Delivering the 10th Foundation Lecture at SAI International School in

Bhubaneswar today, the Vice President said that education must inculcate social, moral, ethical and spiritual values apart from

seeking to empower the future citizens with knowledge and wisdom. 'What is important is your attitude towards fellow

citizens, other living creatures, protecting the environment and your commitment towards the larger good of the society',

he said. Shri Naidu also stressed upon the need to inculcate a sense of volunteerism among young students. He advised the students to join organisations like NCC, NSS, Scouts & Guides to learn life skills and volunteerism. PSLV-C45 successfully launches EMISAT and 28 customer satellites

Sriharikota, April 1
 India's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV-C45) today successfully launched EMISAT and 28 international customer satellites from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) SHAR in Sriharikota. This flight marked the first mission of PSLV-QL, a new variant of PSLV with four strap-on motors.



PSLV-C45 lifted off at 9:27 Hrs (IST) from the Second Launch Pad and injected India's EMISAT into a 748 km sun-synchronous polar orbit, 17 minutes and 12 seconds after liftoff. After separation, the two solar arrays of EMISAT were deployed automatically and the ISRO Telemetry Tracking and Command Network at Bengaluru

assumed control of the satellite. In the coming days, the satellite will be brought to its final operational configuration. Following the separation of

fourth stage engines were restarted twice to place the 28 international customer satellites precisely into a sun-synchronous orbit of 504 km height. The last

A&N Islands hit by 19 mild earthquakes

New Delhi, Apr. 1
 Nineteen medium intensity earthquakes, with a magnitude ranging from 4.7 to 5.2, hit the Andaman and Nicobar Islands on Monday morning, according to the National Centre for Seismology. The first jolt with a magnitude of 4.9 occurred at 5.14 AM, followed by another jolt with a magnitude of 5 a couple of minutes later.

The last jolt was recorded at 6.54 AM with a magnitude of 5.2, it said. Meanwhile, when contacted the Assistant Director, Disaster Management (Operations), Shri Ajayan informed that there was no loss of life and damage to property due to the earthquake near the epicenter at Campbell Bay. The Disaster Management is continuously monitoring the situation 24x7, he added.

Virat Kohli and Co retain ICC Test Championship Mace for third consecutive year

Dubai, April 1
India continued their dominance in the longest format after finishing at the top of the ICC Test Team Rankings on the cut-off date of 1 April, the International Cricket Council announced on Monday. Meanwhile, New Zealand ended at the second place in this list.

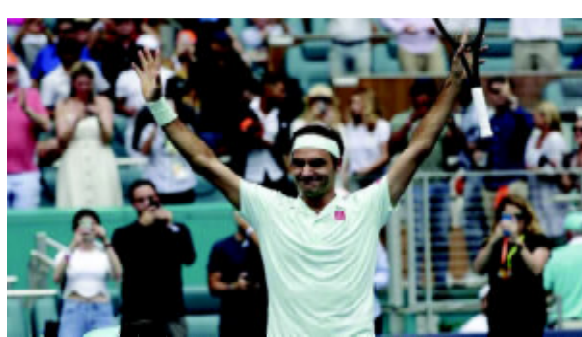
A top place finish was never in doubt for India, captained by Virat Kohli, the number one Test batsman in the world while New Zealand's consistent performances over the past year saw them climb from third position, needing them to only avoid losing the home series against Bangladesh last month to finish at the same position. "Retaining the ICC Test Championship Mace once again is something we are all really proud of. Our team has been doing well across formats



but it gives us extra pleasure to come out on top of the Test rankings. We all know of the importance of Test cricket and of how only the best can prosper in the format," skipper Virat Kohli was quoted as saying in the statement released by ICC. "Our team has a lot of depth and I am sure this will stand us in good stead once the ICC World Test Championship commences later this year. That is again something we are really looking forward to as it adds more context to Test match cricket." New Zealand, who also had the satisfaction of seeing their captain get the ICC Spirit of Cricket award for 2018, after finishing with 108 points, eight behind India. South Africa, who had finished second the previous two times, will now get a prize money of \$200,000 for finishing third with 105 points while Australia who edged out England on decimal points at 104 points bag \$100,000.

Roger Federer defeats Isner in Miami final for 101st title

Miami, April 1
Roger Federer lifted the 101st title of his remarkable career on Sunday, beating ATP Miami Open defending champion John Isner 6-1, 6-4 in just 63 minutes.



Federer has been the form player in South Florida and his performance against big-serving Isner proved it as the 33-year-old home-nation hero was overwhelmed by the Swiss star's incredible consistency. An opening break sapped Isner's confidence and allowed 37-year-old Federer to gain control of a match which he never looked like losing,

especially after Isner was injured near the end of the second set. "Getting a break so early was like a dream start. It relaxes your nerves and you now you in the match, Federer said after lifting his fourth Miami Open title. "What a week it has been for me." Isner appeared to tell the trainer during a medical timeout that he had "broken" his foot, but his spirit was crushed after dropping the first set in only 23 minutes. "Somewhere during the first set I started feeling pain on top of my foot and it didnt go away and it just got worse," Isner said.

