**Captive rearing and breeding technology of anemone fishes**

Anemone fishes or clown fishes are the small sized marine ornamental fishes belonging to the family Pomacentridae. The name anemone fish came from its close association with sea anemone and clown fish because of its painted colour, like a clown. Clown fishes fetch high price in the global marine aquarium trade due to its aesthetic value. Captive breeding and seed production technology plays a major role to resolve the green certification criteria. Breeding and seed production of the three species viz. Amphiprion akallopisos, A. percula, and Premnas biaculeatus were standardized. Breeding and seed production of clown fishes have three important components viz, (1) brood stock development (2) the larval rearing and (3) live feed culture. In brood stock development the good quality parent fishes raise up to spawning, in which male and female fishes are selected from a group of clown fishes and fed with shrimp meat/ squid meat/ fish gonads/ clam meat at a rate of 5% of body weight thrice a day. In larval rearing the hatchlings are reared up to the advanced juvenile stage (2 to 3cm) for around 45 days. During the larval rearing the juveniles/ larvae are fed with microscopic live feed (rotifers/copepods) according to the mouth size. The live feed culture has two major components such as micro algal culture and zooplankton (rotifer/ copepod culture), and here the zooplanktons are fed with microalgae.
