Government of India approves special package of Rs. 400 crore to give impetus to natural oil & gas exploration in A&N Islands

Administration accorded in principle approval for grant of Petroleum Exploration License to M/s Oil India Ltd.

Port Blair, Sept. 3

Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of Andaman group of Islands has 2 million metric tonnes of oil equivalent discovered and 369 million metric tonnes of oil equivalent undiscovered potential. The Government of India has reduced the "No Go" Zone in our EEZ paving way for commercial exploitation of natural oil and gas available in Andaman Basin.

The Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has tasked M/s Oil India Ltd.(OIL) to acquire about 15,000 LKM 2D Seismic data for appraisal of unappraised areas in Andaman deep waters (offshore). The bidding process for selection of agency is open till 1st week of September, 2020 and survey work is likely to be awarded in the 3rd week of September, 2020. The survey work using a state-of-the-art technology for data acquisition, processing and interpretation will commence from last week of December, 2020 and expected to be completed by June, 2021 before onset of monsoon. The final report is expected by January, 2022.

The Apex Steering Committee in the Administration will extend necessary support and coordination for smooth and timely execution of survey work. The project is of national importance considering the potential of natural oil and gas in the Islands and potential of exploration & production of natural oil and gas to give boost to economic growth in the Islands, the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has approved a special grant of Rs. 400 crore for the project. The implementation of project is closely monitored. The Administration is committed for economic development of the Islands. In order to fast track the implementation of the project, the Administration has accorded in-principle approval for grant of Petroleum Exploration License to M/s Oil India Ltd. in 2 blocks in Andaman Basin. The Secretary (Revenue), A&N Administration has been designated as Nodal Officer to facilitate obtaining pre-requisite permissions from the departments as per existing law for issuance of Petroleum Exploration License to M/s Oil India Ltd, a press release from A&N Administration said.

Briefing media yesterday, Union Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar said, the Karmayogi scheme will be the biggest Human Resource development programme of the government.

The institutional framework will consist of Prime Minister's Public Human Resources (HR) Council, Capacity Building Commission, Special Purpose Vehicle for owning and operating the digital assets and the technological platform for online training, and Coordination Unit headed by the Cabinet Secretary.

The Public Human Resources Council comprising select Union Ministers, Chief Ministers, eminent public HR practitioners, thinkers, global thought leaders and Public Service functionaries will serve as the apex body for providing strategic direction to the task of Civil Services Reform and capacity building. The Capacity Building Commission has been proposed with a view to ensure a uniform approach in managing and regulating the capacity building ecosystem on collaborative and co-sharing basis.

To cover around 46 lakh Central employees, a sum of 510.86 crore rupees will be spent over a period of 5 years from 2020-21 to 2024-25. The expenditure is partly funded by multilateral assistance to the tune of 50 million dollars. A wholly owned Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) will be set up. The SPV will create and operationalize the content, market place and manage key business services of iGOT-Karmayogi platform. (Source: india.gov.in)

the aid of machinery or power, providing engineering, technical knowledge or other service for promotion of industrial growth, providing medical health or other allied service, setting up or development of tourism related facilities etc.

The quantum of loan is maximum 75% of the total project cost upto Rs. 10 lakh and minimum 66% of the total project cost exceeding Rs. 10 lakh for purchase of machinery, construction of building. The promoters contribution is minimum 25% for the project cost upto Rs.10 lakh and 34% for the project cost exceeding Rs. 10 lakh.

The rate of interest for different loan amount is fixed based on SIDBI's prime lending rate which is at present 11.00%. Accordingly, Rate of Interest calculated as per the range of finance is as under:

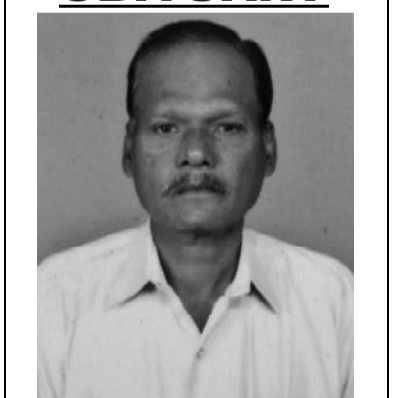

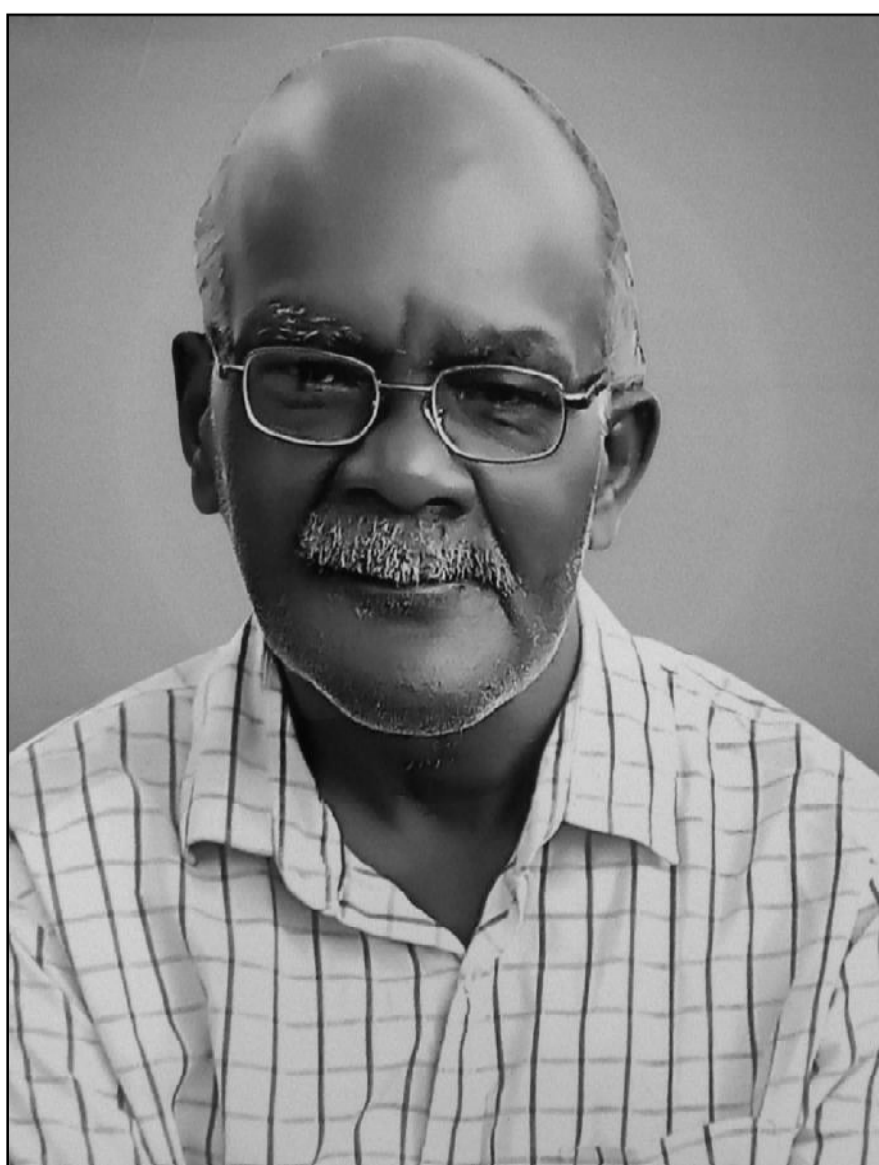
