

Ministry of New and Renewable Energy issues simplified procedure to install rooftop solar plant for the residential consumers

To develop National Portal for the consumers to avail subsidy, apply for net metering

New Delhi, Feb. 2 (PIB) The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has issued simplified procedure for the residential consumers to get the rooftop solar plant installed by themselves or through any vendor of their choice under the Rooftop Solar Programme. As per the new simplified procedure, a national portal for registering applications from the beneficiary, approval thereof and tracking progress will be developed. There will be a portal in the similar format at the level of the DISCOMs and both the portal will be linked.



The household beneficiary, who wishes to install Rooftop Solar (RTS) under the new mechanism will apply on the national portal. The beneficiary will be required to submit necessary information including details of bank account where the subsidy amount will be transferred. At the time of application, the beneficiary will be informed about the complete process and subsidy amount that can be availed for installation of the RTS plant. The application will be

forwarded online to the concerned DISCOM for issuance of technical feasibility approval within next 15 working days. After the application is transferred to the DISCOM it will also be displayed on the DISCOM portal.

After obtaining technical feasibility, the beneficiary will install the RTS plant from any vendor of his choice by selecting solar modules fulfilling the conditions of DCR and enlistment under ALMM and inverters which are certified by J3IS. The list of empanelled vendors will be

Gol issued guidelines for Ex-Gratia Assistance to next of kin of the deceased by COVID-19

All applications for ex-gratia have to be submitted to Deputy Commissioners of respective Districts

Port Blair, Feb. 2 Disaster Response for ex-gratia will have Official Document grievances with Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment in W.P. (C) No. 539 & 554 of 2021, the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Government of India has issued guidelines for Ex-Gratia Assistance to next of kin of the deceased by COVID-19 and recommended an amount of Rs. 50,000/- per deceased person including those involved in relief operations or associated in preparedness activities of COVID-19 subject to cause of death certified as COVID-19 and the said ex-gratia assistance shall be paid from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF). Accordingly, in compliance with the above guidelines and with the approval of the State Disaster Management Authority, the A & N Administration has ordered that the Deputy Commissioners of South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar District shall act as Disbursement Authority in their respective jurisdiction to disburse the ex-gratia assistance to the next of kin of deceased by COVID-19, in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs. All application for ex-gratia will have to be submitted to the Deputy Commissioner of the respective Districts in the prescribed format (published in the leading newspapers and broadcasted in the All India Radio, Port Blair on October 28, 2021) along with specified documents including death certificate that certifies the cause of death due to COVID-19. All claims must be settled within 30 days of submission of the application and disbursed through Aadhaar linked Direct Benefit Transfer procedure. The Chief Registrar/Registrar of Birth & Death/ CMO authorised by Chief Registrar, shall issue Official Document relating to COVID death to the family member of the deceased, who died due to COVID-19, strictly in accordance with the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Indian Council of Medical Research Guidelines communicated by MoHFW, Gol. In case of any grievances with regard to certification of death, the applicant may submit representation to the District Grievance Redressal Committee, which is constituted and notified for the 3 Districts. The District Grievance Redressal Committee shall be responsible to address any grievances with regard to certification of death as prescribed in the MoHFW and ICMR Guidelines and to propose necessary remedial measure, including issuance of amended official document of COVID-19 death after verifying facts in accordance with the guidelines and in the letter and spirit of Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 04/10/2021 in Misc. Application No. 1120/2021 in W.P.(C) No. 539/2021. India on its way to reach exports worth 400 billion dollars by this financial year: Minister

New Delhi, Feb. 2 month, and the total value has reached the figure of 334 billion dollars so far. Minister of Commerce and Industry, Shri Piyush Goyal told Lok Sabha on Wednesday that India is well on its way to reach exports worth 400 billion US dollars by this financial year. Replying during Question Hour, he said there is consistency in export values from last April at the rate of 30 billion dollars a month, and the total value has reached the figure of 334 billion dollars so far. Shri Goyal said the Government is in talks with countries like the UAE, Australia, the UK, the EU, Canada and many others to enter into Free Trade Agreements or Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreements. He said the move is to garner new markets for Indian exports and to the shift in the global geo-political situation post COVID-19 pandemic in aspects like supply chains. He termed the Productivity Linked Incentives scheme as a move that has come in at the right time to give impetus to the industry to take advantage of the changing market conditions. provided on the portal. In order to ensure quality and post installation services, MNRE will issue standards and specifications for RTS plant and a format of agreement to be executed between beneficiary and the vendor. The agreement among other terms and conditions will have the provision to ensure that the RTS plant installed meets safety and performance standards and that the vendor would maintain the plant for next 5 years or higher period as per terms of the agreement. The beneficiary has to install the plant within a specified period otherwise his application will be cancelled and he has to re-apply for installation of RTS plant. Upon installation of RTS plant, the beneficiary will apply for net-metering on the national portal, which will be forwarded online to the concerned DISCOM. The concerned DISCOM will either procure and install the net-meter or it will advise the beneficiary to procure the net-meter as per prescribed specifications and get it tested from the DISCOM authorized lab. The decision of the DISCOM will be posted on the portal.

After installation of the net-meter, the DISCOM officer will submit a commissioning and inspection report on the national portal, which will also be reflected on the DISCOM portal.

On receiving the inspection report, the subsidy will be released directly in the bank account of the beneficiary by the DISCOM. The whole process will be monitored and a grievance redressal mechanism will be put in place.

It is expected that the national portal will be developed in about six to eight weeks. Till the national portal comes into operation, the existing procedure for availing subsidy for installation of rooftop solar plant through DISCOMs will continue and will be the only authorized procedure to avail subsidy from MNRE. After the National portal set up, the beneficiary will have the choice of installing RTS availing either of the options.

The general public have been advised not to trust any misleading/spurious information being published on websites/social media particularly asking for registration fee or other payment for getting Government of India subsidy for installation of rooftop solar plants. Authentic information in this regard will be made available on the official website of Ministry www.mnre.gov.in or on SPIN portal www.solarrooftop.gov.in.
