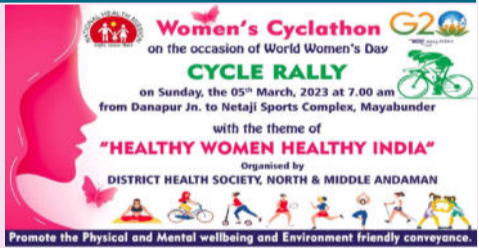

resilience, financial stability, transnational crime, corruption, terrorism, and food and energy security. He remarked that G20 has the capacity to build consensus and deliver concrete results in all these areas. He emphasized that resolutions for issues that cannot be addressed together should not come in the way of those that can be resolved. Underlining that the meeting is taking place in the land of Gandhi and the Buddha, the Prime Minister urged the dignitaries to draw inspiration from India's civilizational ethos of focusing not on what divides us, but on what unites us all.

The Prime Minister observed that Post World War global governance failed in both its mandates of preventing future wars and fostering international cooperation on issues of common interests. He further added that the tragic consequences of this failure are being faced mostly by all the developing countries and the world is at risk of rescinding Sustainable Development after years of progress.

The Prime Minister also noted that many developing countries are struggling with unsustainable debt while trying to ensure food and energy security for their people. He also noted that it is developing countries that are most affected by global warming caused by rich countries. The Prime Minister remarked that India's G20 Presidency has tried to give a voice to the Global South and also pointed out that no group can claim global leadership without listening to those most affected by its decisions. Shri Modi said that the G20 has a critical role to play in finding the right balance between growth and efficiency on one hand and resilience on the other. In the recent past, landslides have occurred in some parts of ANI due to underground water pressure, rainfall in monsoon season, earthquake, human intrusion etc. which causes damage to infrastructures, blockage of roads, loss of properties & environment. To safeguard people against such disasters, the Director (Disaster Management), A&N Administration, Dr. Nitin Shakyia has requested the residents of ANI to follow the Do's and Don'ts during landslides to save themselves and their properties.



- ◆ Build the landslide. ◆ Don't cross any stream or flooding river. ◆ Try to adhere to instructions given by the Government and do not ignore them. ◆ Do not ignore damp areas, any mark of cracks on roads and buildings.
- ◆ Be aware of unusual cracking or rolling of huge stones. ◆ Evacuate the landslide susceptible place as early as possible. ◆ Carry necessary documents with you. ◆ Carry emergency medicine kit, dry food, and drinking water etc, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.
- ◆ Keep a watch on the water in the stream or channel. ◆ Stay out of the path of debris or landslides. ◆ Keep watch on the road for mud blocks or debris overflow.
- ◆ Don't drive during the landslide. ◆ Don't cross any stream or flooding river. ◆ Try to adhere to instructions given by the Government and do not ignore them. ◆ Do not ignore damp areas, any mark of cracks on roads and buildings.
- ◆ Evacuate the landslide susceptible place as early as possible. ◆ Carry necessary documents with you. ◆ Carry emergency medicine kit, dry food, and drinking water etc, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

◆ Assess the soil before constructing your home or taking any property in a landslide-prone or hilly area. ◆ Make buildings away from the steep slopes, edge of mountains, drainage ways, or natural erosion

So far in 2023, total 2592 MV challans have been made against the traffic violators and Rs.16,77,000/- has been collected as fine amount. A total of 309 persons were booked for drunken driving & 7 persons were booked for rash & negligent driving and their driving licenses were also seized alongwith the vehicle.

Apart from this, to promote Road

Safety, a total of 21 road safety awareness programmes were conducted this year at various schools, offices & Panchayats etc. besides 3 meetings were conducted with commercial vehicle drivers & union leaders who were also sensitized about traffic rules and regulations.

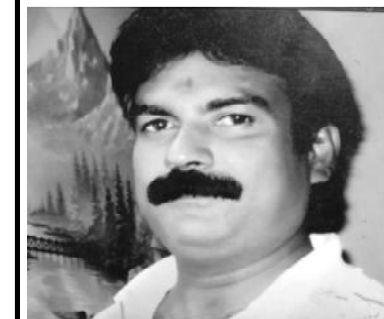
