New Delhi, Aug. 2 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched digital payment solution e-RUPI, a person and purpose specific digital payment solution, today via video conference. e-RUPI is a cashless and contactless instrument for digital payment. Addressing the event, the Prime Minister said that the eRUPI voucher is going to play a huge role in making DBT more effective in digital transactions in the country and will give a new dimension to digital governance. This will help everyone in targeted, transparent and leakage free delivery. He said e-RUPI is a symbol of how India is progressing by connecting people's lives with technology. He also expressed happiness that this futuristic reform initiative has come at a time when the country is celebrating the Amrit Mahotsav on the 75th anniversary of independence.



Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency, along with Shri Jitendra Narain, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration and Shri R N Sharma, Secretary (CS&CA/Health) participated in the virtual launch ceremony of e-RUPI, prepaid e-Voucher, a cashless and contactless, futuristic digital payment solutions by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

He said in addition to the Government, if any organization wants to help someone in their treatment, education or for any other work, then they will be able to give an eRUPI voucher instead of cash. This will ensure that the money given by him is used for the work for which the amount was given.

Victory Flame to visit towns of Port Blair, Mayabunder, Baratang, Diglipur, Hutbay, Car Nicobar & Campbell Bay

Port Blair, Aug. 2

In December 1971, the Indian Armed Forces had secured a decisive victory over the Pakistan Army, and a new nation 'Bangladesh' was created. The victory also resulted into the largest military surrender post World War-II wherein approximately 93,000 soldiers of the Pakistan Army surrendered to the Indian Army. To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the historic victory, the nation is celebrating Year 2021 as 'Swarnim Vijay Varsh'. The celebrations commenced with the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi lighting the Victory Flame on 16th December, 2020. The Victory Flame was lit from the eternal flame of the National War Memorial and signifies the bravery of our heroic soldiers during the war. Since then, the Victory Flame is travelling across the length and breadth of India and a large number of commemorative events have been conducted during its journey.

The Victory Flame will arrive at Port Blair tomorrow (Aug. 3) by Indian Naval Ship 'Sumedha'. On reaching Port Blair, the Victory



Flame will be received by the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) at Naval Jetty at 10 am. A Tri-Service Guard of Honour will be presented to the Victory Flame in the presence of Hon'ble Lt Governor. Thereafter, the Victory Flame will depart from Naval Jetty to Flag Point wherein it will be open for public display from 2 pm to 6 pm.

On Aug. 4, the Victory Flame will depart for Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Island in the morning and later in the evening, the Flame will move to PVC Memorial. Thereafter, Victory Flame will move to National Memorial Cellular Jail. At

Chief Secretary issues order to ensure compliance to containment measures for COVID-19 management in accordance with advisories issued by MoHFW in whole of A&N Islands

Port Blair, Aug. 2

An Order of Union Home Secretary was issued on 29th June, 2021 to ensure compliance to the containment measures for COVID-19 in the country, as conveyed by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) vide D.O. letter dated 28th June, 2021, which was further extended for a period upto 31st August, 2021 vide an order dated 28th July, 2021. Further, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 10 (2) (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive

Committee (NEC) directs that the order of Ministry of Home Affairs of even number dated 29th June, 2021, to ensure compliance to the containment measures for COVID-19 management, as conveyed vide Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) advisory dated 28th June, 2021 and which will remain in force up to 31st August, 2021.

Consequent upon this Order, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain in the capacity as Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee, for

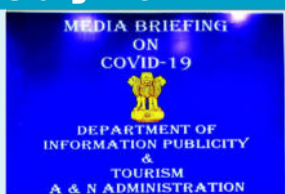
the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has ordered to ensure compliance to the containment measures for COVID-19 management in accordance with the advisories issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) dated 28th June, 2021 shall remain in force upto 31st August, 2021 for the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The Deputy Commissioners and Departments concerned may issue necessary Standard Operating Procedures to implement the orders. Media briefed on COVID-19 Mobile testing team conducts random sample test on 84 persons at Prothrapur; all found negative: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Aug. 2

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 359 flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. RAT test was conducted on 277 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all samples were found negative. Today, 2 flights with 360 passengers arrived here and the results of RT-PCR reports are awaited. The mobile testing team conducted random sample test at Prothrapur today on 84 persons and all the reports were negative.