India finish with 16 gold medals at Asian Airgun Championships

Taoyuan, April 1
Indian shooters continued their dominance claiming half a dozen gold medals on the final day of the Asian Airgun Championships to sign off with a total of 25 medals in Taoyuan, Taipei.



India finished with 16 gold, five silver and four bronze. On the last day of the competition, Yash Vardhan and Shreya Agrawal bagged three gold medals each. Yash finished on top in 10m Air Rifle men's junior event. He then clinched the yellow metal in Team competition with his partners -- Keval Prajapati and Aishwary Tomar. Yash scored 249.5, while Keval

and Aishwary shot 247.3 and 226.1 for silver and bronze respectively. Earlier Vardhan and Shreya combined to win the Mixed Team Rifle junior event. Shreya won the gold in the 10m Air Rifle women's junior event. She also won the Team gold along with Mehuli Ghosh and Kavi Chakkaravarthy. Shreya's gold winning 24-shots ended on an impressive 252.5, while Mehuli settled for individual bronze with an effort of 228.3. Kavi was fourth. Indian shooting's next assignment is scheduled at Al Ain, UAE where the ISSF Shotgun World Cup stage two commences on April 5.

Indian women's hockey team to play five-match series against Malaysia

New Delhi, April 1
Indian women's hockey team is set to play a five-match series against Malaysia in Kuala Lumpur, starting April 4. The match will kick off at 4:30 pm (IST).

Ace goalkeeper Savita, who will lead the side, believes the eight-day tour will help India in their preparation for the FIH Series Final in June. "Earlier this year we played in Spain where we did well against the hosts and Ireland. We will carry the same

confidence into Malaysia and look to improve on key areas which we felt needed to be worked on after analysing our performance in Spain," Savita said. "Whatever we are doing now is all part of the preparations for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics Qualifying event later this year and we are looking to improve as a team as well as our individual performance," she added.

Going into the tour with some key players missing due to injuries such as experienced striker Rani, midfielder Namita Toppo and drag-flicker Gurjit Kaur, Savita said the tour will be a good platform for the youngsters to step up and make use of the opportunity. "I think we have good depth in the team now with quite a few talented youngsters who have had good international exposure. They know what is required at this level and are aware of their individual responsibilities," she said.

ICC ODI rankings: Virat Kohli retains No.1 spot, Aaron Finch breaks into top 10

Dubai, April 1
Indian skipper Virat Kohli continued to remain at the numero-uno spot while his Australian counterpart Aaron Finch has broken into the top 10 of the latest International Cricket Council (ICC) Men's ODI rankings released on Monday. While Kohli is standing at the top spot with 890 points, his team-mate and Indian opener Rohit Sharma has also retained his second place and is standing with 839 points.



Finch saw a surge in his rankings after a superb run in the series against Pakistan which his side won 5-0 to bolster its confidence just two months before the ICC Men's Cricket World Cup 2019. The 32-year-old's player of the series effort of 451 runs, with two centuries and at an average of 112.75, has seen him gain 12 slots to reach joint-ninth position, even as his other team-mates too made important gains in the list of batsmen with memorable efforts in the five-match series in the United Arab Emirates. Finch's opening partner Usman Khawaja has gained six slots to reach 19th position after scoring 272 runs in the series while Glenn Maxwell has advanced 10 places to reach 23rd place with 258 runs.

customer satellite was placed into its designated orbit 1 hour and 55 minutes after lift-off.

About 3 hours after lift-off, the fourth stage (PS4) of the vehicle was moved to a lower circular orbit of 485 km after two restarts to establish it as an orbital platform for carrying out experiments with its three payloads. EMISAT is a satellite built around ISRO's Mini Satellite-2 bus weighing about 436 kg. The satellite is intended for electromagnetic spectrum measurement.

The 28 international customer satellites, together weighing about 220 kg, are from four countries, namely, Lithuania (2), Spain (1), Switzerland (1) and USA (24). These foreign satellites were launched as part of commercial arrangements. The payloads carried by PS4 are Automatic Identification System from ISRO, Automatic Packet Repeating System from AMSAT, India and Advanced Retarding Potential Analyzer for ionospheric studies from Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology. ISRO Chairman Dr K Sivan congratulated the launch vehicle and satellite teams involved in the mission.

"Today's PSLV mission was unique in several ways. It was a four strap-on new variant, the vehicle achieved three different orbits and for the first the PS4 stage is powered by solar panels," Dr Sivan said. He added that a new PSLV team executed today's mission. Dr Sivan also placed on record the significant involvement of the industry in this mission. So far, PSLV has launched 46 national satellites, 10 satellites built by students from Indian Universities and 297 international customer satellites, including the satellites launched today. In its next mission, PSLV-C46 will launch RISAT-2B in May 2019.
