42 Senior Secondary Schools achieve 100% results

Port Blair, July 30
The result of All India Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination 2020-21 (Class XII) has been announced today. In A&N Islands, during the academic session 2020-21, 67 Senior Secondary Schools (including all management) have registered with CBSE for conducting Class-XII examination 2021. The Directorate of Education, A&N Administration in a



press release has stated that the results of 65 schools have been received while the result of 2 schools are awaited and is expected to be received by the first week of August

2021. The release further stated that the compilation of results of 65 schools shows that out of 3670 candidates who appeared in the examination, 3638

candidates have qualified in the examination. 1 candidate has been placed in compartment and the results of 31 candidates are placed under RL

(Result Late). This year, the overall pass percentage of Class-XII stands at 99.13% with an increase of 4.07 % as compared to previous year result which stood at 95.06%.

It is heartening to note that this year, 42 Senior Secondary Schools have achieved 100% results as compared to 23 schools last year, a press release from Education Deptt. said.

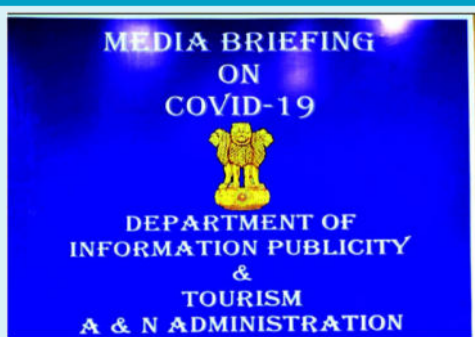

No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on flight passengers : Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, July 30
The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 330 flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. RAT test was conducted on 267 passengers bound for North &



Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and one positive case was found. Today, 2 flights with 327 passengers arrived here and the results of RT-PCR reports are awaited.

About vaccination drive which is being conducted in the Islands smoothly, the Secretary said, today till 3 pm, 700 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman, out of

which, 540 were between the age group of 18-44 years.

No...../F.No.3-117/DIET/GC/2019.-- In exercise of the Powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. U-14939/2/83-ANL dated 21st February, 1985 and in pursuance of DOPT's OM No. AB.14017/13/2016-Estt.(RR) dated 09-08-2016 and in supersession of Administration's Notification No. 66 dated 05.04.2005, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi as received vide letter No. 3/30(5)/2020-RR dated 07.04.2021, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands is hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the Group 'A' posts of Lecturer (Gazetted, Group "A" Non-Ministerial) in the District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), Department of Education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration namely :-

- 1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENTS:-**
(i).These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, DIET, Department of Education (Group "A" post in the DIET of Department of Education), Recruitment Rules, 2021.
(ii)They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. NUMBER OF POSTS, ITS CLASSIFICATION AND LEVEL IN PAY MATRIX:-** The number of said post, its classification and level in pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT, QUALIFICATIONS ETC.:-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in the columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. DISQUALIFICATIONS:-** No Persons-
(a) Who has entered or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse: or
(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:
Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation to this rule.
- 5. POWER TO RELAX:-** Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do he may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, if necessary, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class of category of persons.
- 6. SAVING:-** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Govt. from time to time in this regard.

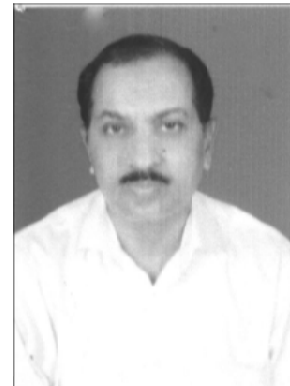

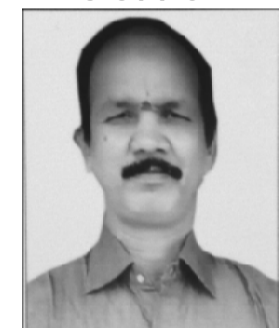
