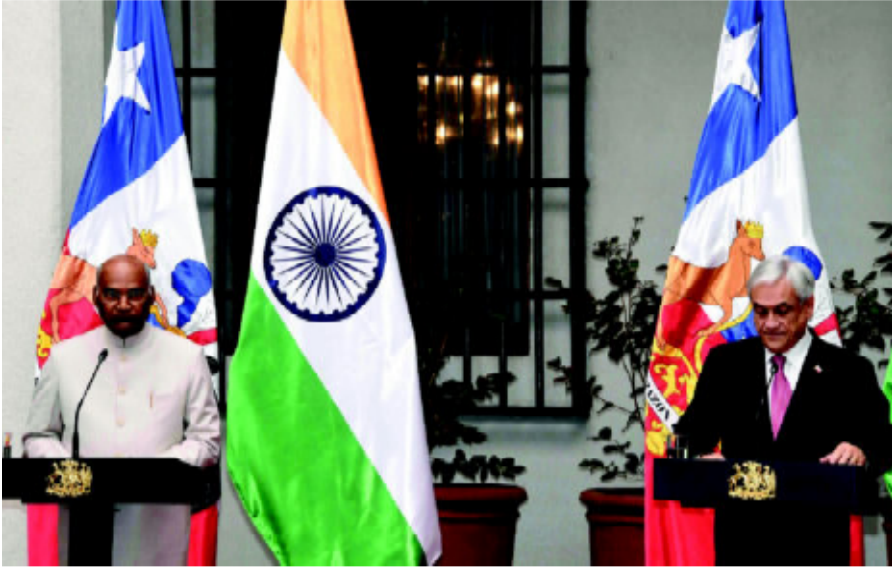

President of India in Chile; Addresses India-Chile Business Forum as well as students at the University of Chile

Chile, April 2
The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, reached Santiago, Chile in the evening of March 30, 2019 - the final leg of his visit to three nations - Croatia, Bolivia and Chile. On March 31, 2019, the President visited the Pablo Neruda Museum in Santiago. He gifted a special pen to the Museum made by the family whom Gandhiji encouraged to develop the first indigenous fountain pen in India. On the same evening, the President addressed a gathering of Indian community and friends of India at a reception hosted by Ms



Anita Nayar, Ambassador of India to Chile. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that in our quest for development and

progress, the overseas Indian community is an invaluable partner. Yesterday (April 1, 2019), the President commenced

his engagements with paying his respects at the Monumento Al Libertador General Bernardo O' Higgins. Thereafter, he

visited the 'La Moneda' Presidential Palace where he was received by Mr Sebastian Pineru, the President of Chile and accorded a ceremonial welcome. Subsequently, the President led the delegation-level talks between the two sides. Speaking on the occasion, he said that India and Chile trade relations are doing well. But the two countries can do much more. Chile is the fifth largest trading partner of India in the Latin American region. Copper

Third Edition of Bilateral Maritime Exercise between Royal Australian and Indian Navies - AUSINDEX-19 set to begin

New Delhi, April 2
The third edition of AUSINDEX, an acronym for Australia India Exercise is scheduled to commence with the arrival of HMAS Canberra (L02), a Landing Helicopter Dock, HMAS Newcastle(06) and HMAS Paramatta(154), both frigates; HMAS Collins, a conventional submarine and HMAS Success(OR 304), a Durance-class multi-product replenishment oiler at Visakhapatnam on 02 April 19. The aim of the exercise is, 'To strengthen and enhance mutual cooperation and interoperability between the IN and RAN, providing opportunities for interaction and exchange of professional views

between the personnel of the two navies'. A sign of strengthening of bilateral and defence cooperation between the two countries as envisaged in the Framework for Security Cooperation (FSC) announced by the Australian and Indian Prime Ministers in 2014. The maiden edition of the exercise was held in September 2015 at Visakhapatnam. Australia hosted the second edition of the exercise off Fremantle in June 2017, wherein ships of the Eastern Fleet of the Indian Navy (IN) exercised with Royal Australian Navy (RAN) ships and submarines.

Building on a long history of cooperation - including the shared experiences in the trenches of World War I in Gallipoli and along the Western Front - Australia and India have a positive defence relationship, underpinned by the 2006 Memorandum of Defence Cooperation and 2009 Joint Declaration on Security Cooperation. However, post the 2014 bilateral FSC the cooperation on defence and security matters between the two countries has gained significant momentum thus, witnessing conscious and focussed enhancements. Mick Schumacher makes his Formula One test debut with Ferrari in Bahrain

Manama, April 2
Mick Schumacher, son of seven times world champion Michael, made his Formula One test debut with Ferrari on Tuesday at the Bahrain circuit, where 15 years ago his father won the first grand prix in the Middle East.
The 20-year-old European F3 champion made his Formula Two debut at the Sakhr circuit over the weekend, finishing eighth and sixth in the two races.
The German, whose father won the Bahrain Grand Prix from pole position in a Ferrari one-two on April 4, 2004, will also test with the Ferrari-powered Alfa Romeo team (formerly Sauber) on Wednesday.
Tuesday's test in the SF90 was



Mick's first experience of a modern F1 car, although he did drive his father's 1994 title-winning Benetton at the Spa-Francorchamps circuit before the 2017 Belgian Grand Prix. "Obviously, with the name and being the son of Michael, there's certainly some links and expectations," four times champion and current Ferrari driver Sebastian Vettel said last week.

