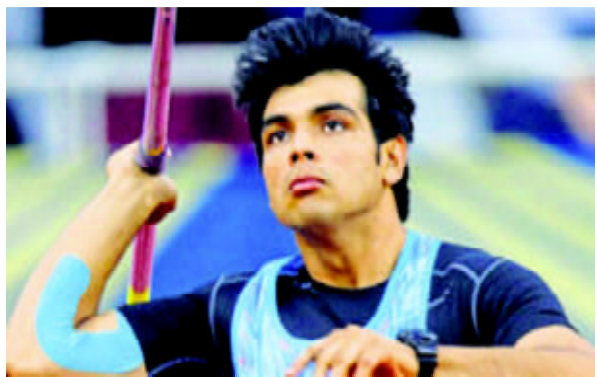

Neeraj Chopra strikes another gold, beats Chao-Tsun Cheng ahead of Asian Games 2018

Finland, July 30
Star Indian javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra won a gold in the Savo Games in Finland with an impressive performance, beating his Chinese Taipei rival Chao-Tsun Cheng as the duo warmed up for an Asian Games showdown. Neeraj, the reigning Commonwealth Games gold medalist and Asian season leader, threw 85.69m in the event held at Lapinlahti, Finland, where he is undergoing training as part of preparations for the Asian Games. Cheng managed 82.52m to take the second place. The 23-year-old Cheng is the only Asian to have thrown the



javelin beyond 90m. He threw 91.36m during the World University Games in Taipei last year to shatter the previous Asian record of 89.15m set by Zhao Qinggang of China at the 2014 Asian Games in Incheon. But this season, his best so far has been a 84.60m effort earlier this month in Sweden. Neeraj

has a personal best and national record of 87.43m which he did during the first leg of the Diamond League Meeting in Doha in May. Neeraj is leading the Asian charts so far this season, ahead of Cheng and Ahmed Bader Magour of Qatar (season best 83.71m).

Bajrang Punia wins 2nd consecutive international gold at Yasar Dogu International

Istanbul, July 30
In Wrestling, Bajrang Punia has won his second consecutive international gold while Sandeep Tomar had to be content with a silver medal at the Yasar Dogu International in Istanbul, Turkey. Indian wrestlers returned with 10 medals, including seven by women, from the ranking event. Commonwealth Games champion Bajrang, did not have to break a sweat as his opponent Andriy Kyvatkovskyy from Ukraine withdrew from the 70 kilogram final due to an injury. Bajrang had won a gold at the Tbilisi Grand Prix in Georgia early this month. In the 61 kilogram final, Sandeep, lost 2-8 to Iran's Mohammadbagher Yakhkeshi.



Vicky won a bronze in the 57 kilogram. In the women's competition, Pinki was the lone gold medalist in the 55kg category with her 6-3 win over Ukraine's Olga Shnaider in the final. However, Olympic bronze medalist Sakshi Malik failed to reach the medal round in the 62 kilogram category.

In the women's 53 kilogram and 57 kilogram categories, Seema and CWG silver medalist Pooja Dhandu won silver. In the 62 kilogram, Sarita grabbed a bronze. In the three-player 72 kilogram category, Rajni settled for silver after finishing second. Sangeeta Phogat won bronze medals in their categories.

India hold USA to 1-1 draw, progress to knockouts of women's hockey World Cup

London, July 30
Under pressure Indian women's hockey team produced a spirited performance to come back from a goal down and hold the higher-ranked USA to a 1-1 draw in their last Pool B match and progress to the knock-out stages of the World Cup here on Sunday. The draw enabled India to keep their campaign afloat in the tournament and progress to the crossovers while the Americans crashed out of the event. As per the rules of the tournament, the top teams from the four pools progress directly to the quarterfinals while the second and third placed teams will feature in the crossovers to decide the remaining four spots of the last eight round. Margaux Paolino (11th minute) broke the deadlock for world



no.7 USA before skipper Rani Rampal equalized for 10th ranked India in the 31st minute. The Indians started brightly with good forays into the US citadel but the forwards failed to breach the rival defence. India secured their first penalty corner in the seventh minute but the Americans defended well. As time passed by the Americans grew in confidence and started to attack the Indian goal quite frequently. From one such occasion, Margaux Paolino scored from

a rebound in the 11th minute after her initial try was kicked away by Indian goalkeeper Savita. Stung by the goal, the Indians continued to press forward and secured two penalty corners in the final minutes of the first quarter but drag-flicker Gurjit Kaur failed on both occasions as USA ended the first quarter with a slender lead. USA secured their first penalty corner three minutes into the second quarter but the Indians stood tall to thwart any danger.