Speaking about vaccination drive which is being conducted smoothly in Isles, the Secretary said 632 persons were vaccinated today till 3 pm, out of which, 432 were in the



age group of 18-44. The Director, ANIMS, Dr. A.K Mandal said that 1 corona patient is undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital while no patient is on oxygen or ventilator. The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De mentioned that two patients are being taken care of at ITI COVID Care Centre.

Andaman Administration allows movement of stranded people between Port Blair & N&M Andaman

To operate ATR Express service in restricted manner from Aug. 3

In order to facilitate stranded people or those who require to move between Port Blair and North & Middle Andaman in connection with education, work or other emergency needs, the A&N Administration has decided to operate the ATR Express services in a restricted manner in respect of buses plying on NH-4 between South Andaman District and

North & Middle Andaman District from 3rd August, 2021, an order to this effect issued by Transport Department said.

The order further stated that Transport Department will be operating buses with maximum 90 % of the registered seating capacity and the operation shall adhere to the SOP issued by Transport Department

seed collection initiative is carried out by the sanitary workers of Swachh Bharat Mission-G. The sanitary workers are collecting seed on daily basis along with collection of door to door segregated waste. After collection, these seeds will be accumulated species wise and handed over to the respective Agriculture Depots in the areas. Under the campaign, the Directorate is focusing on mobilization of the 1000 odd SHG members spread across the 70 Gram Panchayats and tribal areas in the Islands. The SHG members have commenced sapling plantation of fruit bearing trees in their premises and also encouraging other community members to take up the initiative.

Further, the Directorate has issued instructions to the sanitary workers of the Gram Panchayats to also collect used seeds from the households, markets etc along with the routine Door to Door waste collection. The drive is ensuring daily collection of fruit bearing seeds. These collected seeds are handed over to the Sub-Depots under Agriculture Department. The aim is to make the Sub-Depots the hub for fruit bearing seeds and shall act as a repository of different varieties of seeds.

Under the campaign, the Department has also scaled up plantation of trees along the village roads, SWM Clusters, assets of the local bodies and Government buildings.

Taking ahead the plantation of fruit bearing trees in the Islands, RD Department have managed to plant 1080 fruit bearing trees in the Govt. Building of RD; 1500 fruit bearing saplings by the Self Help Groups (SHGs) and Community Resource Persons (CRPs) in their respective residence.

Further, under Save the Seed Campaign, 1480 Seeds have been collected so far from different Gram Panchayats and handed over to the Agriculture Department for further proceeding.

More such initiatives shall be carried out in the coming days across the Islands by the Department towards 'Green and Clean Islands', a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

them wrong. Today the thinking of the country is different, it is new. Today we are seeing technology as a tool to help the poor, a tool for their progress.

The Prime Minister noted how technology is bringing in transparency and integrity in transactions and creating new opportunities and making them available to the poor. He mentioned that for reaching today's unique product, foundation was prepared over the years by creating the JAM system which connected mobile and Aadhaar. Benefits of JAM took some time to be visible to people and we saw how we could help the needy during the lockdown period while other countries were struggling to help their people, said the Prime Minister. He noted that in India, more than seventeen and half lakh crore rupees have been transferred directly to the accounts of the people via Direct Benefit Transfer. More than three hundred schemes are using DBT. 90 crore Indian are being benefited in some way or the other through in areas like LPG, ration, medical treatment, scholarship, pension or wage disbursal. 1 lakh 35 thousand crore rupees have directly been transferred to farmers under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, 85 thousand crore rupees for government purchase of wheat were also disbursed in this manner. "The biggest benefit of this all is that 1 lakh 78 thousand crore rupees were prevented from going to the wrong hands," he added.