"The way he has developed in the last years, he deserves where he is now. Now we should give him the time and the peace to do his job." Michael Schumacher, who still holds the record of 91 grand prix wins, won five of his titles with Ferrari in a golden period from 2000 to 2004. He left the team in 2006 before a comeback with Mercedes from 2010-12.

Sameer suffers heart-breaking loss to Shi Yuqi in Malaysia Open

Kuala Lumpur, April 2
India's Sameer Verma put up a daunting effort before going down in three games in a pulsating opening round clash against World number 2 Chinese Shi Yuqi in the Malaysia Open in Kuala Lumpur on Tuesday.
The 24-year-old from Madhya Pradesh, who had lost to Shi Yuqi in the semifinals of the World Tour Finals in December last year, suffered a heart-breaking 20-22, 23-21, 12-21 loss in a 65-minute men's singles match.
Pranaav Jerry Chopra and N Sikki Reddy, however, made a good start to their campaign, eking out a 22-20, 24-22 win



over Ireland's Sam Magee and Chloe Magee in mixed doubles. The men's singles match was a close battle till 8-8, Sameer fall back to 11-16 but he fought back to make it 20-20 before being edged out by Shi Yuqi in the opening game. The second game was no different as the Indian was

lagging 11-16 again but this time he not only clawed back to 20-20. And even though the Chinese had grabbed one match point, Sameer reeled off three points to take the match to the decider. In the third game, Shi Yuqi jumped to a 9-0 lead and didn't allow the Indian to fight back.

Sam Curran becomes first England player to take IPL hat-trick

New Delhi, April 2
Delhi Capitals were seemingly cruising to victory over Kings XI Punjab before Sam Curran and Mohammed Shami swooped down on them in the death overs to spark a dramatic collapse. In the process, Delhi registered four ducks (five if you include Prithvi Shaw off the first ball of the innings), lost 7 wickets for 8 runs in the last 17 deliveries and Curran became the first hat-trick taker of the season.
Curran is the first Englishman to take a hat-trick in the IPL and the 18th player to do so overall. He is the third Kings XI Punjab player to do it after Yuvraj Singh (vs RCB 2009, vs Deccan Chargers 2009) and Axar Patel (vs Gujarat Lions 2016). Curran got his first wicket in his second over, which was the



18th of the innings. Mohammed Shami had just dented Delhi Capitals' cruise ship by dismissing Rishabh Pant and Ravichandran Ashwin then effected the dismissal of Chris Morris off the very next ball. Delhi would go on to lose all their wickets within the space of the next 14 balls in a capitulation that was of their own making as much as it was because of the Punjab bowlers' persistence. Colin Ingram was the first to fall to Curran off the fourth ball of

the 17th over thanks to a rather silly drive that went straight to long-off. His next wicket was off the last ball of that over with Harshal Patel nicking it to wicketkeeper KL Rahul. He then came back to bowl the final over and in the intervening period Shami had dismissed Hanuma Vihari, the last recognised batsman in the Capitals' lineup. Curran got Rabada off the first ball of the match with an inswinging yorker.

ATP Rankings: Roger Federer jumps to fourth spot after Miami triumph

Miami, April 2
Roger Federer jumped up one spot to fourth in the ATP rankings released on Monday after capturing his 101st career title with his victory over John Isner in Miami.
The Swiss great switched places with Austria's Dominic Thiem, who had briefly climbed to fourth after defeating Federer in the final at Indian Wells two weeks ago.
Rising Greek star Stefanos Tsitsipas moved up to a career best of eighth, while Canadian teenager Denis Shapovalov cracked the top 20 for the first time following his run to the Miami semi-finals.
Felix Auger-Aliassime, 18, soared 24 places to 33rd after matching compatriot Shapovalov's run to the last four in Florida before losing to



defending champion Isner. 6,040
Novak Djokovic remains comfortably clear at the top despite crashing out in the last 16 in Miami, with Rafael Nadal still well ahead of third-ranked Alexander Zverev as the Spaniard targets a return from injury for the clay-court season.

Breakdancing makes next move to Olympic status at Paris 2024

Paris, April 2
The Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) has recommended adding breakdancing, skateboarding, sport climbing and surfing to the 2024 Paris Olympic Games when the full membership meets in June.
IOC President Thomas Bach said at a news conference in Switzerland that making the Olympics more affordable and responsive has been a key aim for the committee.



He said, the addition of these four sports to the Paris medal program offer the opportunity to connect with the young generation. All four sports will be assessed in terms of how they are managed, the integrity of competitions and judging, before being finalized for Paris.

constitutes more than 85% of the imports from Chile. We must diversify our trade basket to further strengthen trade. In a major boost to furthering bilateral ties, Chile announced that it will allow visa-free entry to Indian nationals holding a valid US Visa.