Baker breaks 100m backstroke world record

Irvine (US), July 30
Kathleen Baker set a world record of 58.00sec to win the 100m backstroke at the US swimming championships. Baker, silver medalist in the event at the 2016 Rio Olympics, improved on the world record of 58.10 set by Canadian Kylie Masse at the World Championships in Budapest on July 25 of last year. Baker, who tied for first with Regan Smith in the 200m backstroke this week, clocked a blistering 27.90sec over the



first 50m and held on for the victory. She notched the first world record of the championships, the selection meeting for next month's Pan Pacific

Championships in Tokyo. The two meets together are the qualifiers for the World Championships in South Korea next year. The top three finishers all broke 5

Smriti Mandhana equals fastest half-century in women's T20 cricket

Taunton, England, July 30
India's star batswoman Smriti Mandhana equalled the record for the fastest half-century in women's T20 cricket during a Kia Super League encounter between Western Storm and Loughborough Lightning. Mandhana equalled New Zealand's Sophie Devine's record of notching up a half-century in 18 balls, set against India during a T20 International back in 2015. The Indian blasted a 19-ball 52 overall. Mandhana also smashed the tournament record for fastest fifty as her team beat the league leaders by 18 runs in a curtailed six overs-a-side match on Saturday night. Western Storm posted 85 for 2 in six overs as Mandhana blasted four sixes and five fours



during her 19-ball knock. Ironically, Devine, who was in Mandhana's opposite team, top-scored with 46 for her side but Storm restricted Lightning to 67 for no loss, inflicting their first defeat in three outings. Mandhana and Rachel Priest started off with nine runs off the first over, sent down by Lynsey Smith. Mandhana started with a straight six and then hit Devine

over long-on for another maximum in the next over. Mandhana then drove Jenny Gunn to the long-off boundary, followed by an elegant drive through covers at the expense of Kirstie Gordon. Mandhana hit another big six of Georgia Elwiss over long on and then hit her fourth maximum off Smith to equal the fastest half-century record.

International Army Games 2018 declared open in Moscow

New Delhi, July 30
The International Army Games 2018 at Patriot Park in Moscow region was declared open by Russian Defence Minister Sergei Shoigu, an Army official said. Indian teams are taking part in two major competitions - Tank Biathlon event at Alabino

ranges, Moscow region and Elbrus Ring competition in Caucasus mountains. The games are being held from July 28 to August 11 at 24 training grounds in seven countries namely Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Iran, Kazakhstan, China and Russia.

It is for the first time that Armenia and Iran are co-hosting events of the Army Games. The opening ceremony was attended by Indian Ambassador to Russia, Pankaj Saran along with Indian attaches attended the ceremony.

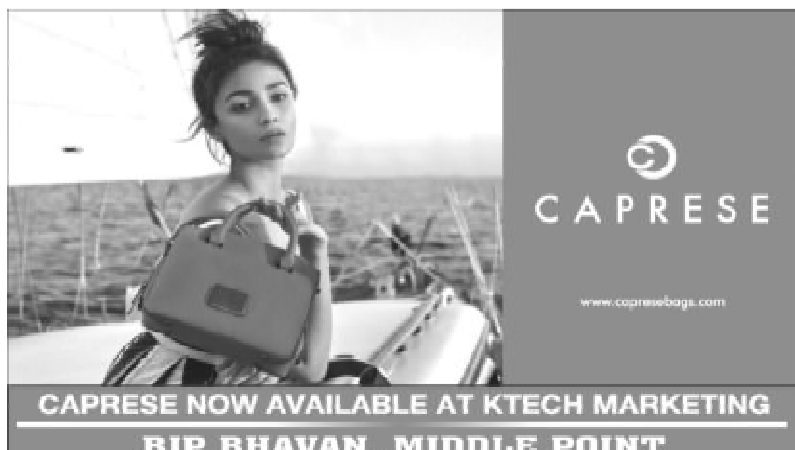
