## Government has changed the face of housing industry: PM

New Delhi, Mar 2

In an effort to stress on the use of advanced technology to meet the increasing demand of housing in the country caused by rapid urbanisation, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has today declared the period from April 2019 to March 2020 as Construction-Technology year.

Addressing the Construction Technology India-2019 Expo-cum-Conference in New Delhi, Mr Modi said, the quality of house and space per home has improved during



the NDA government's rule. He said the government is ensuring that houses have water, power, ujjawala connections and other

such facilities. Mr Modi said, the government has changed the face of the housing industry in the country and is committed to the

affordable housing to all by 2022.

Prime Minister said, his government has already

constructed one crore 30 lakh houses in the last four and a half years, while the previous government made only 25 lakh houses in its tenure.

Prime Minister said, GST in the construction sector has been lessened and in affordable housing, GST has been decreased to one per cent from eight per cent. He said the GST on the under-construction housing projects, has been decreased to five per cent from 12 per cent.

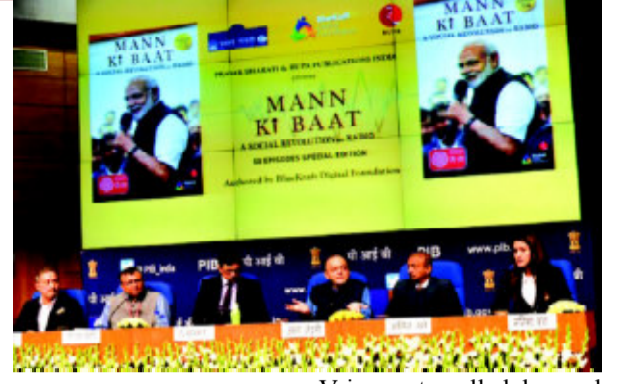

## 20th All India Livestock Census - Digital enumeration work completed in A & N Islands

Port Blair, March.2

The Livestock Census has been conducted in the country periodically since 1919-20 and so far 19 such censuses have been conducted. The Livestock Census usually covers all domesticated animals and headcounts of those animals is carried out during a specific time period. Livestock census helps in planning and preparing schemes and

designing strategies for improvement of Livestock Sector with an aim to increase the contributions of the sector to Gross Domestic Product of our country.

Presently, the 20th Livestock Census is being carried out across the country with the participation of States and Union Territories from 1st October 2018 onwards and will cover all villages and

urban wards in the districts of the Indian Union. Various species of animals (Cattle, Buffalo, Mithun, Yak, Sheep, Goat, Pig, Horse, Pony, Mule, Donkey Camel, Dog, Rabbit and Elephant)/poultry birds (Fowl, Duck, Emu, Turkeys, Quail and other poultry birds) possessed by the households, household enterprises/non-

## Mass livestock vaccination programme; farmers advised

household enterprises and institutions will be counted at their site. The initiatives on collection of breed-wise reliable information of various species will give vital information for determination of threatened indigenous breeds and to take initiatives accordingly for their conservation. Considering this aspect, the 20th Livestock Census would be a Breed-wise Livestock Census which will be helpful for framing policies or programmes for Breed improvement. The breeds of various major species including Poultry as registered by National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (NBAGR) will be covered in the Livestock Census. Further, the latest data on the 20th Livestock Census also includes fisheries part in which the information of fishermen families and infrastructure available for both inland and marine sector will be captured. This is of immense significance because as on date the last such data on Fishermen folk are available as per Livestock Census 2003 only.

The major feature of 20th Livestock census is that for the first time the operation is being done digitally in the entire country. The enumeration work is done through Tablet Computers which are loaded with a software specifically developed for the purpose by National Informatics Centre (NIC). It is expected that the data collection through the Tablets will be of great help in reducing the time gap in data collection, data processing and report generation. The Govt. of India has designated 31st March 2019 as the final date by which All India 20th Livestock Census should be completed. The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, A & N Administration is the Nodal Agency for carrying out Livestock Census in this UT and was one of the first State/UT to start the enumeration work by October 2018. Forty Tablets along with data card and power backup were used for collection of data by engaging Sixty-three enumerators who covered 576 villages and 24 urban wards spread over 3 districts of this UT. The enumerators reported to twenty-one supervisors who retrieved the data for verification before final submission. Five Scrutiny Officers were appointed to oversee the progress of the work and to randomly verify the enumeration work. The entire census operation was conducted by the State Livestock Census Unit of the Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services.

As on date 58724 households in rural area and 26270 households in urban area have been enumerated. The door to door enumeration work of all villages and wards of A & N UT has been completed and data verification and submission has been done by 28th February, 2019. If any livestock owner or household has been left out and not been included during the enumeration, they may contact the nearest Veterinary Institute/Unit with such details within a week, so that, action can be taken to include such additional data in the final report of 20th All India Livestock census, a communication said.

The MHA after examining the proposal submitted by the A&N Administration has forwarded the proposal with recommendation to the NITI Aayog, for consideration under Grant No.40 as per decision taken in the meeting held on 12.02.2019 attended by officials of MHA, NITI Aayog, MoRD and A&N Administration. Now, the said proposal is under active consideration by the Ministry of Finance, GoI, New Delhi as recommended by MHA as well as NITI Aayog for grant of fund to the tune of Rs.279.40 Cr. for repairs/improvement of 344.36 kms of black top roads for which Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, MP has also pursued the matter with the official concerned for early sanction of fund.

As per report, the Tehsil wise rural roads to be under taken for repairs out of financial assistance to be sanctioned are Diglipur - 57.49 kms, Mayabunder - 30.28 kms, Rangat 79.11 kms, Port Blair - 23.51 kms, Swaraj & Shaheed Dweep - 10.11 kms, Ferrargunj - 79.65 kms, Little Andaman - 14.82 kms, Car Nicobar/Kamorta/Katchal/C.Bay - 27.59 kms, Chowra/Teresa - 21.80 kms.

Besides this, fund for 250 kms of rural road for up-gradation under PMGSY-II will also be considered by the Ministry of Rural Development after receiving proposal from the UT Administration as per PMGSY guidelines, for which process will be initiated by the RD department in this regard shortly, a communication from MP Bhawan said.
