Taking into consideration the severity of the pandemic, with many deaths in the country and in the Islands too, vaccines are the only effective solution against COVID-19. The second wave of COVID-19 outbreak in A&N Islands continues to touch new high in terms of daily cases despite repeated requests made to the people by the Administration to get themselves vaccinated and follow COVID appropriate behavior to protect themselves. 3,92,000 cases registered in the past 24 hours across the country

New Delhi, May 2

The active number of corona virus cases is continuously rising in the country due to spike in cases in several States and Union Territories. As a result, the recovery rate is continuously declining in the country. However, India has registered over three lakh recoveries in a single day from this infectious disease.

The Health and Family Welfare Ministry said, over three lakh seven thousand patients have recovered within 24 hours. So far, over one crore 59 lakh patients have already been recovered from corona virus in the country. However, with the rising number of fresh cases, the recovery rate has further declined to 81.7 per cent.

The Ministry also said, there are over 33,49,000 active cases in the country at present which comprises 17.12 per cent of the total positive cases. The Health Ministry has said, over 3,689 deaths have been reported in the country within 24 hours, taking the toll to over two lakh 15 thousand across the country. The Ministry also said, over 3,92,000 cases

Govt. of India has so far provided more 16.54 crore vaccine doses to States/UTs Free of Cost

New Delhi, May 2

Government of India is leading the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic in collaboration with the States and UT through a "Whole of Government" approach. Vaccination forms an integral component of the five point strategy of Government of India of containment and management of the pandemic (including Test, Track, Treat and COVID Appropriate Behaviour).

Implementation of the Liberalised and Accelerated Phase 3 Strategy of Covid-19 Vaccination has started from 1st May 2021. Registration for the new eligible population groups has commenced since 28th April. Potential beneficiaries can either register directly on CoWIN portal (cowin.gov.in) or through the AarogyaSetu app.

Government of India has so far provided nearly 16.54 crore vaccine doses (16,54,93,410) to States/UTs

Free of Cost. Of this, the total consumption including wastages is 15,76,32,631 doses (as per data available at 8 am today).

More than 78 lakh COVID Vaccine doses (78,60,779) are still available with the States/UTs to be administered.

Furthermore, more than 56 lakh (56,20,670) vaccine doses will be received in addition by the States/UTs within the next 3 days. (Source: PIB)

Govt. announces various relief measures for taxpayers under GST law in view of severe COVID-19 pandemic

New Delhi, May 2

In view of the challenges faced by taxpayers in meeting the statutory and regulatory compliances under Goods & Services Tax (GST) law due to the outbreak of the second wave of COVID-19 pandemic, the Government has issued notifications, all dated 1st May, 2021, providing various relief measures for taxpayers. These measures are explained below:

Reduction in rate of interest:

Concessional rates of interest in lieu of the normal rate of interest of 18% per annum for delayed tax payments have been prescribed in the following cases.

For registered persons having aggregate turnover above Rs. 5 crore: A lower rate of interest of 9 per cent for the first 15 days from the due date of payment of tax and 18 per cent thereafter, for the tax payable for tax periods March 2021 and April 2021, payable in April 2021 and May 2021 respectively, has been notified.

For registered persons having aggregate turnover upto Rs. 5 crore: Nil rate of interest for the first 15 days from the due date of payment of tax, 9 per cent for the next 15 days, and 18 per cent thereafter, for both normal taxpayers and those under QRMP scheme, for the tax payable for the periods March 2021 and April 2021, payable in April 2021 and May 2021 respectively, has been notified.

For registered persons who have

opted to pay tax under the Composition scheme: NIL rate of interest for first 15 days from the due date of payment of tax and 9 per cent for the next 15 days, and 18 per cent thereafter has been notified for the tax payable for the quarter ending 31st March, 2021, payable in April 2021.

Waiver of late fee

For registered persons having aggregate turnover above Rs. 5 crore: Late fee waived for 15 days in respect of returns in FORM GSTR-3B furnished beyond the due date for tax periods March, 2021 and April, 2021, due in the April 2021 and May 2021 respectively;

For registered persons having aggregate turnover upto Rs. 5 crore: Late fee waived for 30 days in respect of the returns in FORM GSTR-3B furnished beyond the due date for tax periods March, 2021 and April, 2021 (for taxpayers filing monthly returns) due in April 2021 and May 2021 respectively / and for period Jan-March, 2021 (for taxpayers filing quarterly returns under QRMP scheme) due in April 2021.

Extension of due date of filing GSTR-1, IFF, GSTR-4 and ITC-04 Due date of filing FORM GSTR-1 and IFF for the month of April (due in May) has been extended by 15 days.

Due date of filing FORM GSTR-4 for FY 2020-21 has been extended from 30th April, 2021 to 31st May, 2021.

Due date of furnishing FORM ITC-



04 for Jan-March, 2021 quarter has been extended from 25th April, 2021 to 31st May, 2021.

Certain amendments in CGST Rules:

Relaxation in availment of ITC: Rule 36(4) i.e. 105% cap on availment of ITC in FORM GSTR-3B to be applicable on cumulative basis for period April and May 2021, to be applied in the return for tax period May 2021. Otherwise, rule 36(4) is applicable for each tax period.

The filing of GSTR-3B and GSTR-1/ IFF by companies using electronic verification code has already been enabled for the period from the 27.04.2021 to 31.05.2021.

Extension in statutory time limits under section 168A of the CGST Act: Time limit for completion of various actions, by any authority or by any person, under the GST Act, which falls during the period from 15th April, 2021 to 30th May, 2021, has been extended upto 31st May, 2021, subject to some exceptions as specified in the notification. (Source: PIB)

India receives more foreign aid of medicines, medical equipment & oxygen

New Delhi, May 2

India has received more foreign aid of medicines, medical equipment and oxygen. Another flight from US arrived in India last night carrying over one thousand oxygen cylinders, regulators and other medical equipment. The third shipment in a period of two days adding to the oxygen capacities in India. The Ministry of External Affairs thanked US for its support.

Hundred oxygen concentrators and other medical supplies sent by Government of Uzbekistan also reached India last night. The Indian community in Uzbekistan has donated another 51 oxygen concentrators.

The Ministry of External Affairs thanked Government of Uzbekistan and the Indian



community there for it.

Yesterday, 120 ventilators arrived from Germany. Sources said Germany will send one mobile oxygen production and filling plant next week. 13 German Technical Personnel have come to India for installation and training. Sources said that a consignment of Remdesivir and monoclonal is also set to come. German agency would organize a webinar on

virus sequencing with Indian technical team.

In addition, procurement from private German companies is being made. 24 oxygen transport tanks were procured from German company Linde by Tata. Oil India Corporation Limited is procuring four oxygen tanks from German company Albatross. (Source: india.gov.in)

India's Cumulative Vaccination Coverage exceeds 15.68 Crore as Phase-3 of Nationwide Vaccination Drive commences

New Delhi, May 2

The Government of India along with States/UTs through a 'Whole of Government' approach has embarked on a five-point strategy for prevention, containment, and management of the COVID-19 pandemic in the country. Vaccination forms an integral component of the five-point strategy including Test, Track, Treat, and COVID Appropriate Behaviour.

The cumulative number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country has crossed 15.68 Cr today as the Phase-3 of the nationwide Vaccination Drive commenced yesterday.

The Liberalized and Accelerated Phase-3 Strategy of Covid-19 Vaccination has come into force from yesterday (1st May 2021). Registration for the newly eligible population groups had commenced on 28th April.

86,023 beneficiaries of the age group 18-44 years received their first dose of COVID vaccine across 11 States.


These states are Chhattisgarh (987), Delhi (1,472), Gujarat (51,622), Jammu and Kashmir (201), Karnataka (649), Maharashtra (12,525), Odisha (97), Punjab (298), Rajasthan (1853), Tamil Nadu (527) and UP (15,792).

Cumulatively, 15,68,16,031

vaccine doses have been administered through 22,93,911 sessions, as per the provisional report till 7 am today.

These include 94,28,490 HCWs who have taken the 1st dose and 62,65,397 HCWs who have taken the 2nd dose, 1,27,57,529 FLWs (1st dose), 69,22,093 FLWs (2nd dose), 86,023 beneficiaries under 18-45 age group (1st dose), 5,26,18,135 1st dose beneficiaries and 1,14,49,310 2nd dose beneficiaries more than 60 years old and 5,32,80,976 (1st dose) and 40,08,078 (2nd dose) beneficiaries aged 45 to 60 years. 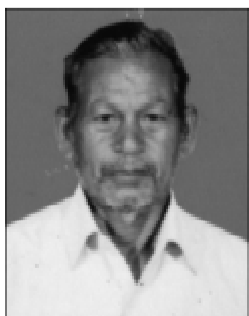

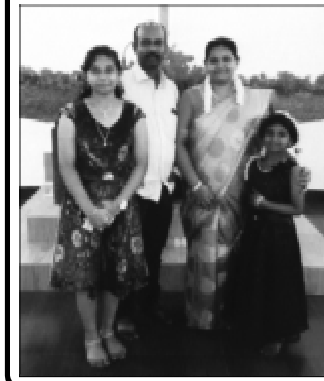
